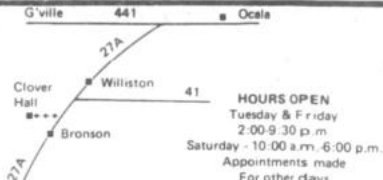

lines, and an offer to help in some areas by your Federation.

Currently, the largest joint effort in Florida dancing is the 1983 Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention. This event is the product of the resources of the Central Florida Square and Round Dancers Association as host, the Round Dance Council of Florida, the Florida Callers Association and the Florida Federation of Square Dancers. The very entertaining and sometimes family connected clogging activities are satelited about the Convention with a growing operation of the Florida Clogging Council.

Concerning the 1983 Convention, there are two unique items of interest on which we would comment: First; The diamond ring to be given away during the 30th (diamond year) convention is a symbolic benefit bestowed to all dancers, even though it is received by one symbolic winner. Second; the Convention Chairman, Howard & Vivian Wilson, have organized a benefit dance to produce funds

for the Pensacola Special Steppers to travel to the 1983 Convention. These handicapped children (who we believe should be referred to as "gifted dancers") personify the noblest spirit in the face of adversity known to mankind. They were chosen to perform at the White House to make the beginning of Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance, and this same benefit is planned for you at the 1983 State Convention.

The dance will be on December 5th from 2 to 5 PM at the Volusia County Fairgrounds, Deland (I-4, Hwy 44). Entrance donation is the amount of your choice. 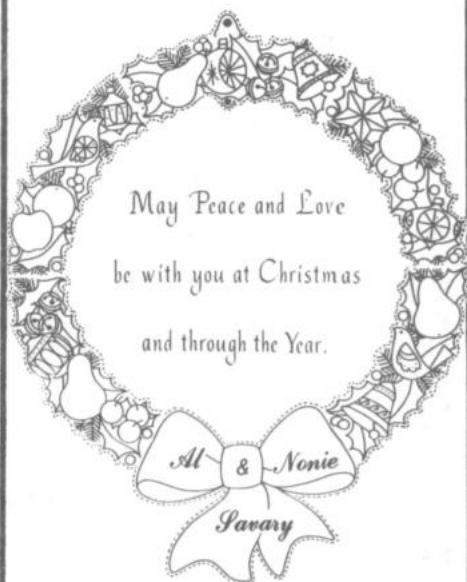

CALLERLAB QUARTERLY SELECTIONS FOR THE PLUS PROGRAM:

The Plus committee has made its first selections for the last quarter of 1982..The two selections are:

TRACK TO A DIAMOND:...

The starting formation is a Column and the action has the first & second lead dancers in each column do a track II type action...The leader walks around the adjacent column & circulates as the next or second dancer will walk around the adjacent column and stops.. The leaders will become the points in parallel diamonds....The trailing two dancers in each column will circulate to form a single box in the center and with adjacent arms, arm turn (cast) 3/4 to become the centers in the forming diamonds... I suggest starting with a column made up of two boys as the leaders & two girls as the trailers...This set up allows the boys to dance a common track II action and the resulting Diamond is a very common set up..... Start with the above and move into the column with two girls as leaders then standard columns...Judgement here is important, only YOU know the degree of difficulty your dancers enjoy and remember the bottom line is Dancer Success....

HEADS PASS THRU..AROUND ONE TO A LINE..
LINES PASS THRU..U TURN BACK..TOUCH 1/4..
TRACK TO A DIAMOND..CENTER LADIES TRADE..
DIAMOND CIRCULATE..FLIP THE DIAMOND..
GIRLS TRADE..SWING THRU..TURN THRU..LEFT ALLE..

ZERO LINE..PASS THRU..WHEEL & DEAL & SPREAD..
TOUCH 1/4..TRACK TO A DIAMOND..DIAMOND CIRCULATE..
FLIP THE DIAMOND..GRAND RIGHT & LEFT...

ZERO LINE..TOUCH 1/4..TRACK TO A DIAMOND..CENTER LADIES TRADE..
THE WAVE..SWING THRU..FLIP THE DIAMOND..
BOYS RUN..REVERSE THE FLUTTER..CROSSTRAIL THRU..LEFT ALLE..

