DANCING NOTES

REPLIES ON "PAT" SQUARES

We have had many and varied verbal responses to the Editorial on "Pat" Squares in the September issue of BOW & SWING. The majority of these said the article about this problem was long overdue. We hope more will respond by letter so that different opinions and solutions to the problem can be aired. We will withhold all names from the responses as we have done with the two following:

August 31 . . . Although we ourselves do not follow the practice, there is very definitely something to be said in favor of having squares made up in advance.

In a tourist/resort area like Florida, we have a constant influx of dancers from all over, with varying degrees of expertise. It is downright disgusting to have square after square break down because of poor dancers — *at any level*. Surely the proficient dancer is just as entitled to an enjoyable evening as is the bumbler. We are also faced with Spring Graduates who, after a summer of workshop, feel themselves qualified for an A-1 workshop. Here the caller is at fault. He should quietly tell such couples that they lack the experience necessary for the level.

The Number or Computer System helps by making sure that a few kind couples are not stuck all night with the poor dancers. There's plenty of time to socialize between tips.

August 31 . . . Just finished reading the editorial on "Pat" Squares and couldn't agree more even though we are guilty, to a degree, of sometimes forming such squares. There is one couple we see only at dances and have established a pattern of dancing the third tip with them whenever we are at the same dance. On other occasions we accompany new, apprehensive dancers and stay with them at their request for a time until their confidence increases as they find they can execute the figures as well as many others.

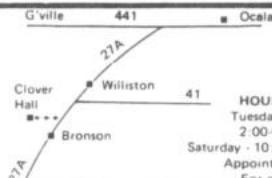

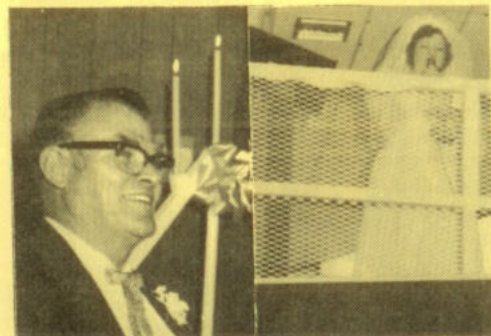

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP:

Recently Dick Bayer has come up with an experimental call, DIXIE SPIN CHAIN THRU, which starts with all dancers doing a Dixie Style to a Wave then the centers(boys) will cast off 3/4. the centers of the wave thru the middle will trade then with the adjacent end cast off 3/4 ending back in parallel left handed waves...The center action after the dixie styl= brings back an old action that has been lost and perhaps its time to bring back the action known as a FAN CHAIN THRU....WHICH MEANS FROM ANY WAVE OR TWO FACED LINE OR EVEN 3&1 LINES WITH THE CENTERS FACING OPPOSITE DIRECTION... The action means the centers will cast off 3/4. new centers trade. again the cast off 3/4... The action of a Fan Chain Thru was an outgrowth of the spin chain thru but without the initial ends turn 1/2....A dixie spin chain thru would then be called a dixie style to a wave then a FAN CHAIN THRU....You would not be limited to the use of the Dixie spin chain thru but by using a Fan Chain Thru you can apply the smooth flowing action to many basic formations.... Let me give you a few examples and then you see what you think!!!!!!

FROM TWO FACED LINES:

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..VEER LEFT..
COUPLES CIRCULATE..GIRLS FAN CHAIN THRU..
FERRIS WHEEL..CENTERS PASS THRU..ALL PASS THRU..LEFT ALLE...

ZERO BOX..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..TAG THE LINE RIGHT..
BOYS FAN CHAIN THRU..BOYS CROSS RUN..
BEND THE LINE..CROSSTRAIL THRU..LEFT ALLE...

ZERO LINE..PASS THE OCEAN..GIRLS TRADE..RECYCLE & VEER LEFT..
COUPLES CIRCULATE..GIRLS FAN CHAIN THRU..BOYS CIRCULATE DOUBLE..
FERRIS WHEEL..CTRS..SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE....

FROM WAVES:

ZERO BOX..DO SA DO TO A WAVE...
GIRLS FAN CHAIN THRU..RECYCLE..
SWING THRU..TURN THRU..LEFT ALLE...

We have had a real void of experimentals with any Mainstream value...Perhaps a GOOD look at an old smooth flowing idea is in order....What do you think.....

Like a spin chain thru, the ends are often directed to circulate double or once, well the same hold true with the fan chain thru...With the centers active the ends can circulate to use up the blank time....First however, get the centers to dance the Fan Chain Thru crisply then add the ends circulate action....Could add to the Fan Family that is not used enough at Mainstream....

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

SIGHT CALLING

Several months back I said that I was going to show you how easy "Sight Calling" is to do so this month we will get into that phase. To me this is the most important part of calling because you can stop memorizing figures and patterns and get right down to calling. I'll give you set-ups and explain HOW and WHY they work the way they do. I'll stop and break each one down so that it will be easily understood.

First I would like to point out that there are TWO different set-ups for each of these things I will show, especially if the dancers are in "lines of four", which would be different if you were to "Bend the Line". In the "8 Chain Thru" position we also have one position where the Head Gents are OUTSIDE and are looking IN, and another where the same Gents are INSIDE looking OUT. Let's break it down.

