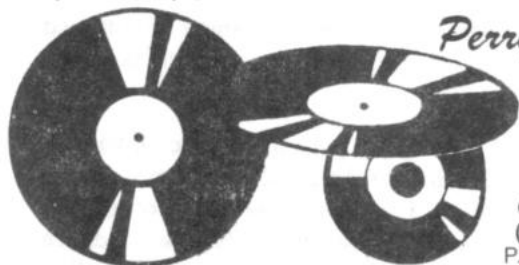

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our new year is now a month old. Most of us have gotten used to writing 1984. The classes which many clubs started in September are well under way, and we can



all begin to think of ways to improve our already wonderful and enjoyable pastime of square dancing.

Legacy, an international leadership organization composed of many well-known callers, cuers, vendors, and dancers throughout the world, once again conducted a survey of dancers from every area of our country which merits our careful examination as the questions asked included all phases of dancing from a simple "How many years have you been dancing?", to questions about participating in club leadership roles.

Perhaps the most significant one for us was a scale running from +5 to -5 on which people rated what they liked most and least about square dancing. Results nationwide, and for our state, were remarkably similar. Most dancers listed "The Pleasure of Dancing", "Doing Things With Friends", and "Exercise"—in that order, as things they liked most. "New Acquaintances", "Learning New Things With Friends", and "Getting Out" followed. Then the things they did not enjoy very much came next—"The Challenge", "The Cost", "The Clothes", "Round Dancing", "Club Activities", "Club Leadership", "Mixers", and finally "Contras", the only activity to receive a negative rating.

Another interesting facet of these questionnaires was a section as to why the person answering felt people dropped out of square dancing. Again the Florida responses followed the nationals proportionately. In this case "Pressure" and "Felt Rushed" were checked by the largest number of people. Other reasons checked included "Bored", "Styling", "Social", "Club" and "Caller". Many also had special or other reasons than those listed.

One question dealt with methods of teaching, asking what method was most effective. The caller in class was judged to be most effective. A sizeable number of dancers thought that help from the experienced dancers in class and learning by example were of benefit to the student, while written material was thought to be of less help to the learning dancer.

These questionnaires obviously can show us trends in dancing and areas we could concentrate on to make this pastime more attractive. Let's take these responses to heart and work to improve the square dance image in our state.

We hope to meet many of you on the dance floor soon.

COURTYARD TO CONVENTION HALL

Ruth H. Brandt

"... promenade home, swing your partner, and yellowrock." No doubt this call is familiar to you. You're probably one of the tens of thousands of square dancers in the United States belonging to a local club and perhaps dancing in state and national conventions.

Besides the pure fun of it, maybe you never stopped to think of some other good reasons for square dancing.

It's good health treatments, both physical and mental. A form of square dancing is taught in public schools as part of the physical education program.

And who can be *lonely* at a square dance? There's the social aspect, the friendships you make. There are children's club and singles' clubs for unmarried adults.

Maybe you wondered about the very origin of the square dance. Dance is a form of art that man has practiced from earliest times. Mexicans dance to celebrate a religious festival; primitive tribes danced to prepare themselves for battle; everybody likes to express happiness through bodily movements. The folk dance expresses the characteristic feelings of a people.

There was no dancing in the early colonies, as the earliest American settlers were very strict Puritans, but dancing was later introduced by the settlers who moved south to the northern Appalachians. Their dance steps were a combination of the arts of their own traditions—the Irish Jig, the Scandinavian Clog, the English Morris, and the German Stomp. Also added to these arts was a form of Indian dance called the Buck Dance—or Buck and Wing, danced by Indian bucks and maidens. The mountain clog was born of this combination of arts. (The tap, formerly called the "black tap" is a child of the clog.)

The barn dance was introduced when the settlers got together for barn-raising. To celebrate their finished product they would gather in the barn to dance. The dancers formed a circle and moved to the calls of one member of the circle. As more friends and relatives attended these dances, the circle

became too large for the barn and was broken up into smaller circles. The noise of the music and the somewhat drunken dancers became too loud for the caller to be heard. Thus began the caller who did not dance but only called.

Their music was jews harps and whiskey jugs (rendered empty by the dancers). Later, homemade fiddles were added to give a "strings" sound. This sound was the basis for bluegrass music, which is all strings. Washboards, saws, and gut-buckets were also put to use as music.

