# DANCING NOTES



## RE: "PAT" SQUARES

*BOW & SWING* received only two letters this month regarding "Pat" Squares — both from Ft. Myers, both on the same day, both unsigned, and written on the same stationery. You can draw your own conclusions about that. Even though they were unsigned, we decided these opinions should be aired, and so are reprinting them here.

Be sure also to read the article "The Right Hand of Fellowship" in this issue by Frank & Nan Habersberger. This article was originally destined for *SETS IN ORDER*, but Frank & Nan, upon reading our September editorial in *BOW & SWING*, felt it would add to the intent of our editorial and graciously gave us permission to use it instead of *SETS IN ORDER*.

Frank & Nan feel that our "Snowbird" guests should be considered in our thinking since they and the dancing fees they donate for a night's dancing are a financial necessity for many clubs in Florida.

### LETTER NO. 1 —

"We definitely think the callers are causing problems for the year around "Bread & Butter" dancers by allowing the Winter Visitors to join in a club of higher level dancers. Most of these dancers do not even finish taking lessons when they head for the north. While up north they seldom get much dancing in and seldom improve. These dancers should remain at the fun level. Keep Pat Squares."

### LETTER NO. 2

"Thank you for allowing your readers to express their opinions. My own opinion is that the Callers are at fault when they permit couples to join a club when they are not really ready for that level. Too many couples only dance during the Winter months, then leave for the summer for 'home' to play at the lake or etc. These couples are not properly trained nor do they have enough 'road time' and will always 'louse' up squares.

"I don't believe in the number system 100%. Maybe for 2/3rds of a dance. At least let couples make up squares for 1/3

of the dances. This way the better dancers can enjoy part of the evening with their friends. Nothing turns good dancers away more than being 'stuck' with dancers who should be dancing at a much lower level. That's my opinion."

Plans for the Northeast Florida Square Dancers Assn. 29th Annual Fall Roundup November 12th and 13th are proceeding full speed ahead. Under the chairmanship of Norm & Joyce Farrell, a full program of square dancing through the Advanced Level as well as Round Dancing and Clogging are scheduled to meet all tastes, plus workshops in all areas. In addition, additional space for dancing has been obtained this year, allowing for a fuller program for dancers under less crowded conditions.

# Caller's Corner

## JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



### EXPERIMENTAL WITH MAINSTREAM POSSIBILITIES:

DIAGONAL STAR...Tom Sellner.

The idea Diagonal Star starts from any facing couple, for our introduction I will keep all facing couples in normal boy-girl positions....The Teach is simple, have the Heads start things off as your basic pair...Heads Go Up & Back...Have the Boys look at their diagonal opposite in the other couple which will be the other man, do the same with the girls. Tell the heads that they will end up in the diagonal opposite dancers foot prints but will remain facing the wall directly in front of them....Now the Heads form a Right Hand Star and star diagonally into the directed opposite dancers foot prints as they drop their hands out of the star ending across the set 1/2 sashayed.... Once the dancers learn to "eye ball" the diagonal opposite they find it east to star into the position.... The basic is useful as it will make 1/2 sashayed couples normal and is easily used with four boys or four girls.....

### GET AQUAINTED WITH DIAGONAL STAR:

HEADS..DIAGONAL STAR..SEPERATE AROUND ONE TO A LINE..

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

*Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills*

## MORE ON SIGHT CALLING

This time we will work on lines of four and the thing that we are going to be looking for is SEQUENCE. We will call "Heads right and circle to a line" and this does not change the sequence of the dancers in any way when we have Head Gents break and form the line. Sequence is easy to check at this point because you can see that the No. 2 Gent is on the right of the No. 1 Gent, so this means that the No. 4 Gent MUST be on the left, and this means that they are IN sequence. Now have the dancers do a "Right & Left Thru", putting the No. 2 man on the left of the No. 1 man. Easy you say? Sure it is.

