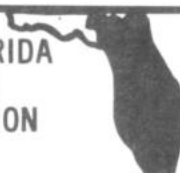

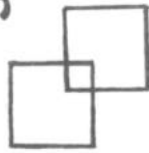

SQUARE DANCING DECLARED ★ U.S. NATIONAL FOLK DANCE ★

Nan & Frank Habersberger of Pembroke Pines, Florida, traveled to Washington, D.C. to take part in a Reception for Congressmen to promote passage of the bill to make Square Dancing the National Folk Dance of the United States. They have provided us with this very interesting report of their trip.

★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★

Nan and I arrived in Washington D. C. on Monday afternoon, April 26th and called on our Florida Congressmen who had not yet committed themselves to Co-Sponsorship. We gained another two to make 14 out of the 15 Florida Congressmen as Co-Sponsors. By Tuesday morning, the computer read-out showed that, Nation-wide we exceeded the required 218 sponsors and the Resolution was out of Committee and ready for the vote. That afternoon, after giving Square and Round Dance and Clogging demonstrations at the lower West Terrace of the Capitol, we all went into the Gallery of the House of Representatives in the hope that our Resolution might be voted on. Unfortunately, the Resolution was not scheduled due to some of the wording of HJR 151 not lining up accurately with that of the companion Senate version, SJR 59. After leaving, the Campaign workers continued their efforts to obtain more Co-Sponsors to assure victory.

Florida called "Swing Vote" State

When we arrived at the Reception we met Mac & Mary McClure, Chairman of the National Folk Dance Committee and Ann & George Holser, Reception Chairman. They expressed thanks for Southeast Association's donation of \$50.00 towards Reception expenses. They said they were pleasantly surprised by the rapid gain in Co-Sponsors in Florida and called Florida the "Swing Vote State" in being a good influence in the campaign in the South-eastern States. The Presidents, Chairmen, and Committee members of all national organizations were present: U.S.D.A., Calterlab, Roundalab, Legacy and National

Square Dance Apparel Suppliers. The Reception was well attended by the Administrative Assistants, but only four or five Congressmen were free to attend. They all really enjoyed participation in the Square Dancing and enjoyed watching the Round Dancing. The Cloggers gave a very excellent exhibition. Someone said they were the Champion group from Tennessee and they were a delight to watch.

Pensacola Special Steppers Get Standing Ovation

The highlight of the evening was the Square Dance Demonstration given by Frank Cherry, Caller, and the Pensacola Special Steppers. These dancers are retarded young people and we were astounded by their skills. After doing "Load the Boat" and "Teacup Chain" they were given a standing ovation, and there wasn't a dry eye in the house. More than anything else we all tried to do, these youngsters reflected the very heart of our activity. We were sure that our guests would return to their offices next day convinced that ours was truly a fellowship of love and caring. We requested that the Florida Federation extend its thanks to Northwest Association, Frank Cherry and the Pensacola Special Steppers for this Demonstration of what the Square Dance Movement is all about. This Commendation was approved in a unanimous vote.

Square Dancing – National Folk Dance for 1982-1983 Becomes Law

On May 11, 1982, the House of Representatives, in a unanimous vote, approved the Senate version of SJR 59. On June 1, President Reagan affixed his signature, making it Public Law 97-188.

Plans are already under way by the National Folk Dance Committee and others concerned, to start the ball rolling for the permanent adoption of Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance of the United States.

