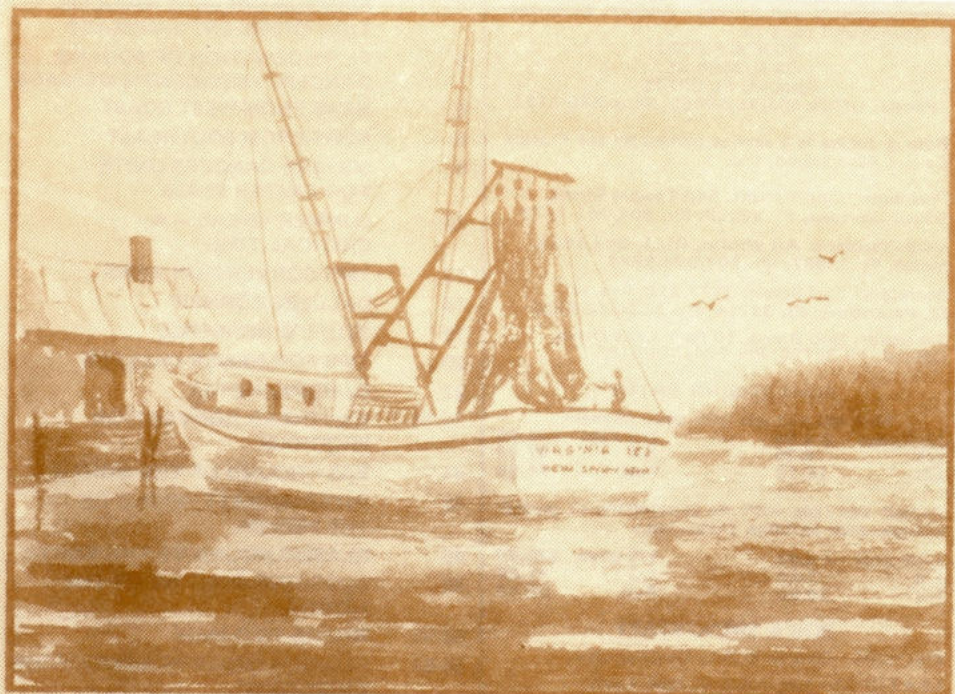

Now let's encourage them so that their enthusiasm doesn't diminish during the summer months. In areas where clubs take a break from dancing during the summer, maintaining the enthusiasm of new dancers may pose a problem. However, your new dancers can be included in many activities which may or may not involve dancing.

Summertime is a good time to nurture the seeds of those friendships planted during the busy fall and spring classes. Now is the time to make them grow. How about a patio party or a pool party with lots of good food and time to relax and get to know one another? Or a barbecue? Or a picnic? Perhaps the patio or a cleaned-out garage (a bonus, incidentally) will provide space for a bit of practice and relaxed dancing. One need not invite the entire group at one time but might consider smaller groups of people with similar backgrounds, etc. And, of course,

Although there will be many workshops available to the newly graduated dancers, do not push them into an experience which might be discouraging and frustrating to them. Instead, encourage them to experience the fun of dancing at the level at which they graduated and to develop expertise at that level for a year or more before they move on to new levels. You will make a welcome contribution to reducing the drop-out rate if you do this.

Please remember to provide that personal touch for the newly graduated dancers during the summer months and encourage them to appear on the club doorstep with dues in hand when the fall dance season starts.

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

EQUIVALENTS

Let's look back at some of the things we have been going over the last few months, and check to see what some of those movements are equivalent to. This is what Square Dancing is all about. Over the years I have found that everything in Square Dancing has to be equivalent to some other movement, or basic. For instance, we have said that the sequence of "Curlique", "Scoot Back", "Boys Run" is equivalent to a "Star Thru". This means from anywhere - from the Static Position, from Lines of Four, or from an Eight Chain Thru. We can go even further. Think about this. If you add a "Star Thru", either before or after the movement above, then we have the equivalent of just a plain old "Right & Left Thru". Something like so:

**One & Three will - Star Thru
Then Curlique - and Scoot Back
Boys Run Right, Cross-Trail Thru
Find old Corner, Left Allemande.**

As I said before, you can add that "Star Thru" either BEFORE or AFTER the "Curlique". However, it is smoother for the dancer if you use it afterwards.

**One & Three will - Curlique
Scoot Back - Boys Run Right -
Star Thru - Cross-Trail Thru
Find the Corner, Left Allemande.**

What we are looking for here are "Equivalents". Looking this one over we find that we can do "Curlique, Scoot Back, Boys Run Right" and we have the equivalent of just a "Star Thru" for the Heads. Then by adding a Star Thru, either before or after the Curlique, we have the Equivalent of a Right & Left Thru. There is nothing difficult about it. This is just a plain simple fact. By learning "Equivalents", and by putting them to actual practice, you expand your own knowledge in the field of Square Dance Calling, and, of course, you are calling a better dance.

