She was recovering recent total hip replacement surgery and looking forward to getting out and about again. Sally was born June 15, 1932 the daughter of Charles A. Gregory (deceased) and Velma Darah Gregory (deceased).

Sally was raised on a farm near Ostrander, Ohio and graduated from Watkins High School in 1950. She then attended Otterbein College where she met her she met her husband, Joel, and they were married August 10, 1951, for 49 years until he died in July 2000. Sally was a minister's wife working alongside her husband, while working at a bank and continued evening college classes earning her teaching degree from Urbana University in the early 1970's. Sally's teaching career began in Ostrander, Ohio, Broadway, Ohio, then at West Mansfield, Ohio where she taught 5th grade until she retired in 1988.

Sally never met a stranger and everyone who entered her home always felt welcome. After retiring, Sally and Joel moved to Florida where she continued to teach until 2002.

Sally enjoyed family camping trips, square dancing, cruises, playing the piano and organ, plants and had many hobbies. She tried almost everything, copper work, crocheting, knitting, ceramics, stained glass, jewelry making, macramé, and cake decorating to name a few. In her early years she also sewed her own clothes and her children's clothes, she even sewed the clothes for the porcelain dolls she made from start to finish. She made over 1,000 dolls, giving many to family and friends and selling a few. She liked her doll collection, and she kept adding to it when she saw a different one.
