IT'S Fall! Things are picking up!

The **FINAL West Coast Association Fall Festival** is on October 28-29, 2014, at the Carver Center. 520 Idlewood Avenue South, Bartow, Florida, and it's FREE for everyone! Ted Kennedy and Bill Chesnut will be calling Mainstream, Plus, and Advanced. Earle Collins will be cueing Phases 2 – 4 Rounds in the Main Hall only.