We said earlier that these same things will work from "Three" positions. We used

them here in a Static position. They will also work from lines of four or from an Eight Chain Thru position. Exactly the same call after you have them in the position you want them in. I seldom ever use Heads/Sides to the right and circle to a line. I use something more effective, like so:

**Heads Curlique - Walk & Dodge
Circle 4 with the Outside Two
Head Gents Break -
Forward and Back
Now Curlique - Then Scoot Back
Boys Run Right and - Star Thru
Cross-Trail Thru, Left Allemande.**

Remember now, you can add the "Star Thru" right at the beginning after you have them in lines. I added it afterwards, but you can add it at the beginning and the results would be the same.

Now we will take a look at the "Eight Chain Thru" position. Start off something like this:

**One & Three will Square Thru
4 hands round to the outside two
(each gent facing his corner, IN Sequence)
Star Thru - Curlique - Scoot Back
Boys Run Right - then Dive Thru -
Square Thru 3/4's, Left Allemande.**

When we had the boys Run Right out of the Scoot Back, we had the equivalent of a Right & Left Thru, so we have them "Dive Thru" and Square Thru Three-Quarters around to a Left Allemande. Or we can do any number of other things. Once you know how to add these things that we are working on, you will be able to put them in almost anywhere. We could have them do a Right & Left Thru after the Dive Thru and then go into something else, or add something. Try it like this:

**Heads Square Thru - Four Hands
Curlique - Scoot Back - Boys Run**

Star Thru - Dive Thru
Then do a Right & Left Thru -
(Turn the Girls)
Curlique, Scoot Back - Boys Run -
Star Thru - Square Thru 3/4's
Left Allemande.

As you know, we are working on just a couple of equivalents here. We can add more and more of them as we go along and the first thing you know you are calling a "Good level" of dancing and you are doing nothing more than just calling Basics. This to me is Square Dance Calling.

I have been told that CALLERLAB has dropped "Swat the Flea". If they have, I can see no reason for doing so. It was one of our standard Basics for many years and I still teach it, and use it. If "Box the Gnat" is with the Right Hands, then I see no reason why "Swat the Flea" should not work for the LEFT Hands. It has worked for many years and will keep

on working as far as I am concerned, and I still use it. Try something like this:

Heads Square Thru 4 hands around
Meet the Corner, Box the Gnat
Change Hands - Swat the Flea
Change Girls - Box the Gnat
Change Hands - Swat the Flea
Change Girls - Box the Gnat
Change Hands - Left Allemande.

That last one is pretty much of a sneaker and it usually catches the dancers "Flat Footed" but we can always remind them: "You were not listening to the Caller".

Here is another sneaker as long as we got into them:

Heads Square Thru 4 Hands
Right & Left Thru - Turn the Girl
Then Dive Thru - California Twirl

Did they do it with the lady by their side, or did they reach for the girl in front of them???

