PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

STYLING



One of the most neglected areas of square dancing today is that of styling. This is most unfortunate because not only does the omission of proper

styling take away from the beauty of the dance, it also leaves out courtesy and often shows disregard for the comfort, and indeed, the safety of the dancer.

For, you see, styling is not only involved with a bit of pretty skirtwork by the ladies and fancy flourishes and twirls; it is a whole way of dancing that puts consideration for others in your square at the top of your priorities.

Part of styling is keeping your square small, not swinging out wide. It means finishing your movement on time - for instance twirling when meeting a partner to promenade only if you can get out of the way of the next couple so they won't run into you, moving along on a "weave the ring" and not holding up the whole square while you "bump sa daisy", and not twirling a lady when the next movement is to be an "Allemande Left".

Styling is consideration - if you meet a lady and she holds her hand low, you know she means, "Please don't twirl me".

Styling is also smooth, easy dancing - no jumping and high kicking and stomping. He does not grab hands on a "Square Through" or jerk arms on a "Star Through". (NOTE: Of course all these sentences apply to the ladies too.) The dancer who pays attention to styling has his body and his hand in the right place at the right time. He is a position dancer and executes his moves sharply and correctly and he is not sloppy and does not take shortcuts.

Styling is also attention to standardization—especially when visiting clubs in other locations. There is an approved way to do all movements - a way you learned when you were a student - because CALLERLAB has recognized a uniform style of dancing which is comfortable for the dancer and yet allows a caller to vary his choreography. While it may be acceptable to substitute other movements for some calls in your area - for instance the swinging "Do-sa-do" - it is never acceptable to do this in a strange place with dancers you do not know. Stick to the traditional way of doing things at least until you observe their customs.

In short, the dancer **AS A STYLIST IS SIMPLY ONE WHO IS THOUGHTFUL AND CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS** IN HIS SQUARE AND ON THE FLOOR. He pays attention to his dancing and is proud to do it right. Let's all try to be better dancers and dance with style.

BIRMINGHAM — HERE WE COME !

Besides the joy of dancing and the good fellowship found at all national conventions, finding good food is also high on the agenda for the attendees. At the 34th National Square Dance Convention to be held in Birmingham, Alabama June 27- 29, 1985, there are many culinary delights to be found.

Over 250 restaurants in the Birmingham area serve everything from fast foods to fancy cuisine with emphasis on good southern-style vegetables to seafood from the Gulf of Mexico. Real barbeque smoked over a wood fire and bathed in a savory sauce made from secret recipes handed down from generation to generation tempt the taste buds of those who whiff the aroma of the slow cooking southern specialty. You may satisfy your craving for barbeque at Old Plantation, Carlile Brothers, Ollie's and the Tired Texan, among others.

For those who lean to the unusual, there is Baby Doe's located high on the edge of a hill overlooking Birmingham. The view is outstanding. Designed to look like a silver mine, it focuses on the legend of Baby Doe Tabor who shocked polite society when the owner of the Matchless Silver Mine divorced his wife and married her. In 1883, silver prices fell; Tabor died and Baby Doe lived in poverty beside the mine shaft of the Matchless Mine. In 1935 her frozen body was found. The decor is rustic with an abandoned mine car at the entrance. Mine cars are also along the winding road to the building which is covered with rusted tin. Inside are small eating areas with furnishings typical of the Baby Doe era. The menu consists of seafood as well as house specialties including outstanding desserts.

Another restaurant featuring turn of the century atmosphere is "Down the Street".

Dine on Oysters Rockefeller, escargots, veal marsala, steak au poivre in high-ceilinged, dark toned rooms.

G G in the Park features steak and seafood with an active lobster tank. The foyer is decorated with photographs of political and sports heroes. A relatively new place is Highlands, a fashionable bar and grill. There you may enjoy original artwork, pastel colors and a tile and marble bar while dining on smoked salmon on pumpernickel or grilled cornish hen.

Another popular place is John's. For consistently good food at reasonable prices, it is the place to go. Le Relais features French cuisine, and Michael's is popular with the sporting crowd. For pasta lovers, there is Rossi's.

Cobb Lane, a picturesque brick lined alleyway located between 13th & 14th Avenue South and just west of 20th Street boasts of Cobb's Corner Cupboard and La Vielle Tavern. At Cobb's Corner Cupboard you will find low ceilinged rooms and a charming patio where you may dine upon tomato aspic, artichoke chicken, shrimp salad, vichyssoise and a most delicious chocolate roulage. French food is served at La Vielle Tavern in charming rooms. Quiche, escargots, carre d'agneau are among the selections available. Reservations are recommended at both of these delightful dining establishments.

Southern, French, Italian and Greek cooking are all available to satisfy the most discriminating taste.

