Any application received after that date WILL NOT be scheduled for State Convention, but will be held for critiquing at the Fall Clinic.

If you are thinking of becoming a Caller and wish to join the Florida Callers Association, please write to Earl Steele for an application for membership. You should also plan to complete your application and submit it to Earl before the Convention so you can attend our spring meeting at the Convention. Following the General Meeting, you'll then meet with the Executive Board for a full explanation of membership requirements and procedures. (This meeting is one of your requirements of membership.)

All callers scheduled on the program, please meet with me at the Callers' Stand in the Main Arena on Friday evening at 7 P.M. for a brief discussion of our plans for a smooth convention.

Callers, please remind your dancers that their convention weekend will be much more enjoyable if they dance in the halls where callers are using the dance movements with which the dancers are familiar. Here is your opportunity to exercise your qualities of leadership to guide your dancers in this area. Too often we hear of dancers who come away from a dance where they were "in over their heads", losing confidence in themselves, thinking they will never dance comfortably. This can be a very detrimental experience — especially for the newer dancer. It's up to you to lead your dancers into many happy dancing experiences. Make this Convention the first of many for them! !

RASPBERRIES TO MR. RASPBERRY

In the September, 1981 issue of *BOW & SWING*, copies of the U.S. Senate and House of Representative bills to make Square Dancing the National Folk Dance of the United States were printed. Later we proudly announced the passage, by unanimous vote, of Senate Joint Resolution No. 59, and requested you write, call or visit your Representative, asking him to co-sponsor HJR No. 151, as it needs 218 co-sponsors in order for it to come up for a vote.

Recently, in the *Orlando Sentinel Star*, there appeared an article written by syndicated columnist, William Raspberry. It was featured in the February, 1982 issue of the Central Florida Square and Round Dance Association's newsletter, *KEEPIN' POSTED*, with some very interesting and pertinent comments regarding Mr. Raspberry's uninformed statements regarding Square Dancing.

This article is reprinted, in part, below:

If you have had little or no interest in this worthwhile project prior to this article, we think you may change your mind somewhat when you read further. We are including excerpts from an article printed recently in the *Sentinel Star*, written by syndicated columnist, William Raspberry. We regret that we do not have space to print the entire article because we believe our dancers would be interested in every word. However, copies are available by sending a stamped self-addressed envelope to the Editor. Read on for a different point of view. The article is titled "Press really out of step on major story of year", and states as follows:

Washington — The press, its attention diverted by weather, Warsaw, and the president's State of the Union message, is blowing what may be the major political-legislative-cultural story of the year.

I refer to the bill, introduced last

fall by Senate Minority Leader Robert Byrd, to make the square dance the American national folk dance.

Early support for the measure has blurred lines of party and political sensitivity. Byrd, a Democrat, introduced it. Strom Thurmond hailed it as "a tremendous piece of legislation". His fellow Republican Howard Baker called it "momentous".

The press may thus have been misled into thinking it is non-controversial. It isn't! Indeed, it could, if enacted, tear this country apart at the seams.

It is impossible to suppose that people for whom folk dancing means an Irish jig could be happy with this bit of terpsichorean treachery. Partisans of the New Orleans Strut will see an official allemande as an attack on their culture. One might just as well decree that Vermonters submit to grits, or Texans to pie for breakfast.

Black people are certain to see the proposal as further erosion of their civil rights. Nor are Hispanic or Oriental-Americans likely to be reassured.

Young people, most especially those in the cities, may well be moved to abandon politics altogether. The person who thinks of disco as the ultimate art form will have no truck with square dancing. That should have been obvious from the fact that the bill's chief sponsor, Byrd, is a country fiddler who would not recognize a Moog synthesizer if it bit him on his do-si-do.

And yet this potentially divisive bill cleared the Senate on a voice vote without a single dissent. There was no debate, no minority report, no expert testimony, not even a single authoritative poll.

Without prejudging the matter, it

does seem reasonable that we institute a national debate on this important issue. I would favor a bipartisan, black-white-yellow-red and brown ribbon committee to investigate the claims of various dance forms for enshrinement as the "national folk dance".

