69th Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention

It's almost time for the convention! Have you registered? The convention is on January 19 – 20, 2024 in Deltona. The theme is *Days of Yore in 2024*. At the end of this newsletter, there is a single page flyer explaining everything about the Convention.

In a nutshell, here is everything you need to do before the convention.

First, you have to register. Did you know you can now register online for the convention (https://form.jotform.com/230066767013048) and make your hotel reservation (https://www.marriott.com/event-reservations/reservation-link.mi?id=1677692698319&key=GRP&app=resvlink) this year? Yes, if the special rate is available, you will still get it when you register online. Isn't that easy? The Courtyard by Marriott is the only local hotel giving us a special square dance rate. If you have to book somewhere else, you will need to go to each hotel's website. There is a list of area hotels below.

Then while you are registering online, you can also order your dinner show (flyer below) tickets and purchase any of the fundraising items!

Then when you arrive at the Trail End dance on Thursday night or the Convention on Friday, just go to the Registration Counter and pick up everything! Isn't that easy?