Florida already has 332 registered for next year's National, second only to the state of Alabama.

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



THE PLUS PROGRAM

The new CALLERLAB Plus Program includes some suggestions for using *Anything & Roll*. I would like to explore one or two of these suggested ideas in the hope that it will be of some help to you and the dancers. I feel that some of these Roll actions do challenge the dancer to what I feel is a bit beyond where most plus dancers are dancing or wish to dance. . . but here goes . . .

SPIN THE TOP & ROLL

Let's gather a bit of information about how *Spin The Top* works so the roll action will be better understood. From standard right hand waves the ends and adjacent dancers turn by the right $\frac{1}{2}$ way. The centers then arm turn or Cast *Left* $\frac{3}{4}$. The Left arm turn then implies that the roll for the centers will be a $\frac{1}{4}$ left face individual turn. So at the completion of the left $\frac{3}{4}$ arm turn the centers must DROP left hands and make a LEFT face $\frac{1}{4}$ turn on the spot of completion. The ends meanwhile are moving forward to their right so they will make an individual Right face $\frac{1}{4}$ turn on the spot of their ending position. The ending formation will be two dancers in single file facing two dancers in single file. I kind of like to start the action from facing couples in lines of four so the ending formation is more practical.

Zero Box: Do Sa Do to a Wave...Pass the Ocean...Spin the Top and Roll... Double Pass Thru...Face Right...Wheel & Deal...Pass to the Center... Square Thru $\frac{3}{4}$...Left Alle...

Zero Line: Pass the Ocean...Fan the Top...Swing Thru...Spin the Top & Roll...

Four girls Swing Thru...Girls Extend...Scoot Back...Boys Run... Slide Thru... Left Alle...(zero box)..

FOLD & ROLL

The folders will be the only dancers doing the roll action and that action will depend upon the direction of the folding action. If the fold is to the right then the roll is to the right; and if the fold is to the left then the roll is a left face $\frac{1}{4}$ turn. Lots of interesting formation changes available!!!

Zero Line: Pass Thru...Boys Fold & Roll...Girls U Turn Back & ... Swing Thru...then Cast Off $\frac{3}{4}$...Boys Circulate Double..Balance... Trade the Wave...Boys Run...Bend the Line...Right & Left Thru... Slide Thru...Left Alle...

Zero Line: Pass Thru...Girls Fold & Roll...Boys U Turn Back & Swing Thru...(check diamonds) Flip the Diamond...Recycle... Pass to the Center...Square Thru $\frac{3}{4}$...Left Alle...

16th BIG YEAR

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher

Last month we covered the *Eight Chain Thru* position where each man is facing his Corner Lady. This month we will cover the same position, but this time each man will be facing his original partner - so let's see what we can come up with, setting it up several different ways - or I should say TWO different ways. One would be IN Sequence - the other is OUT. There are many ways we can get dancers into this position but let's begin with an easy one.

Heads Right & Circle to a Line Star Thru -

At this point each gent is facing his original partner and - *they are OUT of Sequence*. This is the ideal set-up to *Square Thru 3/4's* to a *Left Allemande*. Remember, a *3/4 Square Thru* does NOT change sequence from a static position, or from lines of four, *but it does* change Sequence when the dancers are in an *Eight Chain Thru* position. So, as we said, the dancers are OUT of Sequence - the *3/4 Square Thru* brings them back INTO Sequence and they are ready for a *Left Allemande*.

A year or so back we studied this setup from two different positions but since that was some time ago, and since we likely have more NEW Callers by now, we will take another look at it and break it down. The important thing here is the Sequence. They MUST be OUT of Sequence to *Square Thru 3/4's* around to a *Left Allemande*. You can study this and remember it, keeping track of the Sequence as you go, OR, you can 'Sight' call it much easier if we know what we are looking for. Breaking it down here is what we are looking for. Watch the #1

man and his corner lady. She is the #4 lady, of course. Going back to that setup we have the *Heads Lead Right and Circle to a Line and - Star Thru*. The #1 Man is on the outside, facing his Partner. His Corner, the #4 Lady is on his right. If you are doing sight calling, this is what you are looking for. Look that over real good. If you have been calling several minutes and then decide to use this setup to end the dance and get them into a *Left Allemande*. You have the dancers in lines of four, with their partner on their right. You have them *Star Thru* to get them into the *Eight Chain Thru* position. You look and see that they are just where you want them except, the #1 Man is not on the outside. He is *Inside*, looking at his Partner, with his Corner on his right, exactly where you wanted them., only they are IN Sequence at this point. When you see this you simply have them do a *Right & Left Thru* and they are now OUT of Sequence where you want them.