ZING:

Zing was a quarterly selection at the advanced level earlier in the year and if you take the advanced notes you may wish to refer to the Oct. 1981 issue...The call ZING has several possible starting formations but all have the following rules...From a tandem set up, that is a leader and trailer forming a twosome as part of another formation the call can be applied....The leaders will do a 3/4 zoom action, that is they will start the zoom and end facing into the center of the foursome as the trailers step ahead into the vacating leaders position and 1/4 Turn to face the center of the formation....

1. From Double pass thru formation....Zing ends in line facing in.
2. From a completed double pass thru formation Zing ends in lines facing in..
3. From columns, (each box has a leader, trailer) Zing ends in lines facing in.

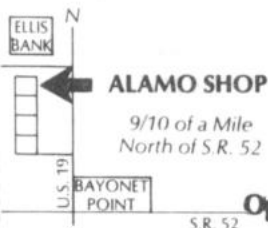

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

Here we are, everyone getting ready for a BIG Xmas, with all the parties, etc. and all looking forward to a brand new year and everything that it brings. The past year has been good for me and my Taw Winnie. We are enjoying life to its fullest, and we both hope that you are also.

One thing we should all keep in mind: The U.S. Congress voted to accept the "Western Style Square Dance" as our National Folk Dance. They gave it a trial of 2 years, 1982 and 1983 - so every one of us should keep this in mind and keep after them to make it permanent. One thing we should do is to keep square dancing before the public all the time, and to be sure that it is promoted at all gatherings, and at large malls, and that it is always shown to be exactly what it is, the "Family Recreation that has no age boundaries". Show them dancing from 9 to 90, or older.

RULES FOR CHAINING LADIES -

There are so many ways of chaining ladies, or the Equivalent to it. Back in the 30's and 40's we had only one way. You either chained them or you didn't and that was it. Today we have "Flutter Wheel", "Swing Thru and Turn Thru", and many others, if we add and mix up other Equivalents. As I mentioned in last month's material, the rule in those days was that the Head Gents MUST chain once with each of the Side Gents to equalize the square. After you got into it and were used to using it, you could change them around at will. One of the calls in those days was, from Line of Four - **Two Ladies Chain, You're doing fine. Now Turn and Chain 'em Down The Line.** Doing it like this, you would not only have your opposite lady

after the two chains, you would also not change the sequence at all. We can do this same thing today and use valuable basics in doing it. One of my favorite calls is something like this:

Heads to the Right & Circle to a Line Swing Thru across from you - Turn Thru

Bend the Line - Swing Thru across from you

Now - Turn Thru and - Bend the Line

And now each Gent has his opposite lady, and they are still in sequence, but we have made them listen, and we have given them some good basics to work with. Another one that I use, especially when the dancers are getting into Extended Basics, goes something like so:

Heads to the Right & Circle to a line 2 Ladies Chain - Square Thru 3/4's

Bend the Line - 2 Ladies Chain - Square Thru 3/4's - Bend the Line

The results are the same. The call is different, but in both cases the dancers are learning to know that they are going to be in lines of four, FACING OUT, after the calls, and that they do not go any further than this until the Caller tells them what to do, or where they will go.

Several months back I mentioned a get-out that I like to use when we have Gents with opposites and they are IN sequence. This will work right along with either of

4. From a split circulate box(zero box touch 1/4) Zing ends in an eight chain thru format.
5. From a single box circulate set up, Zing ends in facing couples...
6. The ends of two faced lines or waves can Zing...The ends end facing into the center.

For the average plus dancer I see zing working well from the Double pass thru & completed double pass thru formations...The column will take a little more walking for the average dancer to "see" the action...From the split circ. boxes it is rather a difficult action for many...The ends of two faced lines and waves is easily danced once understood....

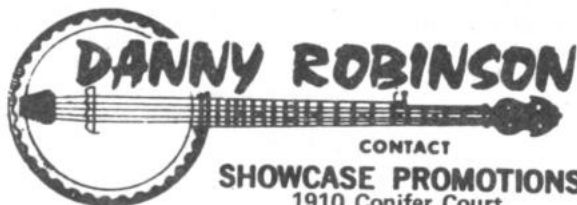

Keep in mind that the centers of waves or two faced lines can on paper do a zing, but it is really a bad call due to the close quarters of the dancers ...From three & one lines with ends facing in and centers in mini waves the ends can load the boat then the centers can zing and you have eliminated the congestion....

those setups I have used in this issue. I'll put one together and show you what I am talking about.

