He fell on August 13th and had some sort of seizure and had been in the hospital until his passing. When his wife, Alice, arrived at the hospital Friday morning, he was having difficulty breathing and was gasping for every breath. The night nurse told her he had been like that for most of the night. They couldn't feed him or give him anything to drink because they were afraid he would choke.

Alice was able to stay with him all day holding his hand and face and telling him how much she loved him. She also played his favorite song for him - "That Happy Feeling" by Bert Kaempfert.

Michael completed organ donor paperwork a long time ago, but since he had Alzheimer's disease, they couldn't do an organ donation. Alice found the Central Florida Brain Bank that does Alzheimer's research.

Alice worked all day on Saturday completing forms and sending Michael's medical records. You are supposed to register for the program in advance, but the representative said if Alice could everything done that day, she would make it work. Alice said she knows Michael would be pleased that his research may help with this terrible disease.
