Dear Fellow Callers:

Our big event in May is the State Square and Round Dance Convention. The Convention this year will provide a Co-ordinating Room. Your committee is asking for your full cooperation so it may work for you. It is your responsibility to check in on your arrival a minimum of thirty minutes prior to going on the program. This is the only way we can make substitutions smoothly for the open spots. The Co-ordinating Room is the only way a caller may be assigned to fill an open spot on our State program. If for any reason you cannot fill your assignment, please notify your committee prior to the Convention, in writing, if possible.

If a caller has not checked in at the Co-ordinating Room twenty-five minutes prior to his assignment, another caller will be assigned to fill his spot. A penalty has been voted on by the body for callers assigned to call on the State program that do not notify the committee that they cannot fill their assignments.

Being a good M.C. is a very important part of our program. When selected, be prepared to do the best job possible. There are many things a good M.C. can do to make a program a success.:

Arrive thirty minutes prior to the starting time.

Check sound system to be sure everything is working properly.

Familiarize yourself with the equipment so you can assist the caller who will be calling.

Have a program with the names of the callers listed.

Contact the callers as soon as possible.

Make a note on what to say about each caller and taw.

Keep it short.

Inform all callers how much time they have on the mike.

Keep the program moving as smoothly as possible.

After introductions, quickly move off stage and be available to answer any questions the next caller or dancers might have.

Be sure to listen for and observe any sound problems.

Looking forward to seeing you at the State Convention.

NORTHEAST FLORIDA SQUARE DANCERS ASSOCIATION (N.E.F.S.D.A.)

The N.E.F.S.D.A. is organized unlike some associations in that it does not accept individual memberships. Any square, round or clogging club/group within the Northeast area can petition and be accepted for membership into the Association. N.E.F.S.D.A. membership is currently at 30 clubs.

The N.E.F.S.D.A. bylaws state very clearly, its purpose for being in existence. That purpose is to coordinate the activities of member clubs in functions they cannot perform individually, and in doing so it strives to achieve the following goals:

1. Promote the growth of our hobby in the Northeast area and stress its importance as a wholesome family activity.
2. Take advantage of every opportunity for presenting to the public the fact that square dancing is one of the most enjoyable, wholesome and physically beneficial forms of recreation available.
3. Encourage the formation of new clubs and the development of new callers, and help them in every way possible.
4. Sponsor and promote association dances, which are held only on fifth Saturdays so as to not interfere with any member club sponsored dance. (An association fund raising promotion).
5. Sponsor and promote the annual Fall Roundup, an area wide weekend festival which brings the best possible callers and round dance leaders into the area. The Fall Roundup is currently being held on the third weekend in November.
6. The N.E.F.S.D.A. sponsors a bi-monthly publication, "The Grapevine". "The Grapevine" provides club news, articles of general interest, and announcements to area dancers.

For membership purposes the N.E.F.S.D.A. encompasses the counties of Flagler, Putnam, Alachua, Columbia and all counties in Florida, north and east thereof.

The election of association officers occurs in September of each year, with new officers taking office on 1 October. Voting is by member clubs with each club having one delegate vote.

The Northeast Florida Square Dance Association is constantly trying to find ways to improve our image with the general public, such as conducting benefit dances (example: "Christmas in July", Easter Seal dance, and many others). It also promotes other worthwhile activities; such as sponsoring the Blood Bank, which provides square dancers blood, if needed, and all possible means of conveying educational matter to dancers, especially to the new dancer. The latest endeavor in this regard is the "New Dancers Handbook", which is currently being put together for issue to the graduating classes in the Spring.

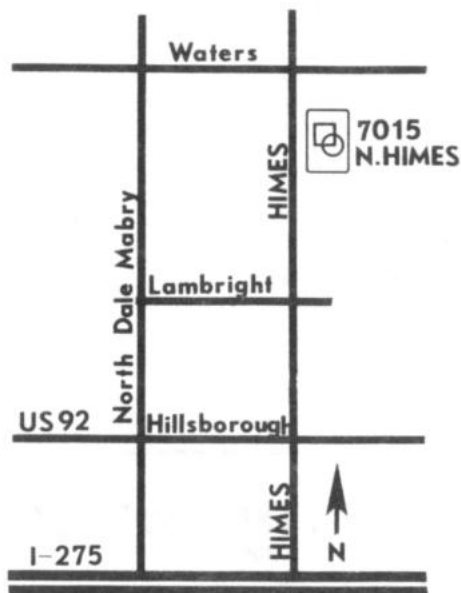

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

CHASE THE TAG...PLUS Quality Experimental...Ron Schneider

When Chase Right first came out there were quite a few variations but it has taken a few years for this one which seems to be quite logical...From back to back couples as if starting a chase right, the girls position will right about face and head across the set with the boys position rolling over and following the girls across the set. As in a tag the line, the dancers single file will cross the set and the call is over unless you wish to add the directional facing changes at the end such as Chase the Tag Right or Left, In or Out...

The availability to use a Chase 1/2 Tag or a Chase 3/4 Tag...Note, the Chase 1/2 tag is quick. Ron also includes in the family a Chase The Cycle...The ending action of the linear cycle with a peel to the right ending in facing lines. From this end it looks like a pretty good idea.

