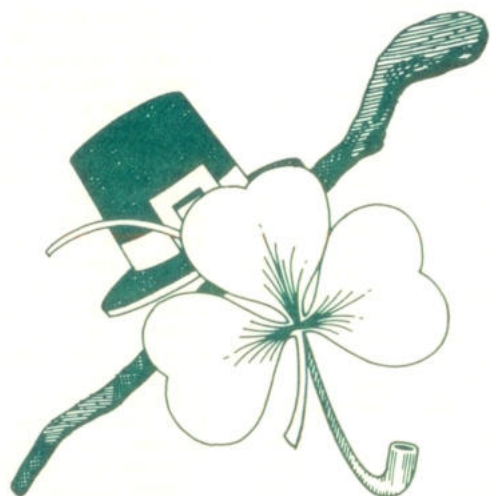

HOW TO WRITE CLUB NEWS

BOW & SWING is "Florida's State Square and Round Dance Magazine", and we would like to hear of anything your club does that would be of interest to the people throughout the state, and elsewhere (we have many subscribers in other states and other countries).

Because space is limited, club news must sometimes be edited to include only newsworthy items. However, do not be dissuaded from sending in lengthy newsletters. Some of the best hints and tidbits that can be of help to other clubs come from the longer letters.

If your club is not listed in the WHERE TO DANCE section in the back of the magazine, you should discuss this with your club officers. This section lists, by area, where a club dances, its level, day of the week, and a phone number where a visitor can get more information about your club. (Incidentally, a supply of *BOW & SWING* goes each month to each of the Florida Welcome Stations -- and the people who request information about Square and Round Dancing are given a copy, so your listing in WHERE TO DANCE is a worthwhile investment. The cost is only \$12.48 per year -- \$1.00 per month.

Because we have this WHERE TO DANCE section, we will, in most cases, delete addresses, times, dates, etc., from your news. This information more properly belongs in your WHERE TO DANCE listing. An exception to this is that we give more information about a brand new club.

If you are planning a special dance, we are happy to mention this in the Club News, but not prices of tickets, where to get them, or other items that should be in an ad. It would be unfair to our advertisers if all this information would be included "free" in Club News.

Everyone knows what the magazine deadline is. (We must start printing at the beginning of the month in order to get it to you on time.) Please don't tell about a dance that's coming up as though it had already happened. That makes "dull" news. Tell instead, interesting anecdotes about your last special dance.

ARE YOU GETTING YOUR MAGAZINE ON TIME?

BOW & SWING is usually mailed on the 25th of the month by CONTROLLED CIRCULATION MAIL, which is 2nd class mail. If you do not receive your copy within a reasonable period of time, please write

This is how you and other clubs get ideas on what to plan for your club in months to come.

Mentioning names of people celebrating special anniversaries or birthdays is fine, but we cannot list EVERYONE in EVERY club for each anniversary or birthday. There just isn't enough space. Many clubs have their own newsletters where this kind of individual recognition can be given. If your club does not have its own newsletter, why not plan to start one in '82?

We also don't often mention by name your callers or cuers. All clubs have a "Beloved Caller" or "Beloved Cuer" who also has a "lovely taw". (Your editors are even in that category). They all "call great dances" and are "friendly", etc. So we can assume all this if your club is having a good time, and leave it out of the Club News. This will save space for REAL NEWS.

Finally - *every time* you send in your articles, please identify them with the name of your club, the city or town where you dance, and sign them with your name (or a nom de plume will do). We sometimes receive news that is not properly identified and there isn't always time to play "detective" to find out the missing information.

Club News should arrive at the *BOW & SWING* office, 54 East Main Street, Apopka Florida 32703 by the first of the month to be included in the following month's magazine. For instance, we should receive it by the 1st of April for the May magazine.

We hope the above will be of some help, and we eagerly await your news. *It's the backbone of BOW & SWING.*

A sincere "thank you" to all the club writers who are so faithful with their club news month after month.

And we hope to hear from all clubs who have not been sending in their News.

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP FOR PLUS DANCERS AND ABOVE:

Z COORDINATE.....Kip Garvey.