During the western gold rush a number of the rough, common-herd gold seekers moved to California, bringing their blustery, drinking, mountain-style barn dance with them. The established population of California then was Mexican Spanish, some English, and French. These people were more refined, class-conscious, and non-drinking. Their dancing was a combination of the English military, the contra, and the French quadrille, each derived from drills in the courts of their countries for the review and entertainment of their queens.

Finally, as the several dance forms merged, the barn dance was tempered and became more refined in style. In 1940 this type of square dance was established as "western style" square dancing and has spread to almost all countries in the world. The movements are so universal, a square dancer can dance in Japan with the square dancers there.

So, the clog and the barn dance were danced simultaneously, drifted apart, and now are back together again as clog and square dance. Both now share the same conventions and festivals.

Square dancing and clogging have their place in our economy, too. Recording and selling records is a business within itself. So, too, is the calling profession and the clothing and accessory shops. Some of the shops are equipped to transport their wares and set up shops around the convention halls where much of their business is done. Some of the

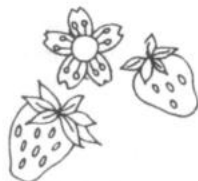

Letter #1

"Your crown will surely merit another star for daring to write and print an Editorial on Single Women in Square Dancing!

"I believe that the main culprits in this problem are the Caller and his wife, and the leaders of the Clubs. Square Dance manners and courtesies are as important as mastering Mainstream movements. Long-sleeved shirts for the men, greeting everyone in the square with handshakes or Yellowrocks, how to square up, the art of "gentle" hands, ending with the circled dancers extending hands for a big "thaaank you" to the Caller.

"A single woman has little to thank her caller for if that caller has not made the effort to see that she danced *at all!* Indeed, many callers casually watch while two brave ladies, one dancing the man's part, attempt to "square up" only to have an obviously angry couple walk out of that square, and the Caller turns his back as though he has not seen it. A Caller who tolerates a four couple "closed" square and is, indeed, intimidated by them, is as guilty of rudeness as they. This completely contradicts the friendly family premise that Square Dancing was founded on. While it is obvious that a Square Dance Caller cannot change the nature of a snob, or a whiner, or an arrogant person, *he can control the*

actions of his dancers in his hall!! Those who choose to be rude, discourteous, or rough, can simply be asked not to do these things, or leave! A Caller who allows this kind of behavior to continue, will find that the nice friendly people will cease coming and he will have a club where nobody wants to visit, because they are rough, or snobbish, or have closed Squares, or don't allow Singles.

"During the last Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention, I went to the main hall to watch. What a beautiful sight—so many squares you couldn't count them all. Down at the far end of the hall, a row of people, some of whom I knew, were waiting to dance. They were Singles. Wouldn't it have been wonderful if a club, or several clubs, saw to it that those seats were vacant at every tip? It did not happen, of course. In fact, as I was watching, two pairs of ladies went out to "square up" with two couples who had their hands up for 2. When the ladies approached, both couples turned and almost ran for the other end of the hall. *Those rude couples had on their club outfit, and their caller's name is known.*

"We are, as you know, very involved in Clogging. One of the most frequent questions asked by a beginner is "Do you need a partner, or can singles come?" Those of you not familiar with Clogging may be surprised to learn that we *DO* have many routines where there is a man's part and a woman's part. In *our* halls, there is absolutely no problem or stigma in women learning and dancing the opposite part. Perhaps this is why singles are flocking to the Clogging Halls!!!"

ADVANCED DANCING VIEWPOINT

How can the Advanced dancing Program eliminate the Callers who advertise advanced programs and call one or two advanced calls in each tip mixed with soft mainstream and plus basics???? The dancers in these programs THINK they are dancing advanced but, wow, they are hit between the eyes the first time they step out to a weekend or to another caller who CALLS advanced ????

This is becoming a problem in some areas and one idea would be for the advanced callers in the area who call ADVANCED to take out an ad in their local square dance magazine explaining just what is ADVANCED DANCING. Kip Garvey and the advanced committee have put together a nice booklet that gives the dancer a good picture of what to find in an advanced dancing program. I'm not sure of the status of the booklet but someday we may have some help on the national picture to combat this unfair practice by some callers....

ADVANCED EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

SHADOW TO AN HOURGLASS....Bill Harrison

The Shadow to a Diamond call that currently is a QS selection led Billy to this idea... From parallel two-faced lines or waves, the action to Shadow to an Hourglass is the same for all but the centers facing in.... The ends and the center facing out will do a Shadow to a Diamond action as the centers facing in will end as the very centers of the Hourglass by doing a single hinge action.... I tell the centers to make like they are doing a single hinge with the other center dancer - however the outfacing dancer will not be there.... The center facing in will connect with the center facing in from across the set to become the centers of the hourglass.... The timing has the centers of the hourglass in position ahead of the other dancers and I add, directionally, for the centers to trade... This is once the action is mastered and dancing starts - not marching....

