FCA MEMBERS — Please remember that your 1983 Convention Availability notices are due to me by October 1. We plan to program the '83 Convention following our meeting on Sunday. If I do not have your availability notices by the required date, you will not be programmed for the Convention.

Once again, a reminder to new applicants to FCA — Attendance at a Clinic or school approved by FCA is a requirement for full membership; so you should plan to attend the Clinic in October.

For FCA Associate Members — If you wish to be critiqued for full membership at the Clinic, you should have your application to Earl Steele by October 1. If Earl does not receive these completed forms by October 1, you will not be critiqued at this clinic.

You can see that fall is a busy season for square dancing in Florida. Good luck with your new classes. Thorough planning will make them successful — and it's through our beginner sessions that square dancing will grow!

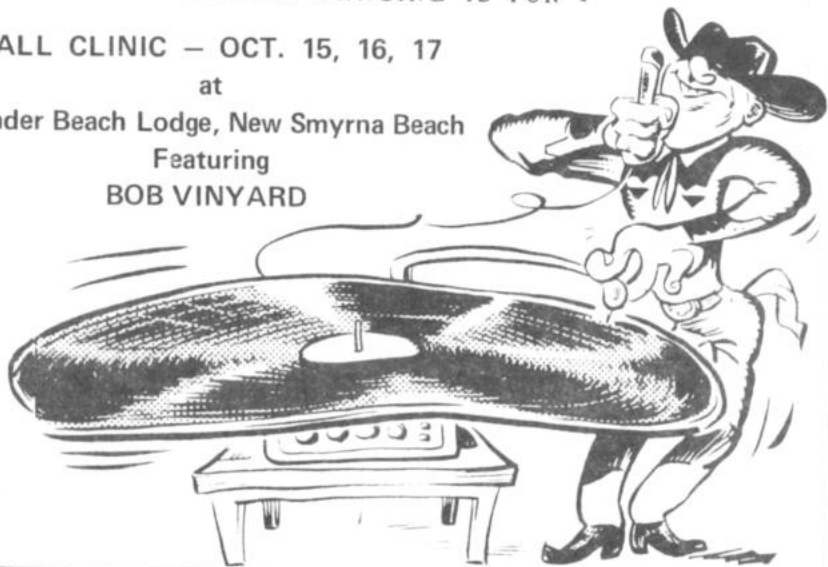

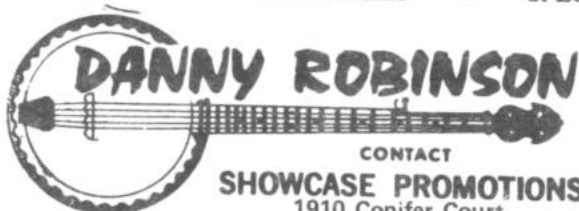
## **CONFAB HELD BY TWO ROUND DANCE ORGANIZATIONS AT NATIONAL CONVENTION**

What this means is that if you know of someone in your area receiving a new issue, you should also receive yours.

Should you fail to receive your magazine, you should first write us, showing your correct address, and we will check to make sure it is correct on the computer. WE WILL RESPOND to EACH INQUIRY of this nature. If the address is correct on the computer list, your next course of action should be to contact your local postman and/or your local Post Office. Don't hesitate to call your Post Office. If they can give you no answer for the delay of your copy, ask for PS Form 4314 which is a Consumer Service Card. Fill this out, following directions, and mail (no postage required). It is actually two cards - one goes to the local Postmaster and one goes to Washington, D.C. Now, the local Postmasters do not like to see these cards come in, because it means they will get inquiries from Washington, D.C. So this could generate a little action at the local level.

Once the mailing is in the hands of the Postal Service, we lose all control of it, and can assume no responsibility for anything not under our control.

# "PAT" SQUARES

## AN EDITORIAL

Back in 1910 John Bossidy made this memorable quote:

*"And this is good old Boston,  
The home of the bean and the cod,  
Where the Lowells talk to the Cabots  
And the Cabots talk only to God."*

This was aimed at snobbery. Are some square dancers becoming Lowells and Cabots? Skill snobbery seems to be rearing its ugly head, especially with the new popularity of more advanced forms of square dancing.

When we were taking our basic lessons, we were urged (or should have been urged) by our caller to "mix and mingle". This is where the camaraderie starts that makes square dancing such an enjoyable activity. You suddenly find you have an enormous circle of friends, all struggling to achieve the goal of becoming accomplished Mainstream Dancers. This "mixing and mingling" also helps keep the entire class near the same level of accomplishment.