I have had several letters requesting information on this call....I have held back from rushing it into the notes because I wanted to explore it fully and provide you with some VERY useful teaching hints....Mission accomplished so here goes...By the way I like the call very much as it dances well, times out well can be easily used from several formations and the rules hold true under all conditions.....

For a starting point I suggest the following set up.....

Zero Box..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..TAG THE LINE RIGHT...

From here I introduce Z Coordinate.....I have found that the following information is very helpful to the dancers and if repeated often enough over several weeks it really helps... Tell the dancers that the centers of the two faced line (boys) will extend as the ends of the line (girls) will slide side ways together.....This will set up a column of three pairs and the lonesome lead boys....The three pairs as in a coordinate will trade and the centers of that column will slide apart and move up beside the dancers in front as the lonesome lead boys move in a circulate action to become the other end of the forming two faced line.....

NOTE:.. We started with the boys as centers of the two faced line so that the ending action is the same as a basic coordinate from common columns... To get out call a wheel & deal and you will be back in a zero box.....

Tell the centers of your two faced lines that those dancers facing in will always extend and will become the center pair in the column of three pairs and they will ALWAYS be the dancers who after the trade portion will move apart and forward.....The center of the two faced line who are facing out...need to be aware which hand is forming the center of the two faced line...If it is the right hand as in our introduction figure after they extend their circulate will be to the right....If it is their left hand they will circulate to their left after they extend.....ENDS OF LINES OR WAVES WILL ALWAYS SLIDE TOGETHER, TRADE AND FREEZE.....

If the action starts from a two faced line you end in a two faced line, if started in a wave you end in a wave. You can even use Z coordinate from 3 & 1 lines of a specific set up...

Z COORDINATE FROM TWO FACED LINES:

ZERO BOX..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..TAG THE LINE RIGHT..

Z COORDINATE..FERRIS WHEEL..CENTERS PASS THRU..LEFT ALLE..

ZERO BOX..WAVE..GIRLS TRADE..RECYCLE..VEER LEFT..COUPLES CIRCULATE..

TAG THE LINE RIGHT..Z COORDINATE..FERRIS WHEEL..

ZOOM..SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE....

Z COORDINATE FROM THE DIXIE STYLE WAVE:

I find this formation to be the second one I explore....

ZERO BOX..SWING THRU..SPIN THE TOP..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..

DIXIE STYLE TO A WAVE...Z COORDINATE...(starts in a wave ends in a wave)

RECYCLE..LEFT ALLE....

ZERO LINE..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..DIXIE STYLE TO A WAVE..

Z COORDINATE..GIRLS RUN..WHEEL & DEAL..GRAND RIGHT & LEFT....

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills



If the Caller understands that the very same basics, when tied together, can be used in just about any position you want to use them, he can then vary his calling by using the very same change, or set-up of changes from several different positions. I am going to set up three ways to use the very same call. The call I am going to use is **SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP - SQUARE THRU 3/4 AROUND TO A LEFT ALLEMANDE**. Three different positions, all using the same call.

1. HEADS TO THE RIGHT & CIRCLE FOUR HEAD GENTS BREAK TO A LINE OF FOUR SWING THRU ACROSS FROM YOU
SPIN THE TOP - THE BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU - TURN YOUR SUE SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS AROUND SHOULD FIND CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.
2. THE HEAD TWO COUPLES SQUARE THRU FOUR HANDS TO THE OUTSIDE TWO SWING THRU NOW AND WHEN YOU DO SPIN THE TOP - THE BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU - TURN 'EM TOO SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS AROUND RUN TO THE CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.
3. HEADS/SIDES WILL SWING THRU NOW SPIN THE TOP - BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU, TURN 'EM TOO SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS NOW SHOULD SEE CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.

The important thing I am trying to point out right here is the fact that you can use that very same call from any of the three positions. You can use it one way in a tip, then in another tip you can use it differently, and then another way in another tip and as far as the dancers are concerned, you have used a variation of calls. They do not realize that it is the same call you are using. This works very well from a Promenade Wheel Around, Wheel either Heads or Sides around and, they are actually in lines of four, so just go ahead and call **SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP, BOYS MOVE UP - RIGHT & LEFT THRU AND SQUARE THRU 3/4 TO A LEFT ALLEMANDE**.