Susan Elaine Adams, Kickoff Chairman, and I, as co-chairman, wish to thank

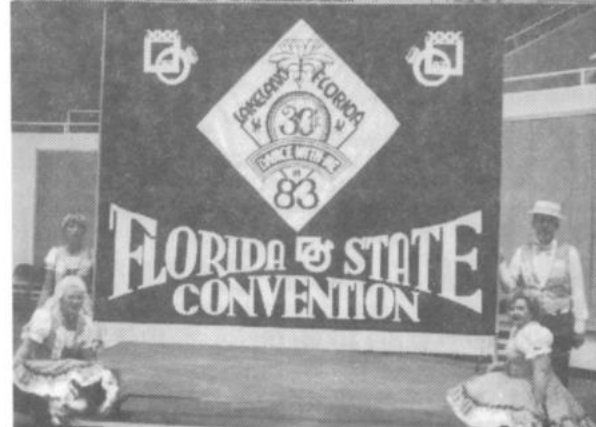
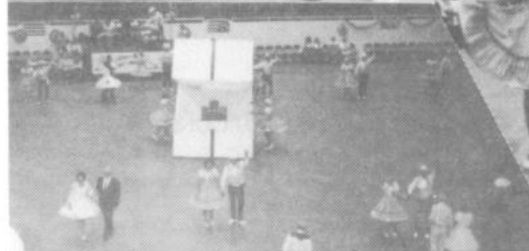
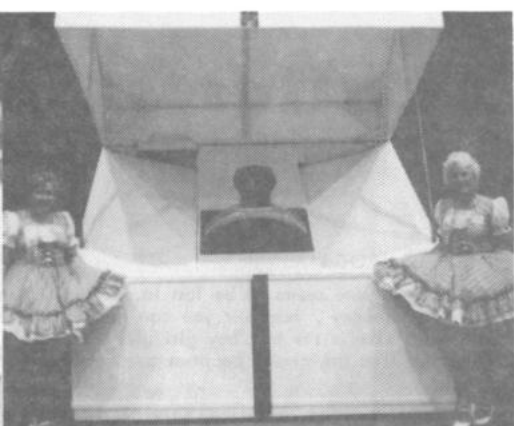

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

SCOOT BACK

I am sure that you have used "Scoot Back" but have you ever gone into it and broken it down to find out how many different places you can use it? Usually, I break everything like this down and see what it is equivalent to or how many equivalents I can come up with. We will break this one down this month and I'll give you some ideas and then you can come up with many more of your own. That's what these things are for — just see what all we can do with one basic and how many different ways we can use it effectively. As I have said so many times before, you can make changes all over the place by "Chaining Ladies" around so as to get them into a position you would like to start from. Let's begin like this:

Head 2 ladies chain to the right - right - right !!!!

The new side ladies Chain Across

The head 2 couples - Square Thru

4 hands around to the outside two

Then Curlique — The gents Scoot Back

Now Run to the Right around the girls

and Star Thru - Square Thru 3/4's around

Should find corner — Left Allemande

Remember several issues back we said that the "Head Ladies Chain Right - New Side Ladies Chain across" puts your original partner in the corner position. When Heads Square Thru, each gent is looking at his original partner, IN Sequence. Curlique puts gents facing IN, ladies facing OUT. The Gents Scoot Back and Run Right, is equivalent to a STAR THRU, so you could use anything at this point that you would use if you just had "Heads Wheel around out of a Promenade". That's it. Set up something like this:

Heads Curlique — Walk & Dodge

Circle up 4 — Head Gents break

Pass Thru — Boys Run to the Right

Boys Scoot Back — Than Run Right

Now All 8 Cross-Trail Thru

Allemande Left with your left hand.

If we stop and break that down we find

that PASS THRU —
BOYS RUN RIGHT —
SCOOT BACK —
RUN RIGHT
AGAIN — simply
equals a Right & Left

Thru from Lines of Four. I know that, and YOU know that, but you can be sure that the dancers don't have any idea that it's just equal to a Right & Left Thru. You have kept them busy listening to the call, and you have been using simple basics, and all they know is that you are keeping them moving, you are calling the basics and they know that they can do it if they just listen to the commands. This is Square Dancing. This is what it's all about — putting the Basics together, never the same way twice in a row. The dancers soon learn that you are capable of changing the basics around in different ways and they have learned that they can get through them all right by just listening.

Now we really make them listen. We are going to do the same thing from an "8 Chain Thru" position. Let's work this one from a Promenade Wheel Around and get into it like this:

Promenade now and don't slow down

The Head 2 couples Wheel Around

And — Curlique across from you —

Boys Scoot Back — Boys Run Right

Square Thru 3/4's — Left Allemande.

Got it? Look it over. Curlique, Scoot Back, Boys Run Right — That's equivalent to a Star Thru. In other words, if you would have them Star Thru and Square Thru 3/4's around to an Allemande Left, it would be exactly the same. So you can see that this is inter-changeable, and again I know it, and you know it, but the dancers don't have any idea what's going on. They are listening.