Sometimes at Plus Workshops — and this gets more pronounced at the Advanced level where more than one club may be involved — a square of dancers from one club, or one area, may decide to attend a Workshop together. To be charitable, we might say they are too shy to square up with strangers in the new environment. In some cases, however, these people do not wish to square up with others for fear the others may not be apt learners, and they might not be getting their "money's worth". This group then becomes a little clique, and even in their home club, they may continue with their "pat square". They may even go so far as to keep their eyes open to find other dancers they think might be "eligible" for the "honor" of being asked to join them should one of their couples be ill or on vacation.

Maybe they are getting their "money's worth". Maybe they are having fun. But they miss one of the best advantages of square dancing — friendship. Their circle of friends becomes very limited. Sometimes other dancers will shun them for their lack of club spirit. Some, when asked if they will square up with a "pat square" in "the next tip", will even politely decline and say they do not believe in planning squares in advance.

We note some callers resort to passing out numbers to couples as they enter, and make up random squares to discourage this practice. This is more prevalent in the Advanced and Challenge groups. These callers are to be commended. They not only help ALL the dancers to have fun, but theirs are the clubs that are more apt to grow and prosper. These clubs also have more visitors, because they are made to feel welcome even if they do not have the skills of the best dancers in the club they are visiting.

**DANCERS** — If you are guilty of planning your squares in advance, you may think yourselves to be the best square on the floor, but you not only miss out on the friendship and love available through square dancing, but on another benefit. There is nothing more pleasing than the feeling you get when you have a "weak" couple in your square, and though it's a struggle, still manage to get everyone to their corner when that all important "Left Allemande" is called. You feel good — and the "weak" couple feels great! It can be the best tip of the night.

**CALLERS** — Keep your eyes open for "pat squares" sneaking into your club. Do something about it — for the sake of square dancing — for your club's sake — for the dancers' sake — and for your sake — for goodness' sake.

# Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



## THE PLUS PROGRAMS:

### INTRODUCING THE LEFT HANDED ASPECT OF PLUS DANCING:

Left handed usage of the basics is not a necessary part of enjoying square dancing, however the addition of basics from the left side invokes another aspect to our activity for the groups that enjoy variety and a bit of a challenge within the framework of a program such as we have with the 27 calls on the plus program....Most experienced mainstream dancers will do a LEFT swing thru when directed but few have the opportunity to really explore the left handed formations.... I like to start with a few left swing thrus, add a left spin the top, add a left spin chain thru and when things are going well I get into a left handed split circulate, scoot back, walk & dodge and left hand diamond circulates and a left handed flip the diamond into a left handed follow your neighbor and from there the gears and relay the deucey....A left handed crossfire is also there along with the left handed couples hinge & triple trade routines, so you can see there is alot of variety available without RUSHING INTO the advanced level... REMEMBER this stuff is often more difficult for the dancers then learning a new call from the standard position so GO SLOWLY and give the dancers a chance to enjoy the variety not get KILLED by it.....

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

## MORE ON EQUIVALENTS

I am starting this month off by using several basics that would be an equivalent to a "Two Ladies Chain". Let us say that I want to set up something where I will get the HEAD GENTS with their opposite lady. It would be very easy to say "Two Ladies Chain" but I don't want it to be that simple. I am calling to a "Mainstream" Group so I want to make it just a little more complicated than that. Use something like this to get them there:

**One and Three will Curlique  
Scoot Back, the boys run  
Star Thru - Flutter Wheel.**

Now I have the Head Gents back home, with their opposites for a partner. There are quite a few goodies that I can use from this set-up. I'll list some for you to try. Of course there are many more, but just try these. AFTER doing the above call, just add these to it:

**The same four will - Square Thru  
4 hands round to the outside two  
Right & Left Thru - Turn your Sue  
Then Swing Thru - and Turn Thru  
There's Corner, Left Allemande.**

Or,

**Those same four will Square Thru  
Count 4 hands and when you do  
You Swing Thru - the Girls Trade  
Now those Boys Trade - Turn Thru  
Here she comes, Left Allemande**

Or,

**Those same four will Square Thru  
4 hands now to the outside two  
Right & Left Thru - Turn 'em too  
Then Dive Thru and - Swing Thru  
Then Turn Thru - Left Allemande.**

When using these calls you can very easily add a ZERO movement to make it more interesting. Like so:

**Those same four will Square Thru  
4 hands round to the outside two  
Than Pass the Ocean - Recycle -  
Right & Left Thru - Turn your Sue  
and Flutter Wheel - and Star Thru**

Right at this point we have them back where they were after we completed the "Square Thru"; so "Pass the Ocean", "Recycle, Right & Left Thru, Flutter Wheel and Star Thru" is your "ZERO". You can also use that same ZERO movement from lines of four or from a Promenade Wheel Around. Just keep in mind that from Lines of Four you call "Star Thru" and at this point we have set them up to Square Thru 3/4's to a Left Allemande. You can add the above ZERO movement to it right after you have them do the "Star Thru". This is in Lines of Four, With Partners, and In Sequence.