We might agree, upon sober reflection, that none of the old dances measure up, that what is needed is a dance that speaks to the tenor of the times. I suggest only a few of the countless possibilities: . . .

(Mr. Raspberry then lists eleven such possibilities.)

Editor's comments:

1. A reliable source on The Hill assured me that the resolution is considered non-controversial.

2. The same contact told us that Senator Byrd is an excellent country fiddler. He is, at the same time, an accomplished musician with a wide variety of musical talent and interests. So much for credibility!

Mr. Raspberry "would favor a bipartisan black-white-yellow-red-brown committee". How interesting! I understand a black square dancer gave one of the Keynote addresses at the 1981 National Square Dance Convention in Seattle inviting everyone to attend the 1982 National in her home city of Detroit. So much for BLACK. During the Milwaukee National my husband and I danced with Orientals. So much for YELLOW. Several weeks ago we danced to a very entertaining and talented caller who is a full-blooded Cherokee Indian. So much for RED. I could go on and on. I hasten to point out, however, that none of the above mentioned people were, in the true sense of the word, black, yellow or red. They are all SQUARE DANCERS.

After you have written your letter to your Congressman, (and I have no doubt some of you may also feel the urge to send *Mr. Raspberry* a few comments on his article), I have another suggestion. Take another

few minutes of your time and write to the 1982 National Square Dance Committee or the National Executive Committee. Send along a copy of *Mr. Raspberry's* column, and request that he be invited as a special guest at the 1982 National Convention in Detroit. There he would see first hand the beauty, the pageantry, the friendship, and the love people from all over the world share as they enjoy their favorite pastime. He would have an opportunity to rub shoulders with these kind, considerate, thoughtful, fun-loving folks who are out "to tear this country apart at the seams" as they peacefully strive to get action on Congressional Resolution H.J.R. #151. If he accepts the invitation, we must be sure he doesn't miss seeing our handicapped dancers, the deaf, the blind, the retarded, those in wheelchairs, as they are encouraged and cheered in their personal struggles to make the most of the wonderful world of square dancing. Then let's be sure to provide *Mr. Raspberry* with a good typewriter and suggest that he write a sequel to the above article that appeared in January on the Editorial page of our local newspaper. What say you, fellow square dancers? Your comments will be most welcome.

The basic concept for selection to the Hall of Fame will be square or round dancers, callers or cuers who have been involved in the Florida activity for ten years or more and devoted much time and unselfish labor so as to have had a significant effect. Their pictures, along with a resume' of their accomplishments will adorn one wall of Strawberry Square. It is hoped a selection committee can be mutually agreed upon at the earliest pos-

sible date.

Along with the Hall of Fame, it is hoped to display on the other walls, various memorabilia of the Florida square dance activity such as the plaques from the National Showcase of Ideas, the old visitation keys and any other items of interest that can be found.

We would welcome your suggestions for Hall of Fame inductees along with a resume' of their accomplishments, especially those of the late 50's and early 60's whether living or not. Any memorabilia you may have or can locate along with a brief history would be most welcome.

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

New sides do a Right & Left Thru
4 & 3 Right & Left Thru (½ out)
2 & 1 Right & Left Thru (all out)
New Heads Cross-Trail Thru (all in)
Find the Corner - Left Allemande.

Editor.

In the last decade of Square Dancing, the callers have come up with 3 new basics. They are what I would consider "Life Savers" for callers and I feel sure that they were originated for just this purpose, because they can get a caller out of a lot of jams that he did not intend to get himself into. I know because I had that same trouble many years ago. I thought that I would try out an idea and the first thing I knew I was working my way out of something I didn't intend to get into in the first place. This can happen to almost any caller, and I always tried to work my way out so that the dancers would never know that I was in trouble.