**Heads right & Circle to a Line
Swing Thru, Turn Thru, Bend the Line
Swing Thru, Turn Thru, Bend the Line
Star Thru - Dive thru - Pass Thru
Star Thru, Cross-trail Thru
Left Allemande.**

As I pointed out in an earlier issue, "Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru and - Star Thru" gives each gent the opposite lady from the one he started the sequence with. So if we start with the opposite lady, then the above will get your partner back again. OUT of Sequence, so Cross-trail Thru takes them right to their Corner lady for a Left Allemande. Practice on both of these.

Of course if you use "Flutter Wheel" you are going to have a change of Sequence, so be sure to keep this in mind. If we start IN Sequence, in lines of 4, and "Flutter Wheel", this will be the equivalent of a "Right & Left Thru, 2 Ladies Chain". So there is a change of Sequence in this movement. Keep this in mind. After using it like the above, you can call like this; "Pass Thru - Bend the Line - Right & Left Thru - Flutter Wheel - Bend the Line", and right now we are back where we started, so we can Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru -

Star Thru - Cross-trail Thru to a Left Allemande.

I am giving you things that are bringing you back to the point of beginning. If you find that "Flutter Wheel" and then "Bend the Line" are awkward for dancers to do, then add something and ZERO it out so that it is smooth. I show what certain things will do. Smoothing them out is something that you should always work on. Keep all movements smooth if you can possibly do so. One way to make it smooth would be to; **Right & Left Thru - Turn your girl and Pass Thru and - Bend the Line** - As I said, there are any number of Zero movements that you can use so you have a choice. You can add other things after the "Flutter Wheel" just to keep the dancers on their toes. How about this for making them listen to you?

**Heads right & circle to a line
Right & left Thru - Flutter Wheel
Square Thru 3/4's - Bend the Line
Right & left Thru - Flutter Wheel
Square Thru 3/4's - Bend the Line**

They are back to that point of beginning again, in Lines of Four, with Opposites, IN Sequence.

I have given you several that will work for you. Dream up others on your own and - **Do have fun. Thank you for your efforts in the Square Dance World and have a Merry, Merry Xmas.**

DANCING NOTES

MORE ON PAT SQUARES

I have been reading the articles in Bow & Swing on Pat Squares. Some of them made me laugh, but the article in the November issue made me boiling mad.

When I started square dance lessons, we were told how friendly square dancers were. They were glad we were taking lessons and the Angels were most kind and helpful to us. If at that time I had read Bow & Swing on Pat Squares, I am sure I would not have continued to take lessons. If I had read the November issue when I moved down to Florida, I would *not* have danced in Florida. As for the Bread & Butter dancers, if it weren't for our winter visitors, the economy of Florida would go down the drain, including square dance clubs. If they don't want the winter visitors to dance with them, why don't they make their club a closed club. See how long that would last.

I am so thankful to all the experienced square dancers that put up and helped us get thru when we started to dance at clubs. We in turn try to be friendly, helpful and *kind* to all new dancers and visitors in our club.

I do think all clubs should have a workshop to polish off the rough spots before new dancers are taken in to the club membership. All new dancers need floor time to feel comfortable at a club dance.

I do not believe in Pat Squares, but I am guilty of accepting an invitation to join in one tip per night in a made up square. I do believe in dancing by numbers or a mixer tip.

"Sad and Disappointed"

Editors Note: We hope you won't be too sad and disappointed, since the letters in the November magazine were probably the opinion of only one person who wrote two letters in an effort to reinforce their position on Pat Squares.

MORE ON PAT SQUARES

I agree completely with the September editorial. Pre-squaring can ruin a club and it has the potential to ruin the whole activity. Club members have a responsibility



to dance with all comers and most of them remember that most of the time.

But: There is another side to this problem to be considered. Why do some dancers feel the need to pre-square? One reason is encountering dancers who have not adequately workshopped the figures and are completely unable to keep up with the level of the dance. After this happens many times, even a determined non-pre-squarer begins to have second thoughts. All dancers should check flyers or ads for the Callerlab level and attend only those dances at which they can dance comfortably. Everyone will have more fun - and this is supposed to be a fun activity.

If you pay careful attention to levels, you will have a more enjoyable evening and you will find the other dancers quite happy to square up with you. If you make a mistake and get into a dance that is all wrong for you, admit it and ask for your money back after the first tip. Save that money for another dance that you would like better. There is no reason to stay at any dance if you can tell right away that you cannot possibly dance and enjoy it.

