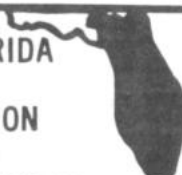

## 1981 DANCERS QUESTIONNAIRE

4280 dancers from all over took time to fill out the 1981 dancers questionnaire survey. The results have been tabulated and all comments have been extracted, categorized and assembled in book form for review by interested persons.

The dancers' concerns for the overall activity is highly evident in their responses. Briefly, there is a strong demand for increased emphasis on square dance etiquette. Callers sticking to the announced level of dance and fewer new figures were 2nd and 3rd among dancers' concerns.

The 1981 questionnaire repeated the 1980 request asking dancers to rate 14 aspects of the activity on a +5 to -5 scale. By repeating this section in future surveys and comparing results, trends in dancer attitudes may be spotted. Dancers are expressing more concern over the cost of our activity. "Learning new things" and "Challenge" has dropped in the plus ratings, but "pleasure of dancing" still remains high.

In addition to the overall results and the comments, computer runs have been made to compile the data for each state in an easy-to-read format. Organizations or editors desiring a copy of their state's report and/or the national figures should contact LEGACY Executive Secretaries Don & Vera Chestnut, 2149 Dahlk Cir., Verona, WI 53593. These are available at cost. A separate summary of the convention questionnaire results has been forwarded to the National Executive Committee.

LEGACY extends its appreciation to Jan

Brown for the long hours spent at her computer and to her son, Sam, for writing the program. Special thanks also to the dancers who took time to give their input. LEGACY plans to continue conducting this survey every two years.

### TWO GROUPS QUESTIONED

The questionnaires were distributed in two groups, one to those attending the National Convention in Seattle and another by LEGACY members to dancers in their local area (40 states). Information requested was the same in both groups except that convention-goers were asked how often they danced and at what level, while the others were asked the number of years they had danced.

The first conclusion drawn from the program was that dancers are concerned about the activity. This was demonstrated by their responses. Despite very spotty distribution, 1395 conventioners took time to fill out the full page forms and added what amounted to 40 typewritten pages of comments on the backs. Local area dancers completed 2885 (30% response rate) and wrote comments that totaled 46 typewritten pages.

### SURVEY RESULTS

All comments were categorized with respect to the general thrust of the individual's thoughts. The results show the number of times that a subject was mentioned. A strong correlation was shown between the comments bearing on etiquette and the data on "desired changes" in the questionnaire summary.

The correlation between Convention and local dancers' data was so close that it would serve no useful purpose to examine them separately except in the few instances mentioned.

**Experience:** About 50% of the local dancers responding have danced 5 years or less. The largest group were two-year dancers.

**Frequency of Dancing:** The average dancer attending the Convention danced 5 times a month. The largest group attended 4 dances a month. 5% said they never dance and 4 people said they dance 30 times a month. Since this information was received only from Convention attendees, do not consider these figures as typical for all dancers.

**Level of Dance:** This information is based on Convention dancers only. The largest group said they danced in the plus levels (40%). The next largest group were mainstream dancers (23%). The remainder, in order, were Advanced (13%), Quarterly Selections (12%), Challenge

(4%) and Basic (2%). The missing 6% didn't indicate.

**Frequency versus Level of Dance:** 64% of Basic dancers dance 4 times per month or less. Because of the few responses (28), this data may not be valid. Of the 314 Mainstream responses, 66% dance up to 5 times a month. The two largest groups dance 2 or 4 times a month. 68% of the Quarterly Selections group reported dancing 6 times per month or less. The largest group (20%) danced 4 times a month. In the Plus Level, 67% dance 8 times per month or less. The largest group (18%) danced 4 times per month.

#### CHANGES DANCERS WANT

LEGACY asked dancers, "If you could change any two things about square dancing, they would be: —". The listed actions and responses (in%) selected by each individual are shown. The total per cent adds up to 190% because most people made two choices.

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

*Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills*

## BUILDING A BRIDGE

Quite a number of years ago when I was traveling all over the world calling and teaching, I had a system I used. I called it "Building Bridges" at that time, to myself that is, so I see no reason not to still call it "Building Bridges" today.


This is setting up something that you are going to use later on. I'll not go into real long set-ups so that you will be able to understand and see what I was doing and you can add to it as you go along. Let's begin with the static square and we will go from there.

I believe everyone understands that, if we have the HEAD Couples Square Thru 4 hands, each gent will be facing his original Corner lady, and the gents are IN Sequence. So we start right here. At this point we have everyone Star Thru and each gent will have his Corner Lady for his partner and they are IN Sequence. So good up to this point. Now, we can make changes by setting our square up before we do the Square Thru 4 hands. For instance, we can do it like this:

**Head two ladies chain to the right  
The new side ladies chain across.**

At this point we have the Head Couples Square Thru 4 hands around; then Star Thru. See what we have here? We have set it up so that each gent would be facing his original partner after the Square Thru. When they Star Thru, gents are with original partners and they are all IN Sequence. So at this point you could do anything you would do if we were to lead Heads to the Right and Circle Four, or if you were to have Heads Wheel Around out of a promenade. They are actually in Lines of Four, IN Sequence, so there are many things you can do right here. Now let us try another set-up:

