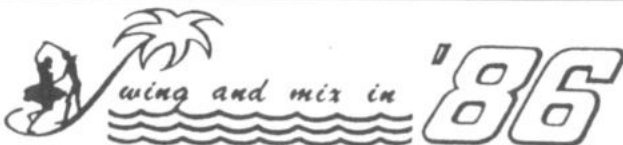

'85 NATIONAL CONVENTION REVIEW

20,000 people from the U.S.A. and many other countries were in attendance at the 34th National Square Dance Convention in Birmingham, Alabama June 27-29, 1985.

The facilities were fine, with most of the events occurring in halls and arenas within about a block's walking distance of one another. The Cloggers, however, had to be located at the Fairgrounds, which was some distance away, but accessible by shuttle bus. From reports heard, however, the Cloggers were "dancing up a storm" at the Fairgrounds and enjoying themselves. With the great diversity of levels and kinds of dance, very few cities are set up with facilities to accommodate everything at one center. It must be difficult, however, for parents who square dance or round dance and have children who clog, to schedule who is going to be dancing, and still have the required parental supervision.

The sound systems, in all the halls we observed, were very good. The only problems the dancers encountered was in getting used to the various accents of the Callers and Cuers who came from just everywhere!

It took a climb up the steep steps of the Coliseum to go to the Showcase of Ideas, but it was worth it. Florida, as usual, had a great display. (It gets better every year.) Sample copies of *BOW & SWING* were available for the taking, and "Florida Real

2:00 P.M., and then found that all but the fast food counters, to eat had shut down and would not re-open until 4:15 or 4:30. After walking up and down hills for two hours in search of a good meal, found that at The Restaurant, the only way to get a variety of vegetables was to get a \$9.95 buffet. On to the Coliseum's food center, to find no variety of menu. I hope future National Conventions will take a tip from the Louisville Convention, and offer a wide variety of foods at any time of the day or evening.

Although Florida came in second in the number of attendees, topped only by Alabama, only a small percentage were brave enough to march in the Parade of States. Perhaps many more had planned to march, but the assembly of the Parade began about 1½ hours before the Parade actually began, and standing in the hot sun for that length of time can discourage even very enthusiastic souls.

The Parade, however, was a very stirring sight. The Coliseum floor was filled with dancers in their colorful State costumes, and there was hardly a seat left empty for the spectators. In the stands too, groups of Florida dancers could be spotted easily because of our distinctive costumes.

The City of Birmingham was mighty glad that we came, and this was evidenced by the friendly hospitality offered wherever we

Food? It could have been better at the Convention Complex. There was good food available, but it was best not to get hungry in the middle of the afternoon. Due to a lengthy stop at the Florida Showcase one day, your reporter did not try to get lunch until after

went. The dancers were really catered to, with streets blocked off at the Convention area, crossing guards on constant duty for official traffic, mounted police patrols, and a gracious Mayor who told us he was ready to take care of any problems, personally, that the dancers might encounter.

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD

CHOREOGRAPHY FOR DANCER IMPROVEMENT & EDUCATION



Scoot Back is a very popular Mainstream basic. Very often the call is limited to a single formation, the zero box....Touch 1/4....then a Scoot Back. Let's explore a number of dance situations that will provide you and the dancer with some variety when calling Scoot Back:

First the dancer should be aware that a Scoot Back action is really done from a mini wave formation. The parallel mini waves form the "Scoot Back" box. The dancers need to be taught how to recognize their part of a Scoot Back is determined by their facing direction. Are you facing into the center of the box? If yes, you always do the Turn Thru portion. If you are facing out, you always do the Run or Rollover action. Once this recognition is part of the dancer's knowledge and he or she can function with the facing recognition and the application of the mechanics of the action, you can easily work with Scoot Back from a great many formations and dancer positioning.

PLACES FOR THE USE OF SCOOT BACK:

The action of a Scoot Back is mostly a right handed activity, while we can use it from left handed boxes, at Mainstream it is primarily a right handed figures. To use it from left handed boxes, it is best to say something like; Ready with a left....Scoot Back....