EQUIVALENTS

If we wanted to go still further and ask the question "What is all this equivalent to?" It is equivalent to a **STAR THRU**. In other words, if we have them do **SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP - RIGHT & LEFT THRU** - we would have the same thing as if we had just called a **STAR THRU** to begin

with. Interesting? These things are always interesting. That is why I always want to know what a set-up is equivalent to. Check everything out and see what each thing is equivalent to and then you will have a more thorough knowledge of what you can do with it.

Many times I find that Mainstreamers seem to have trouble doing **SPIN THE TOP**. This is probably because Callers have not taken the time to break it down and find out what all they can do with it. This is not fair to the dancers. A Caller should make it his job to see that his dancers can **SPIN THE TOP** from anywhere he wants to call it. When we first ran into **SWING THRU** way back in the 50's, the first thing we found out was the fact that **TWO Swing Thrus** equalled a **RIGHT & LEFT THRU**. This made it easy for us to use. We knew that we could do anything from **TWO Swing Thrus** that we could do from a **RIGHT & LEFT THRU**. This is what Callers should do with each and every maneuver. Break it down and find equivalents that can be used.

I am sure that each of you knows that **TWO Spin The Tops** is also equivalent to a **RIGHT & LEFT THRU**. So this means that **TWO SWING THRUS** and **TWO SPIN THE TOPS** are exactly the same as far as equivalents are concerned. This gives the Caller room for expansion. If you were going to use **TWO Swing Thrus** and then **Cross-Trail Thru** to a **Left Allemande**, you could just as well have used **TWO Spin The Tops** and the result would be the same. We must keep in mind though, **ONE Swing Thru** and **ONE Spin the Top** are not equal. **TWO** of each are equal, so watch yourself when using them unless you are doubling them each time.

SIGHT CALLING

Let's just take a short look at **Sight Calling**. I worked out my own method when I really got into calling back around 1948. My method then, and still is today - I watch the #1 man and the #4 lady. Of course I have to be sure whom each of them have for a partner so I will know when they are back together if I have moved them around - and I usually do move them.

We MUST remember that we are concerned with the **MEN** only, as far as sequence is concerned. The ladies have no bearing on

Henry Ford brought to the average family a mode of transportation that has become an integral part of American life for the past 50 years. His Model A Ford, which became the peoples' automobile, will celebrate its 50th birthday in 1982.

Henry Ford also published a book just over 50 years ago, and hired a dance master to help bring a style of old fashioned dancing back to the average family, and this too has become an integral part of American life - our Modern Western Square Dance.

In celebration of both these anniversaries and our American heritage, we are planning an extended trip in 1982, leaving Key West, Florida in our 1930 Model A Ford and driving to Fairbanks, Alaska and return, traveling through all 50 states, and square dancing in all 50 states as well.

We will leave Key West at the end of February, driving through the southern states to the West Coast, then north with a four day stopover in Reno in early April to attend CALLERLAB, the International Square Dance Callers Convention. We will then continue north to Seattle to visit friends and relatives. We hope to ship the Model A from Seattle to Honolulu, fly over ourselves, pick up the car and enjoy a few weeks in Hawaii.

On our return to Seattle May 10th, we will head for Alaska by way of the ferry system to Haines, then drive the Haines and Alaska Highways to Fairbanks. From there we will drive to Anchorage for more relatives and friends, returning to Seattle about the last week in June.

We plan to travel through the mid-west, arriving in Minnesota in time for the 1982 Model A Ford Club of America National Convention. From there we will go to Dearborn, where we hope to attend an Early American Cotillion in Lovett

Hall, then to New England, returning to Florida down the East Coast some time in September or early October.

Since Charlie is a licensed "Ham" (K4HMZ), we will be carrying a two meter radio as well as CB, and look forward to getting in touch with Model A or Antique Car Clubs, Radio Clubs, and Square Dance Clubs, or just saying hello to lots of people along the way.

The trip officially begins on February 27th, dancing with the Key Kickers of Key West (Henry Purcell calling), where we'll get our U.S. 1 badges, then leaving the next day and driving up the Florida East Coast, dancing with old friends in Melbourne, then to Tallahassee where Marshall Flippo is calling with Elmer Sheffield - then we head west, dancing in Mobile on Monday, Ocean Springs, Mississippi on Tuesday, and Baton Rouge,, Louisiana on Wednesday.

