

While living in Lutz, she attended services at First United Methodist Church of Lutz. She also participated in the Temple Twirlers Square Dance Club for 20 years, beginning in 2002. During her membership she had the honor of receiving a medal signifying that she square danced in all 50 states over a period of two years^{*}.

Miriam leaves behind her four daughters, four sons-in-law, nine grandchildren and twelve greatgrandchildren. She was preceded in death by her first husband, James Brown, her parents, siblings, and second husband, Tom James.