As a rule, if you are calling a good, smooth dance, timing your calls so that the dancers don't have to rush, neither do they have to wait, you will find they are happy dancers, especially so if you are

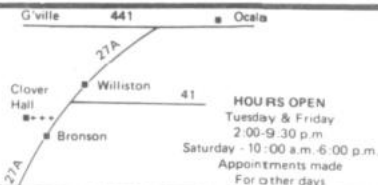

using a lot of different basics and are not repeating them very often. A system that I worked over 40 years ago is to watch their hands all the time. Keep those hands reaching all the time. When they reach to do something with the Right Hand, this is the time to tell them what they are going to do with the Left Hand. Never let those hands drop, keep them UP and be sure that they are reaching. Never give the dancers time to think. If they think, they go wrong.

If you have a group of good dancers, say a group of FAIR PLUS I dancers, and if they are a group that like a bit of a challenge now and then, you might try something like this on them:

Heads Roll a Half Sashay
Pass Thru Across the Way
Chase Right — Scoot Back
Boys Run Right — Curlique
Boys Scoot Back — Run Right
Curlique — and Scoot Back

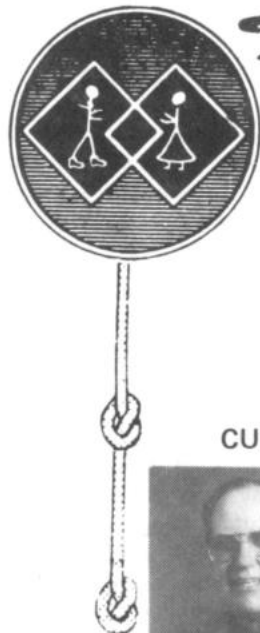

Universal Round Dance Convention

Attendees at the URDC National Round Dance Convention July 22-24 in Grand Rapids, Michigan can do plenty of sight-seeing. In Grand Rapids there are several projects just completed or under construction; including a multi-million dollar expansion of Grand Center (where the Convention will be held), a new Grand River Bank Park, Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum, new home for the Art Museum, downtown Monroe Shopping Mall, including a 20 million dollar hotel complex, the Grand Plaza (Convention headquarters) combining the renovated old Pantlind Hotel with new riverfront towers. Incidentally, there is an enclosed walkway from the Hotel into the Grand Center.

A highlight attraction in the center of the city's multi-million dollar downtown redevelopment project is the huge Calder Sculpture, "La Grande Vitesse" (the grand rapids or the great swiftness). This sculpture is 40 ft. high and weighs 42 tons. A three story county building is in the plaza and on its roof is a 127 X 127 foot painting by the late Alexander Calder. Nearby on the west lawn of the Gerald R. Ford Federal Building is a sculpture by Mark diSuvero.

Within the city limits, numerous golf courses open to summer visitors. The Grand River has been planted with Coho Salmon and is a productive fishing spot in the fall. Chinook Salmon and Steelhead are also taken from the River within a block or two of the city's downtown cen-

ter. One of the city's largest and most popular parks is John Ball Park, with extensive picnic and recreational facilities with terraced zoological gardens and some 350 animals. The West Michigan vacationland is within easy driving distance of Grand Rapids.

The city of Holland (about 30 miles s.w. of Grand Rapids) has an extensive resort development on the shores of Lake Macatawa. Excellent resorts, cottage colonies, restaurants, motels and lodges extend along the highway that skirts the lake. Along U.S. 31, Dutch Village is an attraction featuring Dutch Folk Dancing, craft shops, the Wooden Shoe Factory converts logs into wooden shoes. See the 200 year old Dutch windmill "DeZwaan". For those seeking campsites - Duke Creek KOA, Cedar Springs only 18 miles north of Grand Rapids (36 wooded acres), Grand Rogue Campground (75 acres), Belmont, Michigan, northern edge of Grand Rapids.

This is only scratching the surface. There are many other things to do, many lovely drives along the shoreline. When you are in Grand Rapids this July, with a little extra time, stop in at the Headquarters of the West Michigan Tourist Association at 136 Fulton East, pick up a free map, and get all the travel and vacation information you need.

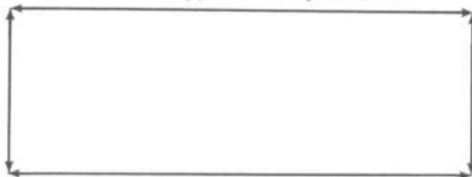