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills



If the Caller understands that the very same basics, when tied together, can be used in just about any position you want to use them, he can then vary his calling by using the very same change, or set-up of changes from several different positions. I am going to set up three ways to use the very same call. The call I am going to use is SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP - SQUARE THRU 3/4 AROUND TO A LEFT ALLEMANDE. Three different positions, all using the same call.

1. HEADS TO THE RIGHT & CIRCLE FOUR HEAD GENTS BREAK TO A LINE OF FOUR SWING THRU ACROSS FROM YOU SPIN THE TOP - THE BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU - TURN YOUR SUE SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS AROUND SHOULD FIND CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.
2. THE HEAD TWO COUPLES SQUARE THRU FOUR HANDS TO THE OUTSIDE TWO SWING THRU NOW AND WHEN YOU DO SPIN THE TOP - THE BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU - TURN 'EM TOO SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS AROUND RUN TO THE CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.
3. HEADS/SIDES WILL SWING THRU NOW SPIN THE TOP - BOYS MOVE UP RIGHT & LEFT THRU, TURN 'EM TOO SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS NOW SHOULD SEE CORNER, LEFT ALLEMANDE.

The important thing I am trying to point out right here is the fact that you can use that very same call from any of the three positions. You can use it one way in a tip, then in another tip you can use it differently, and then another way in another tip and as far as the dancers are concerned, you have used a variation of calls. They do not realize that it is the same call you are using. This works very well from a Promenade Wheel Around. Wheel either Heads or Sides around and, they are actually in lines of four, so just go ahead and call SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP, BOYS MOVE UP - RIGHT & LEFT THRU AND SQUARE THRU 3/4 TO A LEFT ALLEMANDE.

EQUIVALENTS

If we wanted to go still further and ask the question "What is all this equivalent to?" It is equivalent to a STAR THRU. In other words, if we have them do SWING THRU - SPIN THE TOP - RIGHT & LEFT THRU - we would have the same thing as if we had just called a STAR THRU to begin

with. Interesting? These things are always interesting. That is why I always want to know what a set-up is equivalent to. Check everything out and see what each thing is equivalent to and then you will have a more thorough knowledge of what you can do with it.

Many times I find that Mainstreamers seem to have trouble doing SPIN THE TOP. This is probably because Callers have not taken the time to break it down and find out what all they can do with it. This is not fair to the dancers. A Caller should make it his job to see that his dancers can SPIN THE TOP from anywhere he wants to call it. When we first ran into SWING THRU way back in the 50's, the first thing we found out was the fact that TWO Swing Thrus equalled a RIGHT & LEFT THRU. This made it easy for us to use. We knew that we could do anything from TWO Swing Thrus that we could do from a RIGHT & LEFT THRU. This is what Callers should do with each and every maneuver. Break it down and find equivalents that can be used.

I am sure that each of you knows that TWO Spin The Tops is also equivalent to a RIGHT & LEFT THRU. So this means that two SWING THRUS and two SPIN THE TOPS are exactly the same as far as equivalents are concerned. This gives the Caller room for expansion. If you were going to use TWO Swing Thrus and then Cross-Trail Thru to a Left Allemande, you could just as well have used TWO Spin The Tops and the result would be the same. We must keep in mind though, ONE Swing Thru and ONE Spin the Top are not equal. TWO of each are equal, so watch yourself when using them unless you are doubling them each time.

SIGHT CALLING

Let's just take a short look at Sight Calling. I worked out my own method when I really got into calling back around 1948. My method then, and still is today - I watch the #1 man and the #4 lady. Of course I have to be sure whom each of them have for a partner so I will know when they are back together if I have moved them around - and I usually do move them.

We MUST remember that we are concerned with the MEN only, as far as sequence is concerned. The ladies have no bearing on

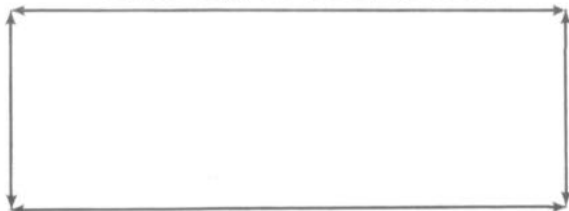
