# President's Message

## Florida Callers Association



• SQUARE DANCING IS FUN •



Can you dance what you call?

So often, when the Caller picks up the microphone for the first time, he or she ceases to think like a dancer.

We base our performance on a different viewpoint. Sometimes we forget what it is like to stand in a square while the Caller makes a lengthy announcement or give an extra long talk-thru. Worse yet, the Caller may have lost track of what is comfortable and what is awkward for the individual to dance.

Lucille and I recently attended a dance as dancers. We enjoyed the dance very much. However, Lucille's comment to me was, "Did you notice how many times the patter had you finish a movement with the right hand and the next call would start with the right hand?"

Much of today's choreography may look fine on paper and it may roll smoothly off the tongue. But dancing it is completely different. A Caller should dance regularly in order to understand what the dancer is going through. No matter how busy they are with their calling, they should never get to the point where they can no longer dance the material they call.

Possibly there is no better method learning the art of calling than to dance to another Caller and analyze the timing, patter and flow from the dancer's viewpoint. A Caller who gains this sensitivity by participating as a dancer stands a much better chance of becoming successful.

Some years back, I talked with Jack Lasry on this subject. He checks with regularity on his calling by dancing to tapes made at his dances. If you aren't taping your dances, perhaps you should. Dance to them and see if you sound like a Drill Sergeant rather than a teacher. Maybe you're teaching too much at your open dances. Your voice will sound different and it will help you understand your calling by dancing to yourself. Give it a try and let us know at our October Callers Clinic if this has helped.

Above all, remember — a Caller, as a leader, should take time to observe the actions of a successful Caller.

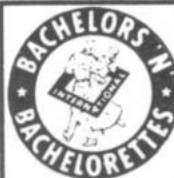

# BOW & SWING GOES TO NATIONAL

The final registration figures are in. Out of the 30,953 registered for the Thirty-Second National Square Dance Convention® at Louisville, Kentucky, June 23-25, 1983, 1211 were from Florida - the 8th largest representation of all the states.

This was my first National, although I have been a dancer for 10 years. Reports of problems encountered by attendees at some of the other Nationals kept my enthusiasm about attending one at a low ebb. I decided to go to the 32nd Annual mainly to attend the Press Breakfast for Editors and the Press Seminar, in order to find out what other publications are doing, in hopes of doing a better job for *BOW & SWING*. Other responsibilities kept George on the home front, so I went as a Single. *BOW & SWING* Photographer, Sunni Thomas, also attended with husband, Jerry, and took the many pictures you'll find in this issue.

For the many thousands of Florida dancers who, like me, have never attended a National Convention, this is what a first-timer encountered.

The hospitality of hosting group was marvelous. Everyone wearing the blue and green Convention outfit was most helpful to answer questions, solve problems, and spread good will.

Bus service to and from motels was dependable - always on schedule.

The facilities were unbelievable. There was plenty of room for whatever your choice of dancing was - at the level of your choice. No sound interfered with the sound from another dancing area. And still plenty of room for all the many educational sessions running concurrently, plus the Sewing Clinic Room which attracted most of the ladies, plus the huge area which housed the vendors, plus the cafeteria area.

I can't pass up the opportunity to enthuse over the cafeteria service. On the first day, it seemed everyone decided to eat lunch at noon and dinner at 6 PM so there was some waiting in the many cafeteria lines. But I saw no waiting during the rest of the Convention. People just naturally paced themselves and ate at different times.

The choice of foods was excellent. Several choices of meats, fish, vegetables, desserts, snacks - even fresh apples and ice cream cones were available. (My favorite was the Kentucky Catfish available every day.) Plenty of tables were available so foot-weary dancers needn't rush away after eating in order to make room for others.

One of the first places I headed for at the Fairgrounds was the "Showcase of Ideas", because *BOW & SWING* was represented there. I was amazed and proud of the beautiful display for our state. I believe it may have been the largest display of any state.



This was a great place to meet your Florida friends - not to mention getting acquainted with people from all over the world.



The display was always ably manned by Florida Federation officers and members, ready to answer any visitor's questions, and extolling the virtues of visiting our state to enjoy all the good things we have to offer. I don't think any Florida caller who attended

## EXPLORING THE 3/4 TAG THE LINE

The 3/4 Tag is not one of the most popular plus calls, however it will provide a lot of variety to the plus program and is useful in changing the dance formation. The 3/4 Tag is easily taught as a 1/2 Tag plus an extend. Another helpful hint is to tell the last dancer in the tag formation that they will form a wave thru the center and for the leaders in the tag formation that they will end the same as if doing a full tag, as the leaders. I prefer to start with two faced lines with boys or girls as the leaders and trailers so in the practice figures you can talk to the Boys or Girls...

*Zero Box: Swing Thru..Boys Run...3/4 Tag the Line...*ending formation is the leads facing out as the wave forms in the center...commonly called the 3/4 tag formation.