**4 ladies chain, a grand chain four  
Turn 'em now and dance some more  
Then the head 2 couples square thru**



At this point we have set the square up so that after the Square Thru each gent will then be facing his **Right Hand Lady**. This means that we can Star Thru and we will have Right Hand Ladies for partners and everyone is IN Sequence. One nice little thing that you can have them do right here is this — after the above would be, **Star Thru**, then —

**Now Square Thru across from you  
Count 4 hands and when you do  
Right to Mother, pull her thru  
There's old corner, Left Allemande.**

Keep this in mind. The above will always work when you have the **Right Hand Lady** for a partner and everyone IN Sequence. Here is still another way you get that very same set-up. Try it. Just get your dancers into a promenade and tell them "Promenade, don't slow down, and keep on going," and "Oh yes, **Listen to the call.**" Then you can call, **Gents Roll in a Left Face Whirl; Promenade now with a brand new girl.** We have set them up with the **Corner Lady** at this point. We said awhile back that a good way for gents to get the opposite lady from the one they are with is to have them — from **Lines of Four**, Star Thru, Dive Thru, and Pass Thru, then Star Thru. This is the same as Four Ladies Chain. So going back, we had each gent promenading along with his **Corner**. Now we will have them,

**Heads Wheel Around and - Star Thru  
(out of sequence)  
Then Dive Thru and - Pass Thru  
(still out)  
Pass Thru and Bend the Line  
(back IN Sequence now)  
Square Thru across from you  
Count to four and when you do**

## TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

(Continued from Page 20)

**Right to Mother, pull her thru**  
**Here comes Corner, Left Allemande**

I have set up things that are easy for you to watch and this will enable you to get used to using these changes. After that you can go on and get just as complicated as you want. I quite often use something like this when I am calling to Mainstream Dancers:

**Head 2 Ladies Chain to the Right**  
**The new Side Ladies Chain Across**  
**Now 1 & 3 will Square Thru**

(each gent looking at partner)

**Curlique - Then Scoot Back**  
(boys are doing the scoot back)

**Boys Run to the Right around**  
**his girl**

**Star Thru - now Square Thru 3/4's**  
**Should find corner, Left Allemande.**

The **Flutter Wheel** is a good way to change ladies around so that you can get the gents with the lady you want them with. Unless we change our set-ups to be-

gin with, from a Static Square we always have the Head Gents with their Opposite Lady for a partner, after the Heads Square Thru. Quite often I want to have everyone with their partner after the Square Thru, so, instead of just chaining the Head Ladies to begin with, I will have **Head Couples do a Right & Left Thru, then Flutter Wheel**. Now when I have the Heads Square Thru 4 hands, we have the dancers in an 8-Chain Thru position, but each gent is with his original partner, and there is a lot you can do from here - Let's look at just a few things from that set-up. We can have them -

**Swing Thru - Girls Trade -**  
**Boys Trade - Turn Thru,**  
**Left Allemande - - - - -**

Or,

**Right & Left Thru - turn 'em**  
**Swing Thru - now Turn Thru**  
**Allemande Left . . .**

Give these a good try. You can take just those few and build quite a batch of bridges.

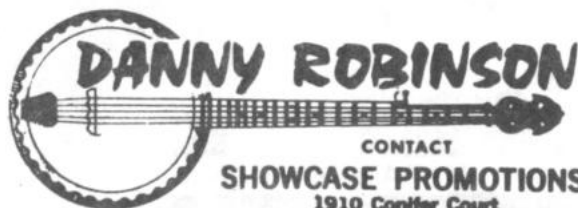

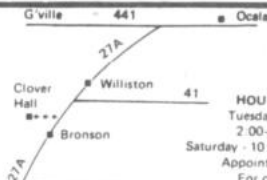

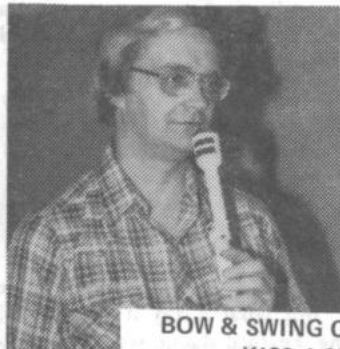

### ETIQUETTE & DANCE LEVELS CONSIDERED MOST IMPORTANT

Almost 38% of all dancers picked "More emphasis on dance etiquette". Add this fact to the strong concern about dance floor behavior shown in the comments and it looks like we'd best be "minding our manners".

"Callers sticking to the announced level of dance" came out a strong number two item of concern, followed by "Fewer new figures". There may be some overlap in the areas of "More emphasis on levels of dance" and "Callers stick to the announced level of dance." If so, the 19% and

31% figures could mean the true measure of concern about following the level program more closely is somewhere above 31%.

The last section of the questionnaire asked dancers to rate 14 aspects on a +5 to -5 scale.

The rather strong downward trend in overall response may indicate growing dancer dissatisfaction. Notice that "cost" is becoming less attractive as prices go up. "Learning" and "challenge" dropped more than the average overall response. "Pleasure" is hanging in there good.

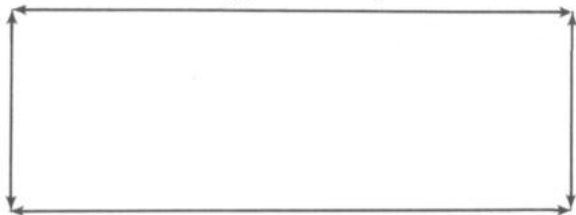