TEACHING EXAMPLE:

Zero Box...Wave...Boys Run...(We are going to do a Shadow to an Hourglass)...the girls do a normal Cast the Shadow action...Boys, the ones facing out, will do the action of a Shadow to a Diamond which is a form of Split Circulate once & 1/2...Boys facing in will do a Single Hinge action to become the centers of the hourglass, boys facing in will be holding right hands in the center...now...*Shadow to an Hourglass...*Let's check to see if the hourglass is properly formed....

Center Boys Trade..Flip the Hourglass..Recycle..Left Alle...

Zero Line..Pass the Ocean..Boys Run..Shadow to an Hourglass..

Center Boys Trade..Hourglass Circulate..Flip the Hourglass..

Boys Trade..Boys Run..Bend the Line..Slide Thru..Left Alle..

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

Let's take a backward look and review some of the things that we have covered over the last couple of years—mostly the important items we have covered—such as *Equivalents* and *Zeros*.

Equivalents:

Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Pass the Ocean - Recycle = Right & Left Thru.

Star Thru - Pass the Ocean - Recycle = 2 Ladies Chain.

Flutter Wheel - Pass the Ocean - Recycle = Star Thru.

Half Sashay - Swing Thru - Recycle = Zero.

Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Sweep a Quarter = Zero.

The above are just a fraction of the things that you should be able to figure out. As we have said so many times before, the first thing you should do with a basic is to find out where it will Zero out, and what it is Equivalent to. These are a *MUST* if you are going to strive for the ultimate in "Sight Calling", and that should be every Caller's goal.

Several months back we covered the fact - *Swing Thru, Girls Trade, Boys Trade* - equals a *Right & Left Thru*, or to put it another way, one will cancel the other out. For instance:

Heads Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Swing Thru, Girls Trade, Boys Trade, Then Turn Thru - Left Allemande....

Instead of doing trades,

Heads Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Right & Left Thru - Swing Thru - Turn Thru - Left Allemande...

Going still further,
Heads Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Pass Thru - Swing Thru, Girls Trade, Boys Trade, Turn Thru, Left Allemande...

Or, instead of trades,
Heads Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Pass Thru - Right & Left Thru - Swing Thru - Turn Thru, Left Allemande...

Those last two will show you that you can do the same thing working with the sides instead of working in the Center of the Set and you will get the same results. These are things we should know so that we have them at hand and can use them whenever we want to. Make any changes you care to make but be sure you know where they are and what will work from that point. UPDATE FROM NATIONAL FOLK DANCE COMMITTEE

Congratulations everyone — it's happening!!!

The bill designating the "Square Dance" as the National Folk Dance was passed unanimously, in perpetuity, by the Senate September 20, 1983. Mac & Mary McClure, Chairman of the National Folk Dance Committee, and George & Ann Holser, Vice Chairman, traveled, at their own expense, to Washington, D.C. during Square Dance Week to obtain more cosponsors. At least 218 cosponsors are needed for a Floor Vote, and at that time there were 123 Cosponsors. Wearing square dance attire and with information, they visited 126 offices of previous cosponsors.

Their efforts were bolstered by thousands of telegrams (*Telegrams to Congress Day - September 21*) plus the letters and petitions from Square Dancers from all around the U.S. Also, Congressmen Mineta (CA) and Panetta (CA) the joint Co-sponsors of HR 1706, had sent another "Dear Colleague Letter" to all previous Co-sponsors - reminding them to cosponsor HR 1706 for Permanent Designation.

WHAT WE HAVE TO DO NEXT: Members of the Post Office & Civil Service Committee must receive letters, cards, petitions, visits, etc. from their constituents urging that HR 1706 be reported out of Committee with a *Permanent Designation* for a House Vote. If necessary to achieve this goal, request that a public hearing be held so members of the Square Dance activity can testify that the Square Dance be *Permanently Designated* as the National Folk Dance.

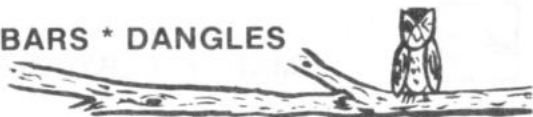

Letter #2

"We have women down here who dance the man's part—some dressed in pants, shirt and bolo, and some who dress like a woman.

