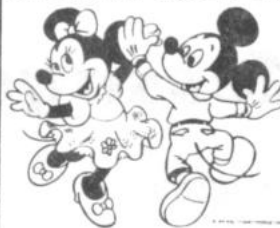

By now all callers should have received their "Request to Call" forms for the 1982 Convention. The Executive Board will meet following the Fall Clinic to program next spring's Convention. I urge all members to return their forms to me as soon as possible. No caller will be programmed unless they return their form before October 1st!

The Fall Clinic will be held October 16 - 18 at the Islander Beach Lodge in New Smyrna Beach. Frank Bedell will conduct this year's Clinic. There will be four clinic sessions: Friday afternoon and evening, and Saturday morning and afternoon. Saturday night there will be a dance called by Frank for the callers and their spouses. Mark this on your calendar and plan to attend. Not only is the Fall Clinic an opportunity to improve your calling skills, it is also an opportunity to meet informally with your fellow callers from around the state.

### ATTENTION GREEN BADGE CALLERS:

If you have completed all the requirements for Full Membership except being critiqued, and plan to be critiqued at the Fall Clinic, you must send me a statement signed by one of your original sponsors before October 1st so we can schedule you for critiquing. You will not be able to be critiqued unless you notify of your intention by October 1st. Also, if you are going to be critiqued, you should submit your "Request to Call" form at the same time. Programming for State Convention will be undertaken after the business meeting on Sunday so any caller critiqued and approved for Full Membership at the Clinic will be eligible to call at the Convention.

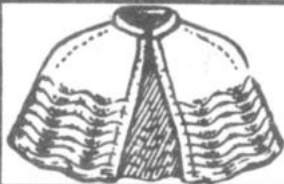

# SQUARE DANCING - NATIONAL FOLK DANCE ? ?

We are happy to report that we are getting very close to having the Square Dance proclaimed the National Folk Dance of the United States of America.

Just as our country is the "melting pot" of the world, with so many nationalities and races blended together, so square dancing is the "melting pot" of folk dances of many nations. Many square dance calls are direct descendants of maneuvers you still see in folk dances of other countries.

For years, efforts have been made to have Square Dancing proclaimed our National Folk Dance. A National Folk Dance Committee has been operating to further these efforts, with Mac & Mary McClure of Los Altos, California the present co-chairmen of this committee.

It was hoped that this legislation would be passed during the Lame Duck session of the last Congress, but it did not get through at that time, possibly because of a heavy agenda.

Just before the Lame Duck

session last year, Ronnie Lake, of Orlando, Florida, was carrying petitions around to all the clubs in the Central Florida area and obtained many hundreds of signatures to present to Congressman Bill Nelson of Florida's 9th District. This led to Congressman Nelson's name now being added to the Resolution's list of sponsors.

Congressman Nelson has now provided Ronnie Lake with copies of the resolutions introduced by both the House and Senate which deal with designating Square Dancing as our National Folk Dance. For your information, we have reproduced copies of both of these resolutions on page 10 of this issue of *BOW & SWING*.

As of September 9th, 1981, Congress will again be in session, and although there is no way of knowing exactly when these resolutions will come up for a vote, we urge you to write to your own Congressmen and Representatives IMMEDIATELY regarding them so they will know just how much interest there is in getting this passed.

## JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating the "square dance" as the national folk dance of the United States of America.

Whereas love of country and professions is enhanced by traditions that have become a part of our way of life and the customs of the American people; and

Whereas we have distinctive and meaningful symbols of our ideals in our Nation's flag, our national anthem, and in many cultural endeavors, but no official designation of a national folk dance; and

Whereas the square dance, which was first associated with the American people and recorded in history since 1651, has consistently been the one dance traditionally recognized by the American people as a dignified and enjoyable expression of American folk dancing; and

Whereas official recognition of the square dance will enhance the cultural stature of the United States both nationally and internationally; and

Whereas national and international prestige is in the best interest of all Americans: Now, therefore, be it

Whereas the American people value the display of etiquette among men and women which is a major element of square dancing;

Whereas square dancing is a traditional form of family recreation which symbolizes a basic strength of this country, namely, the unity of the family;

Whereas square dancing epitomizes democracy because it dissolves arbitrary social distinctions; and

Whereas it is fitting that the square dance be added to the array of symbols of our national character and pride: Now, therefore, be it

## JOHN BERGER

He was Chairman of the Central Florida Dancers Blood Bank and was its biggest donor, with donations counted in gallons. He also gave blood to his church's blood bank and gave personally to Hemophiliacs. He also persuaded the Central Florida Association to donate part of their supply to the Hemophiliacs.

Our sincere sympathy to Frances and his family. John will be missed for his friendship, his diligence in every job he undertook, but maybe most of all because he was so much fun to dance with.

## BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY:

THE BASIC ALAMO STYLE SEEMS TO BE USED FOR A SWING THRU TWICE AND THATS ABOUT ALL...This month I would like to present some ideas that mainstream dancers can do with alamo style.....

First set up a basic alamo and call the old alamo balance routine which goes like this....

ALLE, LEFT IN THE ALAMO STYLE ..RIGHT TO YOUR OWN & BALANCE...