**Star Thru and - Pass the Ocean  
Recycle - Go Right & Left Thru  
Turn 'em around - Flutter Wheel  
Move on around and - Star Thru  
Then Square Thru - 3/4's round  
And find corner, Left Allemande.**

To add even more, still using the usual basics, we can take it from those same Lines of Four and we can add the Curlique, the Scoot Back, Boys Run Right and Star Thru. The only thing you will want to remember is that the above equals a "Right & Left Thru", so, keeping this in mind, we ADD a Right & Left Thru somewhere along the line to compensate

for it. The best place to add it is at the beginning so that you don't lose your own self along the way. Something like this:

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line  
Forward and Back then — Star Thru  
Right & Left Thru across from you  
(now we have added it)  
Then Curlique and — Scoot Back  
Boys Run Right and — Star Thru  
Now Pass the Ocean — Recycle  
Right & Left Thru — Turn your Sue  
Flutter Wheel and When you're thru  
Star Thru and — Square Thru 3/4's  
Find old corner, Left Allemande.**

I have no intention of getting too complicated with this. After you have learned how you can get them into, and out of, certain set-ups, and you have learned several ZERO movements that you can add, then you can carry it just as far as you like. As I have said so many times before, there is absolutely no limit. You can turn and twist the basics all over the place just as long as you don't lose yourself. Also, as I have said before, IF the dancers know their basics, and if you are just calling ba-

sics, then there should be no problem as far as the dancers are concerned. It boils down to, "Are they listening"? If the answer is "Yes", then I remind them that I did NOT call anything that they did not know how to do because everything I called was just the plain old basics. Of course after that they don't have much of an answer and each one looks at the other dancer and tries to figure out who they could blame it on. Did you ever notice that almost every dancer on the floor figures, "I could have got through it all right if the other 7 could have made it". I suppose this is what we call Egotism, but actually it's good, because it gives them more confidence in themselves and they start listening to the caller more and more so as to be sure it's not themselves that goof up. This makes for better dancing for everyone there.

Dancers often ask me, "What is a High Level Dancer"? I always answer, "There is no such thing as a High Level Dancer. They are **High Level Listeners**."

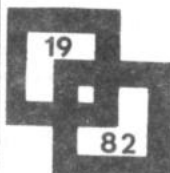

I wish Louise and Bill Roundtree the best of everything in their new venture! A whole new life with a world of pleasure and adventure.

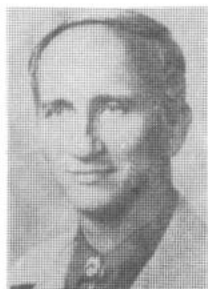

**FLORIDA FEDERATION OF SQUARE DANCERS  
CHARTER MEMBER  
OF UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA**

The largest square dance organization in the world, United Square Dancers of America, Inc. culminated its inaugural year with the acceptance of eleven Charter Member organizations representing ten states and 110,000 square dancers. These are very strong credentials for an organization which is just one year old. The Florida Federation of Square Dancers is proud to be numbered among its Charter Members.

Florida is also well represented on the Executive Board of United Square Dancers of America with Joe Vaccari of Fort Walton Beach serving as Treasurer, and Walter and Esther Stoltz of Plant City serving as Historian for the 1982-83 fiscal year.

The USDA Annual Meeting was held in Detroit, Michigan on June 25, 1982, concurrently with the 31st National Square Dance Convention. Among the major topics discussed and adopted was a plan for the development of a Square Dancers Museum and Hall of Fame to recognize those dancer leaders who have contributed to the development and advancement of the movement. Far too often the dancer is ignored for his many contributions to the growth of the activity. This project was one of the early goals established by USDA's Executive Board in 1981, and is now proceeding under the leadership of George and Judy Garland, North Carolina.

The Resolution adopted in Seattle at its 1981 organizational meeting, supporting the Square Dancers of America's Tournament of Roses Parade Float was reaffirmed in Detroit. In addition, a resolution was adopted to support the Annual National Square Dance Convention and to encourage member organizations to assist with its promotion.

A resolution acknowledging the importance of cooperation among the major na-

tional and international Square Dance organizations — Callerlab, Legacy, Roundlab, United Square Dancers of America, National Square Dance Convention, National Association of Square and Round Dance Suppliers, etc. was unanimously accepted. This resolution parallels one adopted by Callerlab at its 1982 Convention held in Reno.