The basics I am referring to are "Flutter Wheel", "Sweet a Quarter", and "Recycle". All three can be used as "Life Savers" in many instances to get yourself into another position you want. I will also show you how we used calls to get into the same positions before there was a call to get you into them. I mentioned Flutter Wheel first so we will take a look at that one first. Actually Flutter Wheel is nothing more than a Right & Left Thru and Two Ladies Chain. What I am saying

is that this is the way we would get our dancers into that position before we had Flutter Wheel to fall back on. However, Flutter Wheel is such a smooth movement that it is really a great addition to our Basic list of calls. Here's a for instance::

1 & 3 Square Thru
Pass the Ocean
Now Recycle

Right at this point I have the gent where I want him but he is with the wrong lady so I call:

Right & Left Thru - Turn your girl
Flutter Wheel and - Star Thru -

Now I have the dancers right back where they were after the Square Thru, each gent looking at his Corner Lady, IN sequence. So, when you have the gent in position but he has the wrong lady on his right, just call a Right & Left Thru, then a "Flutter Wheel". This is the same as Two Ladies Chain except that it does change the sequence. I have watched Callers using these basics to their advantage and they are giving the dancers a good dance at the same time. You can use Flutter Wheel from a Promenade Wheel Around and come up with very good results. You call:

Promenade now and don't slow down
Heads Wheel Round - Right & Left Thru
Turn on around and - Flutter Wheel
Now Pass Thru and - Bend the Line
Right & Left Thru - Flutter Wheel

Let's check that one out. We have the opposite lady at this point and we are out of sequence. There are any number