### Possible action for the leaders:

1. Stay there
2. U turn back
3. Partner trade
4. Clover Leaf
5. Partner Trade & Roll
6. Partner Tag
7. Partner hinge
8. Divide &
9. Face your partner (face in) or face right/left

### Possible actions for the wave dancers

1. Swing Thru
2. Spin the Top
3. Single Hinge
4. Fan the Top
5. Explode the Wave
6. Explode &
7. Recycle
8. Trade the Wave
9. Centers run/ends run
10. Turn Thru
11. Ends/centers Trade
12. Ends/centers Fold/Cross Fold

So you can really see a lot of variety is available to apply to the 3/4 Tag the Line

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

## DEMONSTRATION NUMBERS

Some of you might be called on to do demonstrations now and then so I thought I might give you some ideas along those lines, especially so since I was called upon to put on some numbers during the half-time shows at the Tampa Bay Bandits football games. Of course this would be their home games, not road games.

At their opening game, March 6th, Burt Reynolds and Jerry Reed were scheduled to be present - so they wanted us to use a Jerry Reed record from one of the Bandit pictures he and Burt Reynolds played in — "East Bound and Down." I'm sure most of you know the record - not the Square Dance record - the one with Jerry singing the number. There was to be no calling to the dancers. Everything had to be rehearsed and memorized for this reason: The Bandits had 40 girls in their cheerleaders group - there was also a nice group of youngsters, ages 7 to 12, known as "Just Kids". They are quite famous around here. They are from a dancing school, and they put on a nice show. I've worked with them on many occasions, and they always go over big.

Another school here puts on a nice demonstration of baton twirling, routines, etc. Now for the reason for no Calling. Each group had to work up a routine to the Jerry Reed recording. "Just Kids" put on their own version of dancing to the number, the "Cheerleaders" put on their own version, worked out by their instructor. The "Baton Twirlers" worked out a routine to the music, and it was my task to work out a routine for

the Square Dancers. We had 12 squares of Square Dancers, and also 4 squares of Cloggers.

I put 3 squares of dancers in each corner, one square between the 5 & 10 yard lines. I put one square between the 15 & 20 yard lines and another square between the 25 & 30 yard lines. This was the set-up in each corner of the field. In the center of the field were the 40 cheerleaders. On each end between the square dancers were 2 squares of the "Cloggers", and they added worked out their own routine to "East Bound and Down", and we were all doing our thing at the same time. It was a real show and it drew a great standing ovation from the 43,000 plus spectators who were there for that first game.

When doing demonstrations, you need something that is different, and unusual, and I mean that it should be different for any Square Dancers that happen to be in the audience too. I started off with the *Teacup Chain*, which any square dancer would know right off. This I followed with the *Venus & Mars*, which has appeared in this article before. Next I did a *Progressive Star Route* that I worked out for this special purpose. It went like this:

**Heads to the Center, Right Hand Star Go once and a half from where you are**

**Star by the Left with the outside two Go once around, and when you do**

## TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

(Continued from page 20)

Star right back in the middle you two  
Go once and a quarter from where you  
are  
Star once more with the outside pair  
Star Right back in the middle,  
Go Once and a quarter from where you  
are.

Here is the break-down on the above, although I did not complete the figure. You can do that.

**Instructions:** Heads star Right and go once and a half, #1 couple going to the #3 position, #3 going to the #1 position — *Now*, while they are doing this, the sides face, like in a Grand Square, they back away, turn to face the head position, walk forward and star thru, the man then turns around, puts his left hand with the lady's left hand, which she used to do the Star Thru - by this time the head couples are there and they make a left hand star with this couple, turning it once around, then into the middle to go *once and a quarter*, sides repeat their part, etc.

Here would be the break down — The #1 couple would star left in the #3 position the first time, then the #1 couples would star Left in the #2 position the next time, then they would star Left in their own home position the 3rd time, and the next time they go once and a quarter in the center, they will all meet their original corner lady in her original home position, where they do a left allemande, right & left grand, etc.

I followed this with *Everybody Chain*, which I am sure I have put in print before but I will give it again just in case:

Four ladies Chain, Grand Chain Four  
Chain 'em back across the floor  
Turn your girl and - Everybody Chain  
Head Men Chain Right, turn this girl  
Same men Chain Right, turn this girl  
Same men Chain Right, turn this girl  
Same men Chain Right, now you're  
home  
So Turn your own -

#1 Man chains with the #2 man, ladies are simply chaining over and back, over and back, etc. #1 Man turns the lady coming across from the #4 position and puts her back in the center, then he chains to his *right* and turns a lady in the #3 position and puts her back into the center, then he chains to his

*right* again and turns a lady in #4 position. He chains to his *right* again and he is now back home where he turns his own partner.

