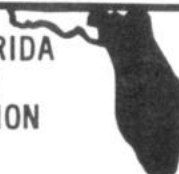

DANCING MAINSTREAM

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY:

Last month I mentioned that an obvious beginners weakness is his inability to do a SCOOT BACK from parallel ocean waves with boys as ends and girls as centers or visa versa.... The same is true with the call SPLIT CIRCULATE....Call a heads square thru and touch 1/4 then Split Circulate all is fine but from a zero box form a wave and call it and you will no doubt have a few real problems...Lets zero in on this area and work on it so our dancers will respond well...

I like to place the dancers in a zero box wave and have the girls drop hands and tell the boys to take the girl they are holding on to and slide apart from the other couple in their wave to leave a gap between them, I go on to say we have just built a wall between the couples and to do the call split circulate you must stay on your own side of the wall, I also have then locate their "box" of four that will do the split circ. and have them review the rules of the infacers walk across the street as the outfacers run right.. Walk the figure a few times then add the music then change the action into mixing scoot backs and split circulates and little by little they will become well acquainted and do well..

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills



I am designing this workshop material for the newer caller because there is an abundance of material for the more experienced caller, and, in my opinion, it is the newer caller who is in need of things that he/she can do easily. These are things that can be called without walk-thru's with the dancers. One of the first things a caller should school himself/herself on is the fact that a dance does not have to be complicated to be interesting. How you put your dance together is of much importance.

To begin with, SEQUENCE is very important and this first article will show you how to use it and how to recognize it. If you are just beginning to use Sequence and want to try it out, you can do so very easily because your dancers do not know that you are experimenting. Sequence means everything to the caller - nothing as far as the dancers are concerned. The dancer has learned to listen (we hope), and does as the caller directs him to do. It is the caller who must watch the Sequence and I intend to make that part of it easy.

You can recognize Sequence and keep going as far or as little as you like. Just be sure you do not get yourself into a jam by going too far and forgetting where you are.

Callers most always say that the dancers are either IN or OUT OF SEQUENCE. This is really not true. The dancers can be just HALF OUT, or you might say, HALF IN SEQUENCE. For example, should you have couples 1 & 2 do a Right & Left Thru, the dancers would now be ONE-HALF OUT OF SEQUENCE. Couples 1 & 2 are OUT OF SEQUENCE, but couples 3 & 4 are still IN SEQUENCE.

If you are just beginning to work on Sequence, this would be a good place to start. You can use this without any walk-thru's whatsoever. I often use this with dancers, even Mainstreamers. It sometimes shocks them, especially if they have not had it before:

1 & 2 DO A RIGHT & LEFT THRU
NEW 2 & 3 DO A RIGHT & LEFT THRU
NEW 3 & 4 CROSS-TRAIL THRU
AND EVERYBODY DO A LEFT ALLEMANDE.

Let's look at what is happening here.

When we had 1 & 2 do a Right & Left Thru, these two couples were OUT OF SEQUENCE. Then when we had the new 2 & 3 couples do a Right & Left Thru, this moved the original number 3 couple into the number 2 position. Both couples have been moved one position to their LEFT, but they are IN SEQUENCE. At this point the original number 1 couple and the number 4 couple are OUT OF SEQUENCE.

So right here we have the new number 3 & 4 couples Cross-Trail Thru and then have everybody do a Left Allemande. That's all there is to it. Very simple, but the dancers have to listen to the caller because you could just as easily start off with couples 2 & 3 instead of 1 & 2. Or you could start with 3 & 4. Change it and start any way you want, being sure you don't get yourself into a predicament.

Something else I use with my groups, and they like it because it makes 'em think. I explain before I start, "What I'm going to call works from wherever you happen to be". "Forget all about your starting position - this call means from the position you happen to be in at the time the call comes".

We've said when 1 & 2 does a Right & Left Thru, we have the set ONE HALF IN and ONE HALF OUT OF SEQUENCE. Now at this point if we have 3 & 4 do a Right & Left Thru, then all dancers will be OUT OF SEQUENCE. Also, we could have Heads or Sides Cross-Trail right here and do a Left Allemande. You can go on and on or you can shut it off at any point. Just be sure you know where they are. Try something like this:

	Sequence
1 & 2 DO A RIGHT & LEFT THRU	($\frac{1}{2}$ out)
3 & 4 RIGHT & LEFT THRU	(all out)
New Sides RIGHT & LEFT THRU	(all in)
3 & 2 RIGHT & LEFT THRU	($\frac{1}{2}$ out)
4 & 1 RIGHT & LEFT THRU	(all in)
4 & 3 RIGHT & LEFT THRU	($\frac{1}{2}$ out)

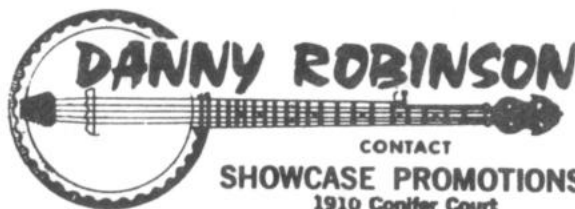

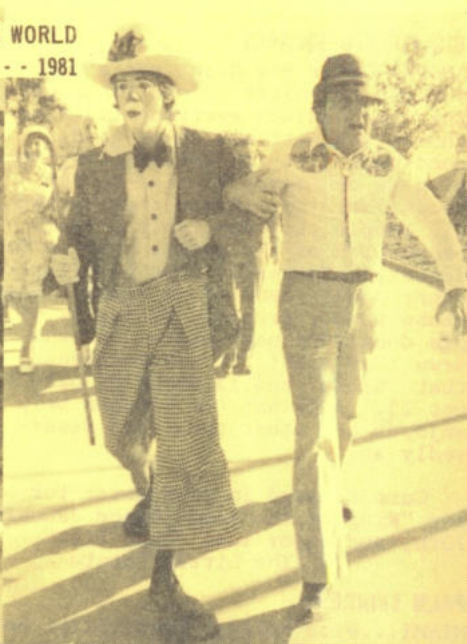

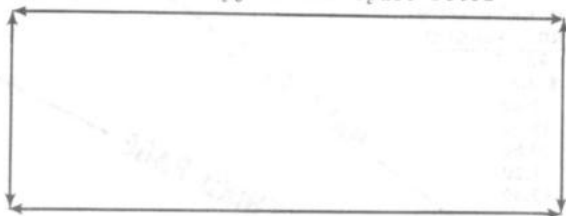