Heads to the Right,
Circle to a Line
Forward & Back
Then - Star Thru

At this point we have the Head Gents OUTSIDE looking IN, and they are looking at their Partner. Also at this point, the Men are OUT of sequence. From the "Static Position" and from "Lines of Four", a 3/4 Square Thru does NOT change the sequence. However, if the dancers are in an "8 Chain Thru position", a 3/4 Square Thru DOES change the sequence. A 1/2 square thru will change the sequence also, so right here we will find that second set-up by having the dancers do the 1/2 square thru, then Bend the Line and Star Thru. This position will

place Head Gents inside, looking OUT, still looking at their original partner, but they are now standing back to back with their corner lady. In that first set-up we said the Head Gents are looking at their partner, but failed to say that their original corner lady is on their right at this point.

The important thing to point out right here is that they can, from either of these positions, do a 3/4 square thru to a Left Allemande. We had better take time here to break it down.

When heads lead right and circle to a line, and star thru, the Gents are out of sequence. When we have them square thru 3/4, this puts them back IN sequence, ready to do that Left Allemande - So instead of doing the 3/4 square thru at that point, we will have them do a 1/2 square thru, bend the line and star thru, and we have them ready to square thru 3/4 to a Left Allemande. Keep in mind, they were OUT of sequence after that first Star Thru from lines of 4. The 1/2 square thru put them back IN sequence. Bend the line did nothing as far as sequence is concerned, but the star thru puts them OUT of sequence again, ready for the 3/4 square thru (which brings them back IN sequence) ready for the Left Allemande.

Let's break this same idea down more thoroughly. There are many things we can do with just this one set-up. For instance, instead of having them do a 1/2 square thru from that first set-up, we will have them do a FULL square thru. When we do this, then we MUST remember that we must add a Right & Left Thru somewhere

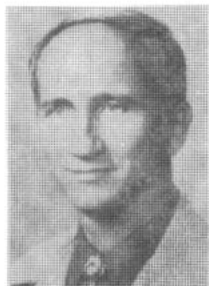

along the way to equalize the change. Keep in mind that the 1/2 square thru changes sequence, the FULL square thru does NOT, so we simply MUST add a Right & Left Thru to equalize what we are doing. An important thing to remember is that it makes no difference when you add the Right & Left Thru. Just be sure you add it somewhere along the way. If we decide to add it right at the beginning, we could call —

**Heads lead right and Circle to a Line
Star Thru
Right & Left Thru - Turn your Sue
Then Square Thru across from you
Now Bend the Line and - Star Thru**

This would give us the exact position we would have should we have called "1/2 Square Thru, Bend the Line, and Star Thru", not adding the Right & Left Thru. Of course you could wait to use the Right & Left Thru —

**Heads lead right and Circle to a Line
Star Thru
Square Thru across from you
Bend the Line - Right & Left Thru
Turn your girl and - Star Thru -**

Or it could be like this —

**Heads lead right and Circle to a Line
Star Thru**

**Square Thru across from you
Bend the Line and - Star Thru
Right & Left Thru - Turn your Sue**

As you can see, the thing I am pointing out here is the fact that it makes no difference when you add the Right & Left Thru. Just be sure you do not forget it along the way. This is where "Sight Calling" comes in. You can check your head man (or whomever you are watching) and see if he is outside looking IN, facing his partner, with his corner on his right, or you can check and see if he is INSIDE, looking out, facing his partner, standing back to back with his original corner lady. If he is in neither of those positions, then you must have forgotten to make that change in sequence. This is why "Sight Calling" is so important to know and understand.

I have said before that you do not use it all the time, just when you want to make sure. Also, as I have said, it is very important that you do try to learn and understand it more thoroughly. You can add to the above movements and set-ups by using some "Zero" movements while you do some practicing. Use such things as "8 Chain Thru across the track, all the way over and all the way back". There is no change at all in movements like this and it gives you the needed time to check your dancers and see if they are where you want them to be. See you next month.

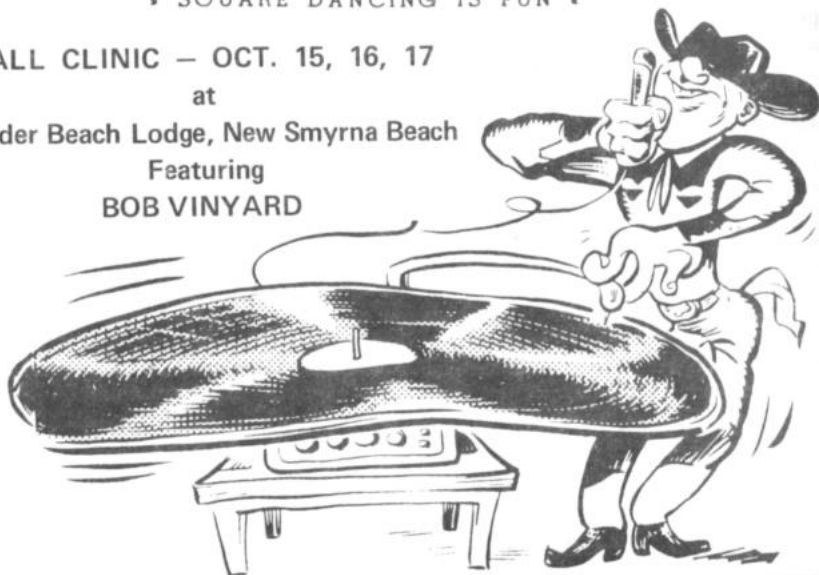

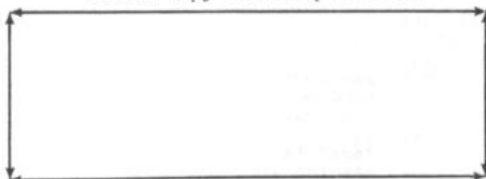