"If everybody knows everybody—it doesn't make that much difference, but if there are any strangers in the set—it is very difficult. And the more inexperienced the dancer, the worse it is.

"One reason is because our calling is mostly "boys - girls". Perhaps if it was all centers and ends it would be better. But that wouldn't always work!

"I have danced the man's part to fill in a square when my husband wanted to sit out. It was very confusing to the other people. When my husband was in the hospital I danced the man's part and dressed the part. Much better.

"I also feel that two couples of "woman dancing man" should not be in the same square.

"For these women to be accepted—they must become excellent dancers—so people will be glad to dance with them. They must become "better than ordinary". Some people who are not sure of themselves resent women dancing as men. It is their own inferiority complex "That a woman could dance both parts well".

"More power to you gals! Personally, I think that all men should learn the "woman's" part and all women should learn the "man's" part. Then Arky wouldn't throw them."

The plus QS call Mix to a Diamond led to this one which is really a very nice and easy way to set up an hourglass...From parallel two-faced lines or waves, the centers will Cross Run and the new centers will 1/2 Circulate...Forming the hourglass...

*Zero Box: Right & Left Thru..Veer Left..Mix to an Hourglass..
Center Boys Trade..Flip the Hourglass..
Girls Trade..Girls Run..Bend the Line..Left Alle...*

*Zero Box: Swing Thru..Boys Run..Tag the Line Right
Mix to an Hourglass..Center Girls Trade..
Flip the Hourglass..Boys Run..Wheel & Deal...Left Alle...*

The above two ideas will add to the ways we can set up Hourglass formations. Which one will become the most popular of the two is only a guess but I think Mix to an Hourglass is a bit easier, but both will dance smoothly.

**Heads Flutter Wheel - Star Thru
Then Pass Thru -**

**Heads Right & Left Thru -
Flutter Wheel - Square Thru 4 hands -**

**Heads Swing Thru - Then Turn Thru
Partner Trade - Square Thru 4 hands -**

This could go on and on but you need to work things out on your own and not depend on someone else doing it for you - in fact, you can just stand up there and sight call them into the position you are looking for, simply watching to see when you have them with Partners.

A simple way would be.
**1 & 3 Right & Left Thru -
Turn your girl and Veer to the Left -
Bend the Line and - Pass Thru -**

You can get them into this same position by using a Circulate - try it this way,

Heads Square Thru 4 Hands -

**Swing Thru - Girls Circulate - Boys
Trade, Turn Thru, Left Allemande -**

A little more complicated.
**Heads Square Thru 4 Hands -
Swing Thru - Girls Circulate -
Boys Run - Now Bend the Line -
and Star Thru -**

That last set-up gets them back into that same position we have been using, heads facing the sides, *IN* sequence, all with original partners—and from here they can do a Right & Left Thru, then Swing thru and Turn Thru to a Left Allemande, or they can Swing Thru, Girls Trade, Boys Trade, Turn Thru, Left Allemande. Try something like this some time;

**Heads Flutter Wheel - Star Thru -
Pass Thru - Swing Thru - Boys Run -
Ferris Wheel - Pass Thru Now and -
Swing Thru - Girls Trade, Boys Trade -
and Turn Thru, Left Allemande -**

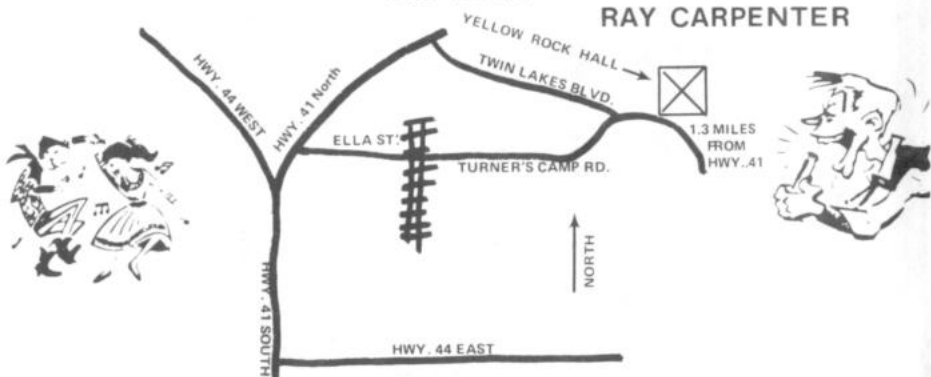