Don't let anyone talk you into going to a dance or club - whether for a banner raid or otherwise - if it is far beyond the level you are used to. Don't be misled by: "Don't worry, the dancers there are so friendly - they can pull you thru." Or "If you don't get out and try, you never will learn." First of all, if the club is friendly now, it will seem even more so when you are competent to dance at the club level. And - don't worry - you will learn to dance at the level you choose by regularly attending one of the many workshops given by the callers in this area.

Careful attention to Callerlab levels is a courtesy we owe each other. And keep on dancin'!!

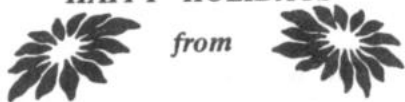

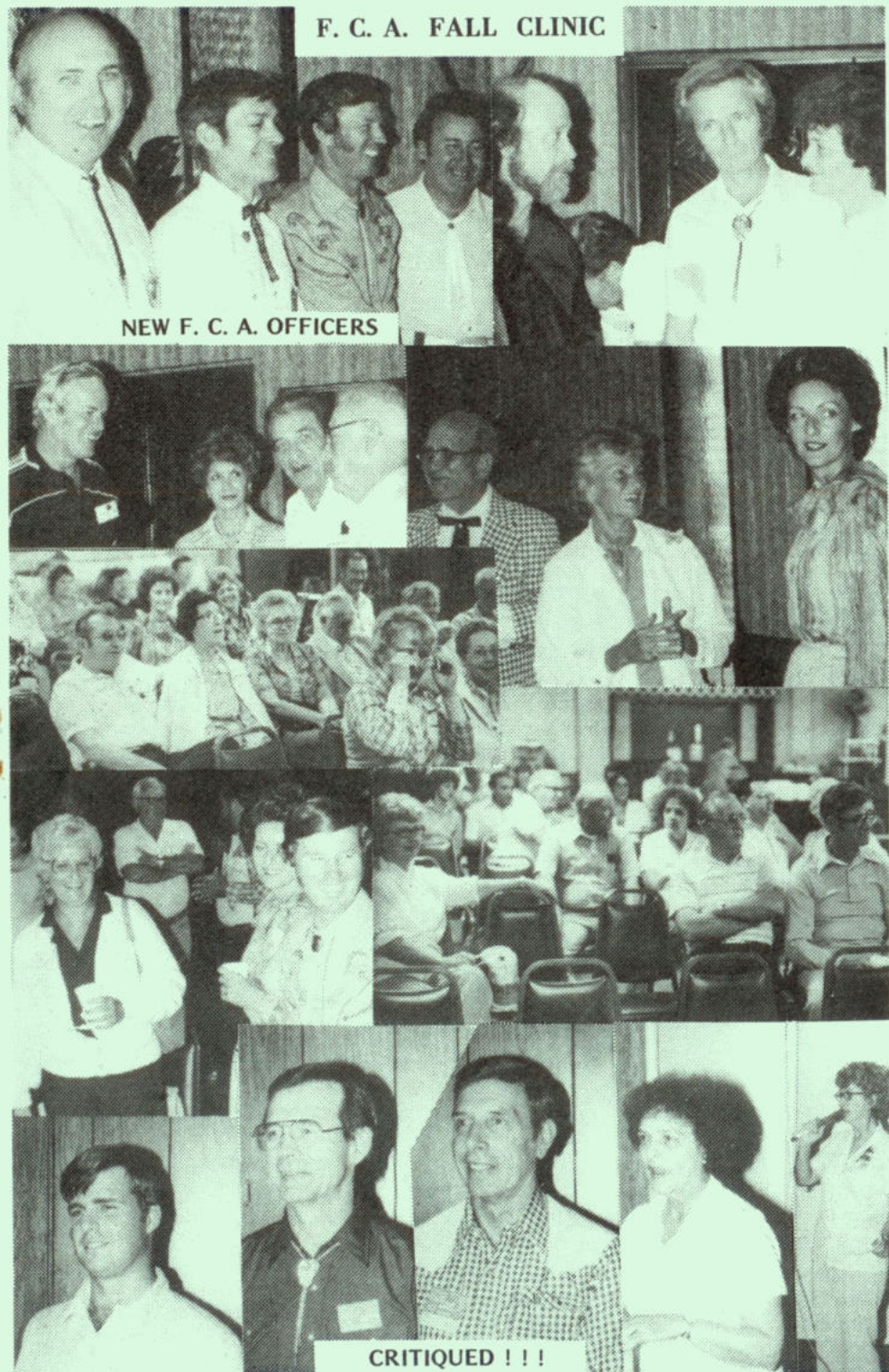

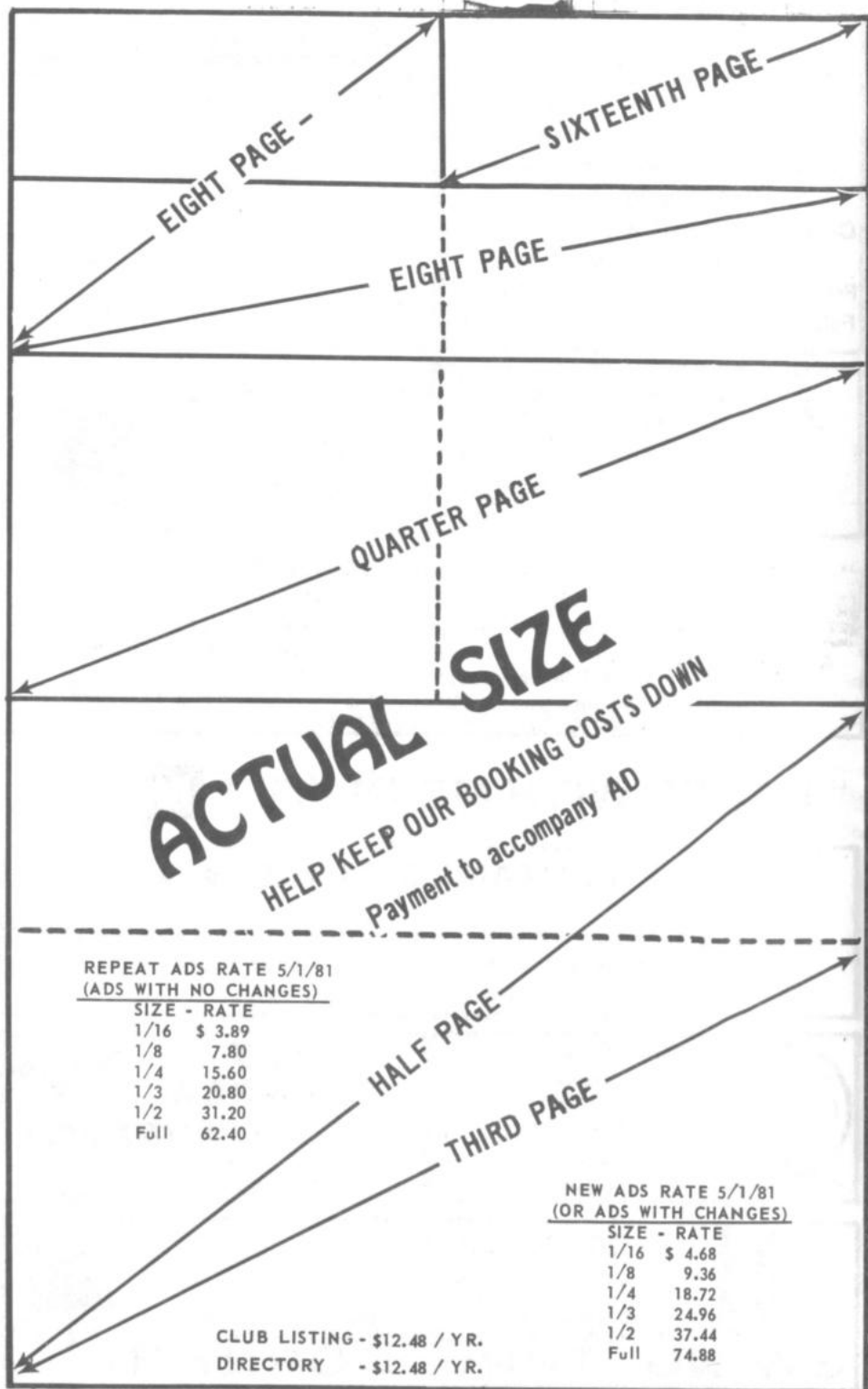