You can work the *3/4 Square Thru* to a *Left Allemande* when the #1 Man is in the middle and not on the outside but the setup will be different. If he is *Inside* looking out then he *must* be looking at his Partner, *but*, he *must* be standing back-to-back with his Corner. Sequence determines this as it does everything in *Square Dancing*. There are *two* setups you must watch for if you are sight calling. Now we will break it down by Sequence and we will see what happens.

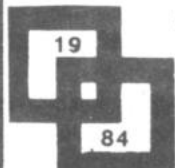

Heads Right and Circle to a Line

Star Thru (out)

Right & Left Thru (they are now IN)

Square Thru 4 Hands (still IN Sequence)

Bend the Line and -

Star Thru - (OUT again)

We have put them into the same setup twice in a row. We used a *Right & left Thru* and we changed the sequence. This put them back INTO Sequence. The Square Thru 4 hands changed nothing - but when we did a Bend the Line and - *Star Thru* we put them OUT of Sequence.

Now we will get into the other setup. *Heads Right and Circle to a Line and - Star Thru - Half Square Thru* - this puts them IN Sequence again - *Bend the Line and -*

SQUARE DANCE AS NATIONAL FOLK DANCE DENIED

The McClures and Holsers of the National Folk Dance Committee had many meetings with Congressmen and their staff members prior to the Hearing on June 28th of the Subcommittee on Census & Population on HR 1706, designating the Square Dance as the National Folk Dance of the U.S.A.

At the Hearing with room was filled with dancers (in square dance attire), reporters, and supporters of the opposition group. NBC TV and Bill & Bobbie Myrick (Editors of California Blue Book) videotaped the entire proceedings. An official stenographer took notes and taped all testimonies for a typewritten transcript of the hearing. A table was provided for copies of oral and written testimonies, plus information and history articles regarding the square dance activity, which was available for everyone to take.

The "Hearing" was recessed 3 times by "Roll Call Votes". (All members of Congress are required to be on the House Floor for a Roll Call Vote.)

Testifying for Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance were Congressmen Norman Y. Mineta (CA), Leon E. Panetta (CA), Mickey Leland (TX), and Earl Hutto (FL); George F. Holser, Vice Chairman NFDC; Mac McClure, Chairman NFDC; Cathie Burdick, Coeditor of American Square Dance Magazine; and Bob Osgood, Editor Square Dancing Magazine. Mrs. Burdick was interrupted and requested to relinquish her remaining time (which she did), and Bob Osgood was requested to limit his testimony to 3 minutes because another hearing was scheduled for Room 311 shortly.

Speaking against the Bill were Ralph Rinzler, Assistant Secretary, Public Service, Smithsonian Inst.; Dr. Thomas Vennum, Sr. Ethnomusicologist, Office of Folklife Programs, Smithsonian Inst.; Lavon Robinson, Tap Dancer; Mr. Cameron, Eskimo; Dr. Carol Robertson, President, Society for Ethnomusicology, Inc.; Dr. Charles Camp, State Folklorist, Maryland Arts Council; Dr. Gretchen Schneider, Dance Historian; Joe Wilson, Exec. Dir., National Council for Traditional Arts; and Robert Delsemer, V.P. Country Dance Society (Square Dance Caller who has received a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts).

Those present at the "Hearing" felt the deck had been stacked against them but felt that everyone in the square dance activity can be proud of the oral and written testimonies presented in favor of the Bill. The very strong testimonies by the Congressmen, plus the fact that there are now 266 cosponsors (all 5 members of the subcommittee and 19 of the 25 members of the full Post Office & Civil Service Committee are also cosponsors of HR 1706) clearly showed that the Bill should be marked up and sent to the House for vote.

They felt the opposition's testimonies were repetitious and for the most part based on points emphasized in the "Study" made by Mr. Gerald Parsons, Jr. Their main points of opposition were as follows:

1. No one dance should be designated the National Folk Dance.
2. Ethnic Dance Groups may feel slighted.
3. Might stop or slow down the development of other folk dances.
4. The wording of HR 1706 is not correct. No definition of "Square Dance".

The opposition, at the last minute, were allowed three additional people to testify who were not on the agenda and had not submitted written testimony. The additional testimonies and the fact that Mrs. Burdick and Mr. Osgood were requested to shorten their testimony resulted in the opposition having 26 minutes more oral testimony than those in favor.

It was interesting that those testifying in opposition and their supporters chose not to remain and hear testimony in favor of HR 1706. By the time the hearing was concluded, only one person from the opposition remained in the room.

In a letter to Congressman Hutto dated August 15th, Katie Hall, Chairwoman of the Subcommittee on Census and Population said "it is the opinion of the Chair that there is insufficient support to mark up H.R. 1706 in its present form." She added that "The Subcommittee will assist Congressmen Mineta and Panetta with future legislation honoring the square dance, so that this great American folkdance will continue to be recognized for its contributions to the preservation of American folkculture."