These two "Lines of Four" positions are the first ones that I found way back in 1947 and as far as I know, no one ever thought of Sequence before that time. In fact, up to that point, all of the callers used memorized calls, and up to this point I was among the memorized or memory callers. There was nothing else. The caller memorized the call and the dancers memorized the dance. And if the caller called it any other way, the dancers would let him know that he had goofed.

Anyway, I wanted to know what was happening, so I started watching and I eventually developed the beginning of "Sight Calling". Here is what I watched for — When I had the dancers do the "Right & Left Thru" from lines of four, I noticed that the No. 2 man was what I called *Inside* the line and that he was looking at his corner lady, also *Inside* her line. I learned that I could Cross-Trail Thru to an Allemande Left from this position.

Shortly after this, instead of having the dancers do a "Right & Left Thru", I had them Pass Thru and Bend the Line. I saw that this would give me the same thing but that the No. 4 lady, the No. 1 man's corner, was now on the right end of the line and the No. 1 man was on the left end of the same line. So here were two positions that I could watch for. The No. 1 man, when *Inside* the line, was looking at his corner lady, but when he was on the End of a line, his corner lady *must* be on the other end of that same line.

At this point I had not come up with anything about Sequence. I just called it IN if they were in the position I wanted, and I called it OUT if they were not in the position I wanted. Of course, it did not take me very long to see that a "Right & Left Thru" would make the adjustment that I wanted. This was brand new to me but it was even newer to the dancers of that time. I experimented on them. I never told them that I was experimenting, but the fact remains, I was experimenting because this was new to me also. It was new to Square Dancing itself. This was something that the dancers could not memorize. They had to listen, and this was something the dancers in the 40's had not learned to do. Other callers had not started "Sight Calling" yet, so the dancers had not yet been pushed to listen.

I had to remind the dancers that what I was doing was something different and

that they would have to listen to me to be able to do the command. They seemed to like it. I liked it, and this is how it all came about. At that time it had not even dawned on me that a "Pass Thru and Bend the Line" was the equivalent of a "Right & Left Thru". This was an important "milestone" to me then because I did not have to depend on the "Right & Left Thru" to get the change I wanted. I could now use "Pass Thru and Bend the Line" and the result was the same.

Soon afterwards I discovered that I could go ahead and carry this just as far as I wanted to carry it. I would now be able to get them IN and then get them OUT again, and I would keep this going for quite awhile and then I would get them into one or the other of the aforementioned positions and "Cross-Trail Thru to a Left Allemande".

This was progress? At that time - it WAS progress. One thing that I would like to point out to you callers of today. There was no one to get help from at that time. Callers started writing to me and asking me questions about the things that I was doing. This is one reason that I started working so hard to come up with answers. Actually, I did not have the answers at that time. I knew how to do it, but explaining was something else again.

I had to have answers sooner or later, so I went to work on it. I really started to use my little pawns, making notes, making mistakes, but forging ahead until I came up with the answers that I wanted. This was not accomplished overnight either. Years and years went into it.

I started "Callers Colleges", putting cards on the backs and fronts of the No. 1 couple and on the No. 4 couple, showing each and every Caller that these were the No. 1 and No. 4 couples, then show how to get them IN and OUT of predicaments. Mostly OUT, because it has always been easy to get IN predicaments. - Not too long afterwards, I decided to go all the way and "Chain the Ladies" and work my way out from there. This was quite a risk because up to now I always kept each Gent with his original partner when experimenting. I soon found that I *must* have the No. 1 man chain with each of the side gents if I was going to equalize them. I would have the No. 1 man chain with No. 4 gent, from lines of 4, then I would have them "Chain down the Line" (that's an old call from those days),\* and at this point each gent would have his opposite lady for a partner. I would do a "Pass Thru" and then Bend the Line and start in to repeat the above, the No. 1 man chaining with each of the side gents again and now everyone was back with original partners. From here I would start doing my "Sight Calling" to find that corner lady on the right end of the same line with No. 1 man, or they were both Inside the Line facing each other, then Cross-Trail Thru to a Left Allemande.