Also at its June 1981 meeting, USDA supported the effort to achieve recognition of Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance. With the June 1, 1982 signing of the bill by President Reagan identifying Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance through 1983, efforts are now being directed toward the State level, for each State to also designate Square Dance as its Folk Dance.

In conjunction with having obtained acceptance of Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance, USDA is seeking further distinction for the activity through the issuance of a Postage Stamp depicting Square Dancing. Additional details will be available in the near future.

Among the most significant programs presented and adopted in Detroit was a National accident/liability insurance which provides the individual dancer with accident coverage, and the affiliate member organization together with its member clubs with public liability insurance. Complete details of this program, which takes effect as of January 1, 1983, will be available by September 1982 through Charles Naddeo, USDA Insurance Chairman.

The USDA 1983 Annual Meeting is scheduled for Friday, June 24, 1983 at the Executive West in Louisville, Kentucky — concurrently with the National Square Dance Convention. All interested dancers are welcome to attend these interesting meetings.

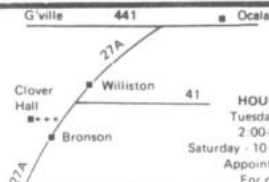

# CALLERLAB

*Editors Note: "Guidelines" is a monthly Newsletter sent to all Callerslab members. Your Editor felt this excerpt from the July, 1983 "Guidelines" would be of interest to all our readers . . .*

## NOT ENOUGH MATERIAL

One frequently hears that the reason dancers rush from one program to another is that they are bored at the level at which they are dancing and are seeking new challenge. Often, it is pointed out that, most likely, it is not the dancers who are getting bored, but that it is the caller who is getting tired of his own material, and is seeking new areas of experimentation, and is pushing the dancers to so-called higher levels of dancing. In either case, it would appear that dancers and/or callers run out of material too quickly at a level they are capable of handling comfortably. Is this really true? Or is it that callers just do not really investigate and use fully the material at hand.

In the early 1960's, Bruce Johnson conducted a clinic for a group of callers in Hawaii. The general theme of the clinic was, "What's The Hurry?" The tape of that clinic is as useful and as pertinent today as it was almost 20 years ago. Bruce made the point that there was plenty of material if we just learned to use it properly and with imagination and that there was no need to hurry on to more new material. At that time, there were about 30 basics. (Incidentally, classes were 16 weeks long.) Bruce said that if we danced regularly the rest of our lives, we could not possibly dance all the combinations of the basics that could be put together. That is an interesting statement and worthy of examination.

Let's look at the possible combinations of just 3 basics: Do Sa Do, Right and Left Thru, and Ladies Chain. The possi-

ble combinations of those 3 basics is  $1 \times 2 \times 3$  or 6. Using D for Do Sa Do, R for Right and Left Thru, and L for Ladies Chain, the 6 different ways to dance those 3 basics would be: D-R-L, D-L-R, R-D-L, R-L-D, L-R-D, and L-D-R. This example obviously oversimplified the situation, and dancers would soon get tired of doing just those three basics no matter how they were put together. However, the example does illustrate the point that there is great opportunity for variety without constantly seeking new material. In the course of one evening's calling, how many times do we get from a static square to a zero box with a square thru? There are many other interesting and smooth-flowing ways to arrive at that point, but they are neglected a great deal of the time.

Getting back to Bruce's statement that we could dance all of our lives without coming close to dancing all the combinations of the basics, even 20 years ago. It is interesting to play with numbers. For example, the possible number of ways to combine just 12 basics is  $1 \times 2 \times 3 \times 4 \times 5 \times 6 \times 7 \times 8 \times 9 \times 10 \times 11 \times 12$  or 479,001,600! If we use just 10 basics and dance 1,000 different combinations per night every night of the year, it would take almost 10 years to dance the 3,628,800 combinations.

Undoubtedly, many of our readers will be quick to point out that mere figures do not tell the whole story. Some combinations simply would not work because of hand position, body flow, and other aspects of good choreography. Of course, they are right. To suggest that we put things together just for the sake of seeing how many combinations we could get would be worse than suggesting that we always use a square thru to get from a static square to a zero box. Nevertheless,

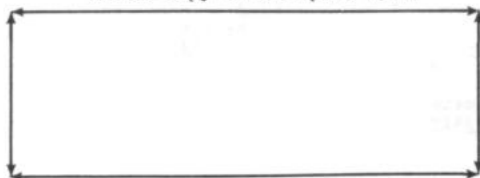