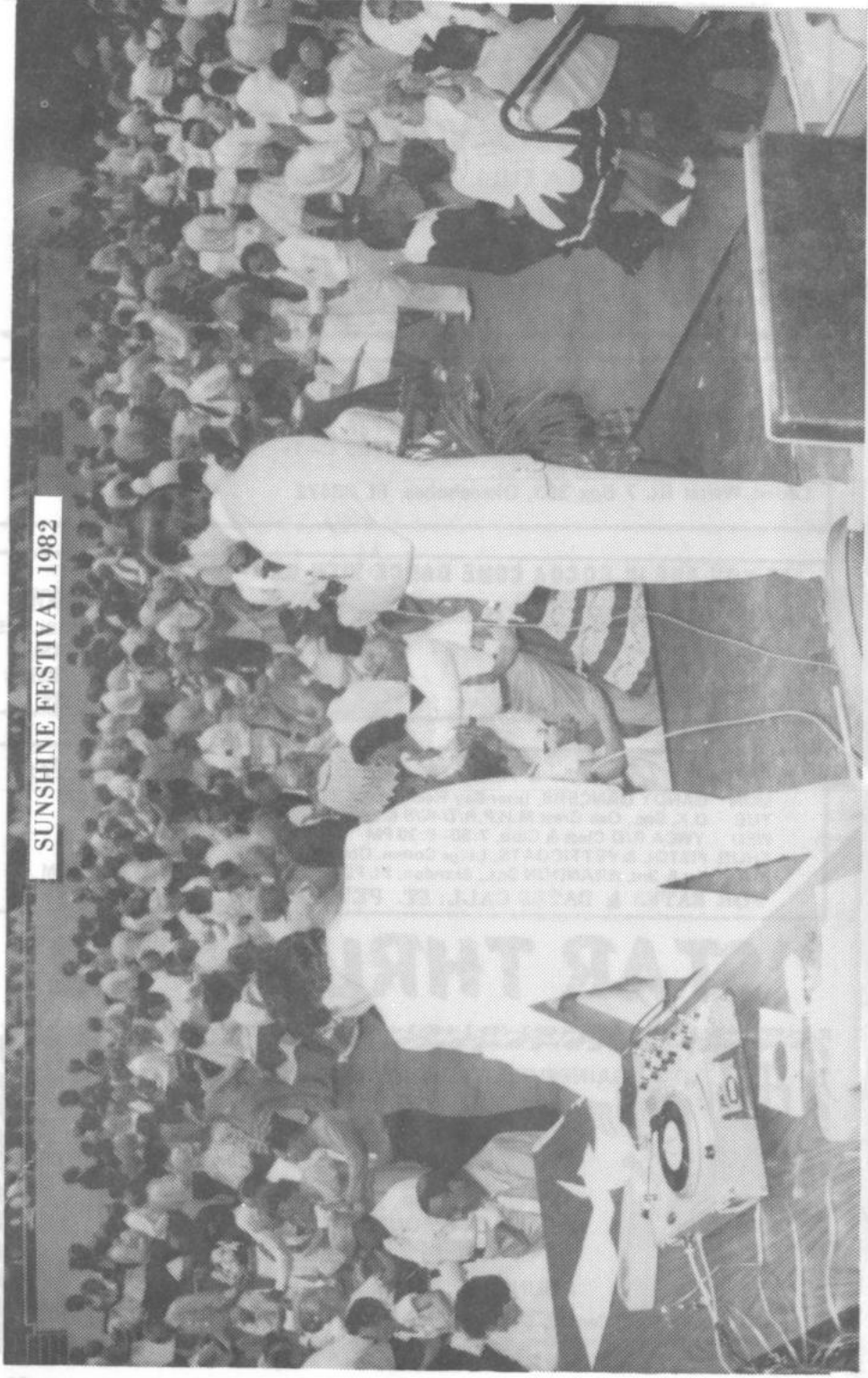

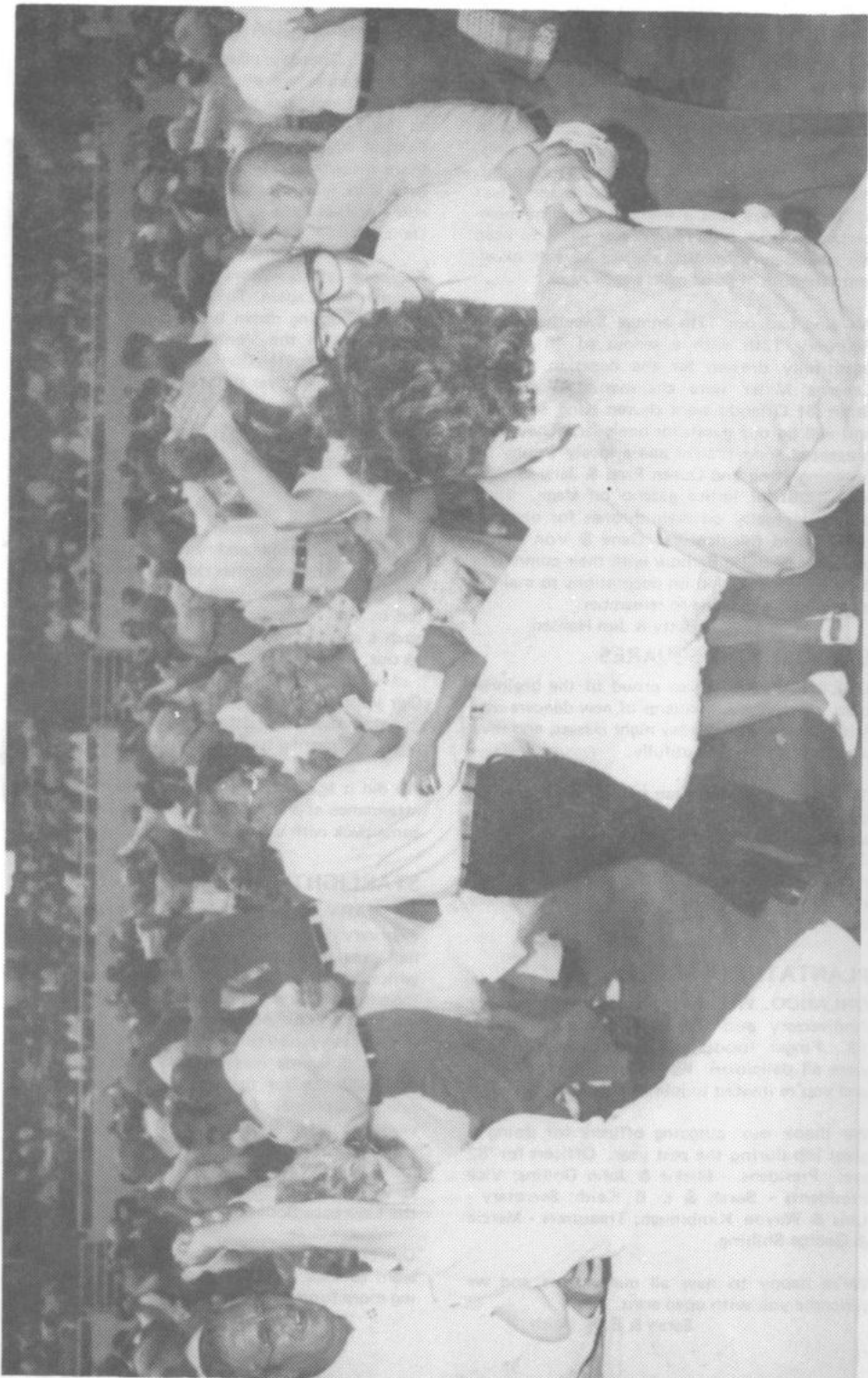

TIPS FOR THE NEWER CALLER

(Continued from Page 20)

of things you can do here. One thing I like to use right here would be:

- Pass Thru - Bend the Line*
- Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru -*
- Star Thru - Cross-Trail, Left Allemande*

Just in case you didn't already know it, from lines of four, if you have the dancers do a STAR THRU - DIVE THRU - and STAR THRU - this is exactly the same as a 4 Ladies Chain. If Gents start with original Partners, after the above call they will have their opposite lady for a partner, OUT of sequence. Here it is:

- Promenade now and don't slow down*
- (IN sequence)*
- 1 & 3 will wheel around (still IN)*
- Star Thru (out) Dive Thru (still out)*
- Pass Thru (still out) Star Thru (out)*
- Pass Thru - Bend the Line*
- (they are now IN sequence)*
- Star Thru (out) Dive Thru (out)*
- Pass Thru (out) Star Thru (out)*
- Cross Trail (IN) - Allemande Left*

You will notice that in the first setup I used Flutter Wheel the first two changes and this put the gents with their opposite lady. Then I had them Pass Thru and Bend the Line to get them back IN sequence, we gave them the "Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru and Star Thru" and now we are back with original partners, OUT of sequence so we simply