The last number I used was an oldie called *Right and a Star* — very beautiful to watch. Here is the call for it:

Four little ladies form a ring  
Go once around and hear me sing  
Gents step in - in front of your girl  
Make a Right Hand Star across the  
world  
Now turn that star, and turn that ring  
Girls roll out around one man  
Come back in and circle again  
Girls roll out one more time  
Circle again, you're doing fine  
Girls roll out now just once more  
Circle again in the middle of the floor  
Now the girls roll out to a Left Alle-  
mande  
And here we go Right & Left Grand -

When you look at, you can see it is practically a directional call. One thing though - gents should hold their hands *high* in the Star to keep in close and make it easier for the ladies to make their ring - ladies do a left-face roll out, the gents are moving so the ladies really just do a turn in place as the gents move forward, like "Ladies in, gents sashay" - It falls into place and is an audience pleaser.

As I said, we received a standing ovation from the thousands there and were asked to repeat that number again. After that I received a call from the Half-Time Director in Oakland, California, asking me about using something like that out there and if I could help them get a Caller from there to put it on, which I agreed to do. They plan to use it next season. This is good promotion for Square Dancing. and I always try to Promote Square Dancing every way I can.

I taught that same routine to cloggers, and they danced it to my calling. They loved it and so did I, and it really goes over with the spectators - the Cloggers are not doing a *routine* where everyone does the same step at the same time - but are doing *Free Style Clogging*", and they love it because they can do just whatever their feet dictate and they can cut loose and do their thing. *Try it sometime.*

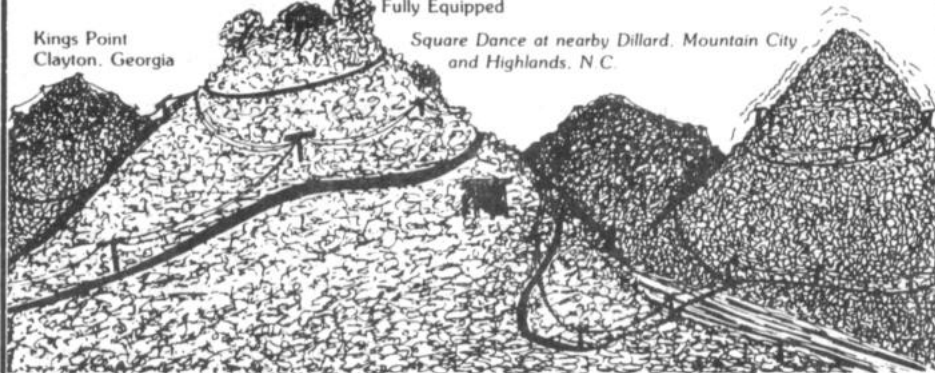

missed coming by the "Showcase". Ever-present were Harry & Betty Cassar, keeping a watchful eye on their charge, "Millie", the mascot of the Central Florida Square & Round Dance Association.

Exhibition dances were well scheduled. They took place in various halls, and if you couldn't make one show, you had the chance to see your favorite performers at another time in another place. I think our Pensacola Special Steppers stole the show in the main arena. The "Reflections" drew gasps from the audience when they reversed colors on their spectacular outfits. I especially enjoyed the exhibitions of the Wheelchair dancers and Unicycle Dancers from other states.

The Fashion Show was comparable to a Hollywood production with a horse-racing motif. My only complaint would be that it could have had better lighting so that we could all see Ken & Mae Ford better as



they strolled down the runway in their beautiful lavender outfits.

And I danced! I was pleasantly surprised to find how well all the callers and cuers were

kept on schedule. For those of you who have never attended a National, this is how they did it: The Caller or Cuer was introduced and immediately started the tip. Those squares ready to dance - danced. Where there were incomplete squares, a member of the Convention committee carrying a long pole with an emblem perched atop it would step in and stay there until the square was filled. Late-comers to any tip had no trouble finding a place to fill in.

An extra-special treat was the "International Hour" in the Singles Hall. I begged Vern Johnson to be my partner and danced to callers from England, Japan, Canada, and Australia - a never-to-be-forgotten experience. This was a test of listening power. The different accents made it a real challenge.

Finally - on to the Cardinal Stadium for the Parade of States. Thousands watched the parade from the stands, but just how many were on the field may never be known. It took an hour and 15 minutes for the delegates to march in. Close to 20,000 dancers may have been on the field at one time. Florida's delegation braved the



heat and made a good showing. A photographer was to take pictures of the square dance after the parade from a helicopter, but because of failing light and diminishing fuel had to give up before the dance, so no photograph is available to count the number of people.

These are only the highlights of my first National Convention. The pleasure of friendship exists at every square dance. Multiply this many times, and you have a National. Maybe Louisville had unusually great accommodations, and unusually hard workers to make it what it was, but I am now "hooked" on Nationals and can hardly wait for next year's at Baltimore.