Work on these line figures until you have perfected them before going on.

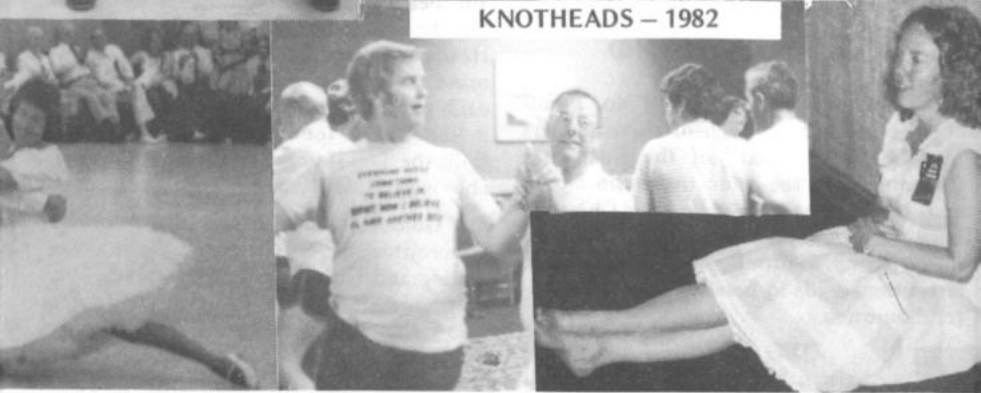

# CALLERLAB

THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION  
OF SQUARE DANCE CALLERS

## PQS PROGRAM INTRODUCED

At the Reno Convention, the membership of CALLERLAB voted to establish a new program called the Plus Quarterly Selection (PQS). It is aimed at Plus Program clubs and dancers who wish to expand their dancing to a limited degree but do not choose to enter into a more elaborate program. The PQS selection committee could help provide guidance to callers to help screen material that might be suitable for inclusion at Plus Program workshops.

The PQS program is designed to allow callers and dancers to dance new material suited to the Plus Program. However, not all clubs or dancers will desire this program. It is written in terms that presuppose a working knowledge of the Plus Program. For instance, the two calls selected for this initial offering include terminology of Track II as well as Diamonds. The PQS program will operate under similar guidelines as the Mainstream QS Program. Jerry Schatzer heads up this active CALLERLAB committee consisting of approximately 100 callers using Plus Programs. Any comments may be directed to the CALLERLAB office or directly to Jerry Schatzer at 1203 N Sweetzer Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90069.

Please note: There is no implied pressure by CALLERLAB that any caller or club should use this material if the group is not ready for it. Caller judgment is the key to the appropriateness of this material.

### TRACK TO A DIAMOND

(8 beats)

From columns, the No. 1 and No. 2 dancers do a Track II. Each of these dancers becomes one "point" of the final twin diamonds. At the same time, the No. 3 and No. 4 dancers Single File Circulate once (to a momentary box of 4) then Cast Off 3/4 forming an ocean wave. Movement ends in parallel, center-to-center diamonds.

### ZING (4 beats)

Starting from a DPT, completed DPT, or

Box Circulate formation, the leaders in each foursome do a Zoom 3/4 (270°), as the trailers step forward into the vacated spot, then turn a quarter to face the center of the foursome. Movement ends in facing couples.

## MAINSTREAM QUARTERLY SELECTION

The Mainstream Quarterly Selection for the quarter beginning 10/1/82 is not a new movement, but one which offers some interest to Mainstream dancers. It was first introduced before the call Pass the Ocean was written and the use of Pass the Ocean makes the figure easier for the dancers. The 64 beat timed figure permits the caller to use lyrics from popular tunes.

### GRAND SPIN — Ross Crispino

#### Starting Formation - Static Square

Heads Part - Pass the Ocean, Spin the Top, Star Thru, step forward and California Twirl at the sides of the square to become new sides.