Zero Box..Touch 1/4..Walk & Dodge..Chase the Tag Right..
Boys Cross Run..Bend the Line..
Slide Thru..Left Alle..

Zero Line..Pass Thru..Chase 1/2 Tag..

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

TAG FIGURES

I have received several requests asking for something about *Tag the Line* figures and *Half Tags* - how to set them up - and especially how to get *out* of them after they are set up. I wonder how many of you knew that a *Tag the Line All the Way* is simply a *Double Pass Thru*? Of course the dancers do not know that they are in a *Double Pass Thru* setup when you call for the *Tag the Line* - because the call is followed up with something else that seldom ever takes them into couples. Try something like this sometime - instead of doing a *Wheel & Deal*, then a *Double Pass Thru* to a *Track II* - Set it up like this and watch the dancers do it very easily.

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line
Pass Thru - Boys Run Right to a
Wave**

**Swing Thru - Centers Run Right -
Tag the Line All the Way to a Track II**

Since most of my inquiries were about the *Half Tag, Trade and Roll*, how to set it up, etc., I will move right into that phase of the movement and see what we can come up with. Let's start off very easy - like this:

**Side Ladies Chain across the way
The same four Roll a Half Sashay
Now 1 and 3 will Curlique
Walk & Dodge and - Circle Four
The two men Break to a Line of Four
Forward and Back -
Then Half Tag, Trade and Roll
Left Allemande...**

That call could be *Two Men Break to a Line* or it could be *Head Men Break to a Line*, whichever. I am trying to keep this as

simple as possible, even though the *Half Tag, Trade and Roll* is not a very simple figure to work with. If you don't set it up, half sashaying someone, or do some figure that will create a half sashay for sides or heads, then you are going to end up by having gents facing gents and ladies facing ladies, and it could then become very complicated. So we will keep it simple:

**2 & 4 go Right & Left Thru
1 & 3 Cross-Trail Thru
Go up the outside, Go round two
Line of Four go Forward and Back
Half Tag - Trade - and Roll -
Star Thru - Then Bend the Line
Go Forward and Back - Star Thru
Then Dive Thru - How about a Zoom?
Those Center Four Square Thru
¾ Round, Left Allemande.**

I put a couple of forward and backs in that call simply because I was using *two* Star Thru's in a row, which is something you really should not do. It's much better to add something else and keep a forward motion as much as possible. Something like *Pass Thru - Partner Trade - Right & Left Thru* - Both are equivalent but the dancers are working and you are zeroing them out.

After awhile you will get used to working the *Tag* figures and you will find that you can go as far as you like with them just as you can go as far as you like with other figures that you use most of the time. Try one like this:

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

(Continued from page 20)

Heads to the Right and Circle Four
Head Gents Break to a Line of Four
Pass Thru now across the way
Gents Run Right and Make a Wave
Swing Thru - Centers Run Right -
Half Tag - Trade - and Roll -
Star Thru - Couples Circulate -
Wheel & Deal - Then Dive Thru -
Right & Left Thru in the center
Now Swing Thru in the center
Girls Trade - Boys Trade -
Turn Thru, Left Allemande...

When you, from lines of four, have the dancers Pass Thru, *Boys Run Right to a Wave - Swing Thru, Centers Run Right* You have set them up in *Two Faced Lines - Ladies with Ladies - Gents with Gents* - They are now in a perfect setup for *Tag* figures. You can have them *Tag the Line All the Way to a Track II* - or you can have them *Half Tag - Trade - and Roll*. If you started them out with their original partners in the Lines of Four, then when you have them *Pass Thru - Boys Run Right to a Wave - Swing Thru - Centers Run Right - Half Tag - Trade - and Roll* - you will have each Gent facing his original Partner - then you have them Star Thru - they are all back together, *and*, they are back *In Sequence* - so you could, at this point, have them - *Bend*

the Line, then Star Thru and Square Thru 3/4's around to a Left Allemande. Or, you could just pick it up right at that point, after you bend the line, go ahead and do anything that you would do from *Heads to the Right and Circle to a Line*. Just be sure of your Zero points, learning to watch at all times to be sure whether they are *In* or *Out* of Sequence.

Two points right here - if you are sure of your Sequence - and if you are sure who each Gent has as a partner at a given time, then you have the problem whipped. In fact, there is no problem.

We could go on and on with setups but you would only be memorizing them and that is exactly what we are trying to eliminate. Stand up there and put them together as you go. When checking to see who each gent has as a partner, keep this one thing in mind. If you know that the Head Gents have their Corner at a given time, then you can be certain that the Side Gents must have either their Corner Lady, or they *must* have their Right Hand Lady for a partner. The reason is the fact that there is no one else out there for him to have. It's just that simple. Simple deduction, my dear Watson, simple deduction.

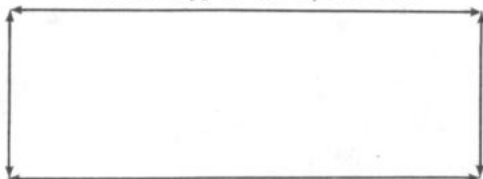