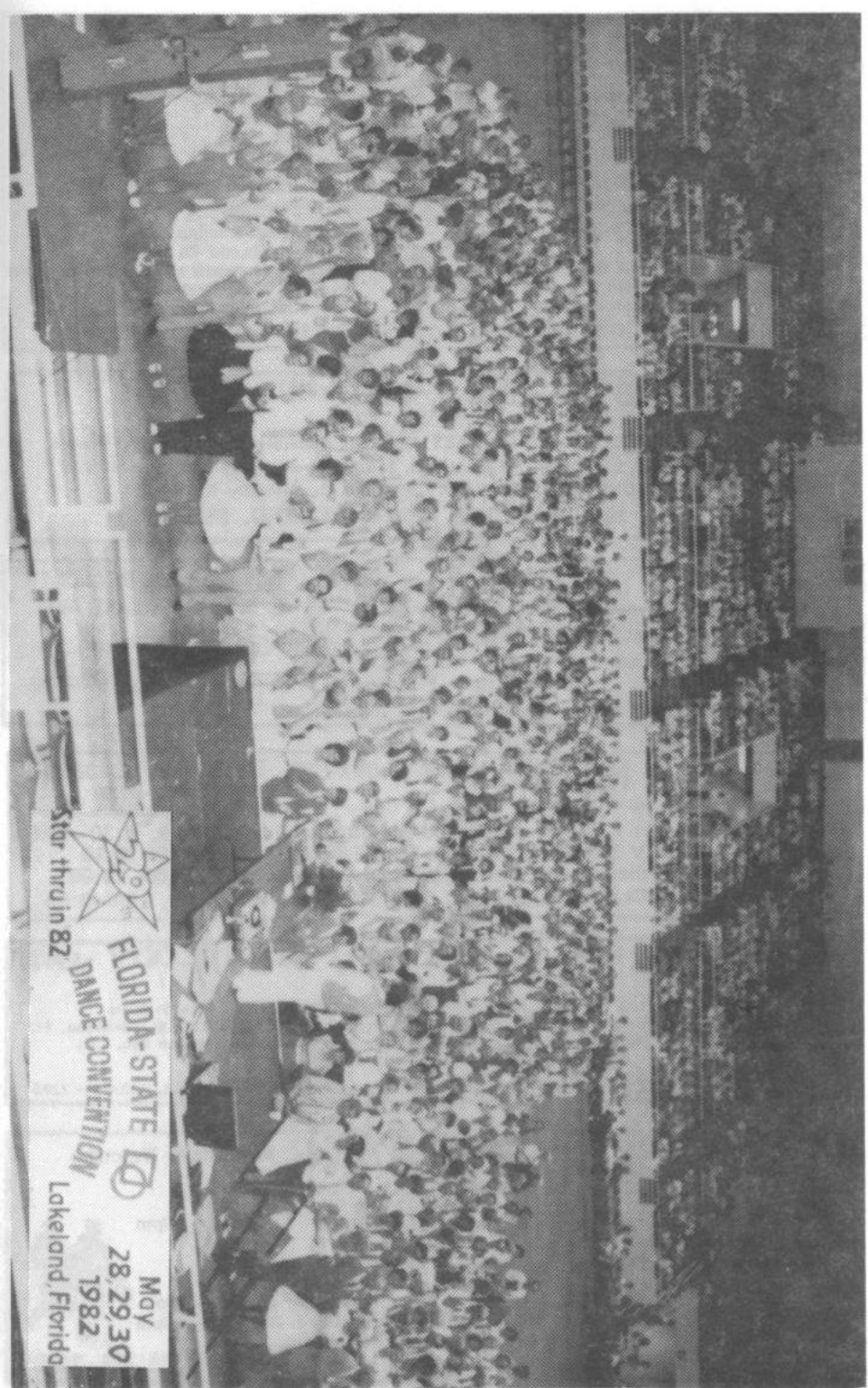

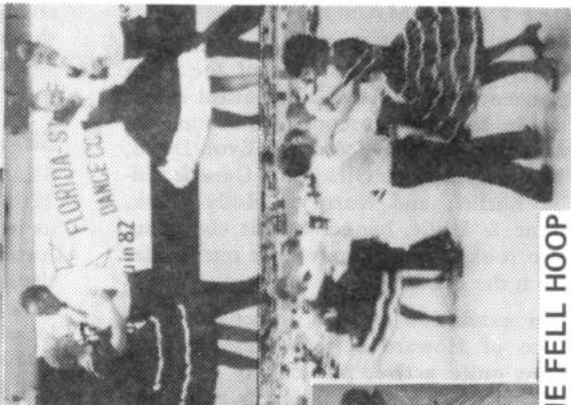
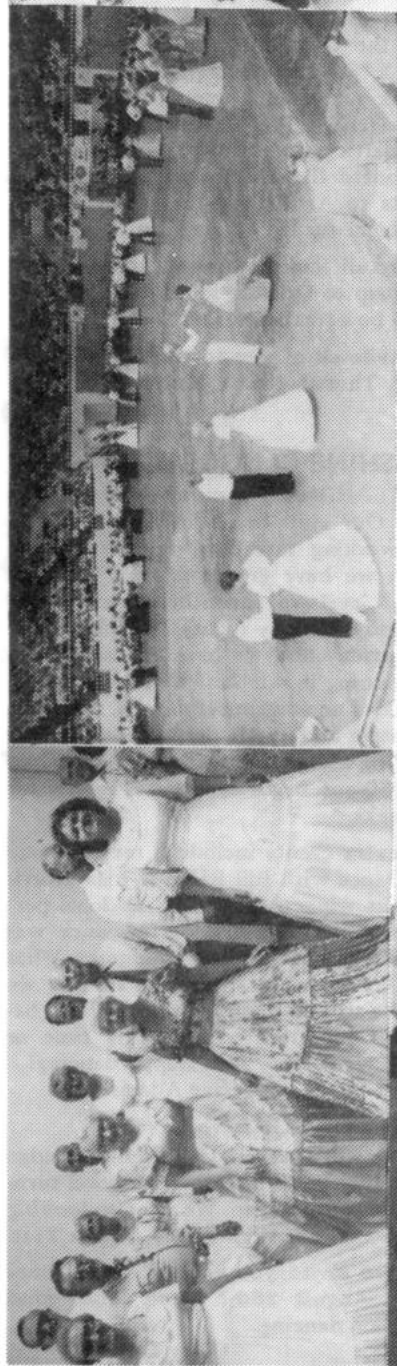

In August, Several of us will spend another fun week of dancing at Andy's Trout Farm in Dillard, Ga., and add another trout to our badge.

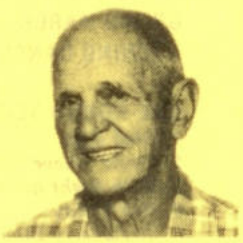