Sides Part - Face your partner and back away (as in Grand Square - take three steps and turn on fourth step). Turn in and walk towards your opposite and do a Do Sa Do. Star Thru with that person and become the new heads.

Each part takes 16 beats to complete and each dancer will do each part twice to complete the figure. Four x 16.

The beauty of the figure is the dancing to the music. If the dancers take shortcuts, the beauty will be lost. When using this for the first time with a group, stress the Heads part, then the Sides part and remind the dancers that each person will do each part. As an aside - you can substitute a Slide Thru for a Star Thru after the Spin the Top if your dancers are comfortable with Slide Thru.

Cal Golden, former chairman of the QS Committee, has had to retire from active calling and Harold Bausch has taken over as Chairman, Harold requests all dancers and callers correspond with him for future selections in order to continue the excellent track record of this committee.

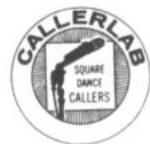

## CLASSES — NEW BEGINNING OR DEAD END?

The learn-to-square-dance time of year is here again, and the drive for new dancers to join Fall classes is in progress. It is a good time for each teacher to examine his or her goals in light of the realities of the environment in which he or she must operate. Presumably, each teacher wants to produce finished dancers who can cope in the real world of square dancing and who will be a part of the activity for many years. However, if national surveys of drop-out rates have any validity at all, it appears that the square dance teachers of the country are falling far short of that goal. Assuming the goal is valid, then perhaps we need to examine realistically the environment in which teaching takes place and make the necessary adjustments to reach the goal.

In many areas it is difficult to find time enough to cover the basics thoroughly on just the Mainstream list. Schools, where classes are held, close for holidays and the summer months; Harvest time brings about high absentee rates — the reasons for lack of time are many. There is no short-cut to effective teaching, and where time is now insufficient, more time must be found, or the goal for the year changed. Some areas have found it necessary and worthwhile to extend the teaching program into a second season; the Basic plateau the first season, summer practice at that plateau, and the Mainstream plateau the second season. These areas are turning out competent, happy, long-lived dancers. Perhaps individual lessons can be made longer, with care exercised to ensure that student fatigue does not make the extra time non-productive. Other quantitative measures to help solve the problem may be found. We also need to examine the quality of teaching, since copious amounts of poor teaching will not produce good students. One needs to prepare himself to teach. An in-depth knowledge of the subject to be taught, a broad knowledge of teaching techniques and learning principles, and a sincere concern for the students are pre-requisites for effective teaching. A good caller is not necessarily a

good teacher, just as a good teacher is not necessarily a good caller. Calling and teaching both are arts in themselves.

As we begin a new season of classes, we need to face the unquestionable fact that, with rare exceptions, new dancers cannot be taught to dance competently at the Mainstream level in 20 to 25 two-hour sessions. If classes are to be a new beginning in a world of square dance fun for our students, we need to improve qualitatively. Failure to do so simply makes classes a dead end, producing frustration, bitterness, and more drop-outs.

Upon graduation, the new dancers must be provided a place to dance at their comfort and confidence level. If the sponsoring club is dancing the Plus Program, ask yourself — "Where does the new graduate dance?" Certainly we cannot expect them to learn the entire Mainstream Program as well as some of the Plus Program. So again ask yourself, "*Classes — New Beginning or Dead End?*"

## CALLERS SEMINAR SLATED FOR NATIONAL CONVENTION

CALLERLAB will again be responsible for the annual Callers' Seminar to be held in conjunction with the National Square Dance Convention in Louisville, Kentucky on June 23, 24 and 25, 1983.

These seminars are geared toward all callers regardless of skill level or affiliation with CALLERLAB, and are staffed with CALLERLAB accredited Caller-Coaches whenever possible. The topics to be covered during the scheduled 12 hours of the seminar are taken from the CALLERLAB approved curriculum, and are decided upon by the CALLERLAB Executive Committee based on the expertise of those staffing the sessions.
