#### SPOTLIGHT ON DETROIT HISTORY





Hittsville, U.S.A. is the first headquarters and recording studio of the Motown record label, founded in 1959 by Berry Gordy Jr. Motown was instrumental in the racial integration of popular music as an African-Americanowned label that achieved crossover success with white audiences. Tour the Motown Museum, one of Detroit's most popular tourist destinations. Its walls are graced with the costumes, photos and records from Motown's golden era; and you can visit Studio A where the distinct sound of Motown's music was made and recorded and see the original 1877 Steinway & Sons grand piano restored to playing condition with the help of Paul McCartney in 2012. Another amazing artifact you'll find is a black fedora and studded white glove Michael Jackson donated in 1988 from his Bad World Tour.

Truly a gem of Detroit's history you won't want to miss!