ALLE, LEFT..ALAMO STYLE..BALANCE...HEADS..BOX CIRCULATE..

As the time for Fall Classes approaches, callerslab wants to encourage clubs and caller-teachers to take a critical look at their class programs and goals.

Review the current Basic and Mainstream Programs carefully in light of the time available for instruction and the clear need to graduate well-grounded dancers. Dancers should be taught not only the choreography of the various basics but also an introduction to the topics of history and heritage, dress, dance customs and manners, as well as simple rounds, mixers, and contras. Teach the basics from more than just a single set-up and insure both heads and sides can dance each part comfortably. Note that the new Basic Program (which combines the previous Basic and Extended Basic lists) makes an excellent 30 week package and is well suited for those areas where conditions limit class time to about 30 weeks a year.

to 2 1/2 hours each to teach the complete Mainstream Program, and many areas are phasing into a two year program of instruction to ensure that graduating dancers meet with success when they enter the square dance world. It seems clear that much of our dropout problem is rooted in the fact that some dancers are rushed through class too quickly and find that they cannot cope after graduation. Rushing dancers through class to increase club membership or the club treasury is short-sighted at best.

How much better to produce dancers who will be around for a long time because they are comfortable with and enjoy their square dance experience. The freezing of the Mainstream list for a period of three years enables us to look ahead and plan our teaching program without fear of disruptive changes. Let's make the most of our opportunity and rededicate ourselves to graduating really capable, smooth-dancing, happy dancers who are well-prepared to take their places in the square dance world and have the background and motivation to prepare for positions of leadership.

CALLERLAB recommends 29 sessions of 2-2 1/2 hours each or approximately 60 hours of instruction to teach the BASIC PROGRAM (Calls 1-48), 41 sessions to teach the MAINSTREAM PROGRAM (Calls 1-68). Do not teach from just a single position/formation and remember to teach styling as well. Calls in italics may be deferred until later.

# WHICH DIRECTION TO TURN ?

This question has been asked by many callers and leaders all over the world. It is not new, it has been asked for over 30 years and yet nobody has come up with a foolproof solution to satisfy everyone.

The question is in regard to the Mainstream Basics Program. CALLERLAB has developed the most workable program ever! Nobody has ever said that the CALLERLAB program is perfect but it is closer than anything in existence today, in the eyes of the majority.

At the first CALLERLAB Convention, held in St. Louis in 1974, the big outcry was "Develop a Mainstream Program of basics that every caller, all over the world, can use so the teaching and learning process will be standardized." The Mainstream Basics Committee was formed, with Johnny LeClair as chairman, and the process began. The first proposed program took almost 2 years to develop and was adopted on a one-year trial basis at the convention in 1976. This same program was adopted on a permanent basis in 1977 with a suggested teaching order and a recommendation of forty-one sessions or eighty hours of teaching time. The amount of teaching time was the most workable average selected by the committee from suggestions that ranged from a low of ten weeks to a high of seventy weeks. If every caller in the world were to make up a Mainstream Basics list, along with the amount of teaching time, we would probably have nine thousand different programs, presuming there are that many callers worldwide. What a disaster that would be to the square dancing world.

Square dancing is more standardized today than ever before, due to the hard work and dedication of the committees and members of CALLERLAB.

There have been a certain number of complaints about the length of the Mainstream Program and the teaching time. Some of them have been justified, but there have been many more compliments than complaints. It was interesting and rewarding to hear the European Callers Association at their meeting in Munich, Germany in July, 1978 adopt a policy that the Saturday night dance of their festival would consist of the CALLERLAB Mainstream Program only! What fantastic cooperation and what a compliment to CALLERLAB.

We may have reached the time when the Basic and Extended Programs need to be "frozen" for a certain period. This aspect will be discussed at the convention this year.

It is disturbing to hear callers complain about the length and the amount of time required to teach the Mainstream Program when all along their ultimate goal is to push their new dancers to the Plus II level as fast as possible. Some callers are trying to attain this impossible goal in twenty to twenty-five sessions. How sad it is to see this happen and watch dancers suffer and be totally frustrated when they enter the square dancing world. The caller and the club are not being fair to their new dancers.

The Mainstream Program does work. This has been proven in many instances. It can and should work all over the world. All it takes is commitment and cooperation of the callers and leaders.

We need to keep the fun and sociable aspect of square dancing uppermost in our minds and not frustration. Too many very good callers have forgotten what made them popular and in demand all over the world. They became well known for the simple reason that they called a fantastic dance. No mention was ever made about what level they called or how choreographically intricate the figures were. They simply called a great dance.

Good leadership and good judgment are the keys to the entire activity. If the callers and leaders have the attitude that the dancer must be the winner during class and at dances, then good leadership and good judgment have been exercised. If, on the other hand, the callers and leaders are constantly pushing the dancer to learn more and more and never permitting them to win and have fun, then poor leadership and poor judgment are evident. In far too many instances we have sacrificed quality for quantity. Quality dancing is so beautiful and feels so good, it gives one the feeling of being a winged figure of human form in fine art.

So, which direction do we turn? We turn toward commitment and cooperation that we can and will continue to make Square Dancing the most enjoyable activity that has ever been created.

Square dancing should and must be an "Expression of Joy."