Cross-Trail Thru, Left Allemande.

SWEEP A QUARTER can also be used as a Life Saver in many instances. You can use it to get your dancers into another position, such as changing them from an 8 Chain Thru position into a Line of 4 position, or vice versa. Let's go back to that first setup we used, like this:

- 1 & 3 will Square Thru*
- Count 4 hands to the Outside Two*
- Pass the Ocean - Recycle*
- and Sweep a Quarter.*

By using "Sweep a Quarter" we now have the dancers right back where they were after we did the "Heads Square Thru". Keep this in mind. If the dancers are in a wave and you want to make a change and get them into an 8 Chain Thru position you can use a "Sweep a Quarter" and this will put them back into the 8 Chain Thru position. You will probably ask, "How did you get the same thing when there was no "Recycle"? In almost all cases, we would get exactly the same thing by calling "Girls Turn Around - Wheel & Deal to face 'em. Try that some time from a wave. Instead of calling Recycle, just call "Girls turn back - Wheel & Deal to face that couple".

Give all of these a good tryout and see if they are of some help in your calling. I am sure that you will be able to add to them as you go along.

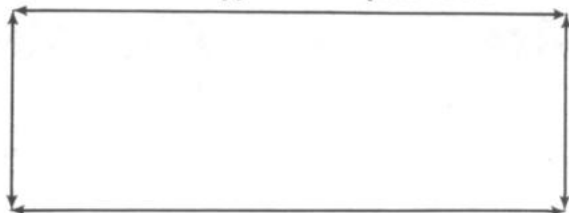