1. Parallel Scoot Back boxes. (zero box Touch 1/4)
2. Parallel Ocean Waves. (zero box wave)
3. The center box formed by the center four of parallel two faced lines.
4. The center box of parallel Dixie Style waves
5. End to End boxes in columns.
6. The center box in a column.
7. A single box between couples facing in or out (Heads Slide Thru & Touch 1/4)
8. When the centers of a 3 & 1 line are in mini waves.
9. Directed dancers from an Alamo Ring.

The examples below are numbered to relate to the above formations.

1. *Zero Box: Touch 1/4 . . Scoot Back . . Boys Run . . Reverse Flutter Wheel Sweep 1/4 . . Left Alle . . (zero)*
2. *Zero Box Wave: Scoot Back . . Girls Circulate . . Boys Trade . . Boys Run . . 1/2 Tag the Line . . Girls Run . . Star Thru . . Left Alle . .*
3. *Zero Line: Pass the Ocean . . Recycle & Veer Left . . Girls Scoot Back Girls Cross Run . . Boys Scoot Back & Cross Run . . Wheel & Deal . . Swing Thru . . Turn Thru . . Left Alle . .*

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher

This is the month most callers are preparing to start beginner classes. This is the time to think about teaching the basics and also the time to start work on changing them around so that you can give the dancers a variety - a variety of basics, not a variety of junk. Since you will be working with beginners, this would be a wonderful time for you to make a try at changing them around because the beginner dancer does not have any idea of what you are doing. Practice on them, being sure that you know what you are going to do, and don't let them catch you by making a lot of mistakes.

Take one position at a time and see what you can do with that one position. I'll give you several different things that you can do - you take it from there and see how many different changes you can come up with yourself. Here we go . . .

Have the heads Square Thru - four hands around. This leaves the dancers in what I call an *Eight Chain Thru position - everyone facing their original corner, in sequence*. Now, we are going to see how many different things we can do, always bringing the dancers to that same position, *Eight Chain Thru position, facing corners, in sequence* . . .

Heads Square Thru, 4 hands
Swing Thru - Boys Run right -
Wheel & Deal to face those two.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Veer Left - Couples Trade -
Wheel & Deal to face those two.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Circle half way around - Veer Left,

Wheel & Deal to
face those two.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Swing Thru -
Boys Run right -
Couples Circulate -
Couples Trade
Wheel & Deal -
Square Thru 3/4's
Trade by - facing
corner again.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Right & Left Thru - Swing Thru -
Boys Run right - Wheel & Deal -
Dive Thru - Square Thru 3/4's

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Pass the Ocean - Recycle -
Sweep a quarter more.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Touch a Quarter - Walk & Dodge -
Partner Trade - Right & Left Thru -
Slide Thru - Step to a wave - Recycle.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Pass the Ocean - Recycle -
Right & Left Thru - Flutter Wheel -
Star Thru - back facing corner again.

Heads Square Thru - 4 hands
Pass the Ocean - Right & Left Thru
Turn your girl and - Star Thru.

To move into something a little different you can do something like this, you are still simply using the basics and everyone should do it very easily.

Heads Promenade Half Way Around -
Come into the Center,
Square Thru - 4 hands -
Right & Left Thru - Turn your girl and -
Star Thru - Square Thru 4 - Count 4
hands and then Trade by - Lookin' at
corner, Left Allemande.

ABOUT OUR COVER ARTIST

Many thanks to Warren Johnson, who provided BOW & SWING with the beautiful painting displayed on the cover of our June, 1985 issue, and also the cover on this issue.



Warren Johnson is a well known artist who lives in the art oriented community of New Smyrna Beach, Florida. His interest in art started as a teenager in Michigan where he studied graphics and oil painting. As a youngster he was a frequent visitor to Daytona Beach where his grandparents had a winter home. It was natural for him to select this area for his retirement home in 1973.

Soon after retirement he renewed his interest in art. His first paintings were with a relatively new medium — acrylic. He uses it occasionally when the subject seems to warrant it. During those early years of his art career he established himself as a seascape painter and many of his present day paintings are of shrimp boats from this area. After several years he ventured into the demanding field of watercolors and with the help of the well known watercolorist, Jean Eck, he began to progress in a realm known to many top artists today. He has won many ribbons at various juried shows throughout Central Florida. For several years he pursued the conventional road of exhibits, art shows and one-man shows. He now prefers to exhibit in banks, hospital lobbies, church halls, libraries and places where the viewers may observe the paintings leisurely and form their own conclusion.

He has assisted in the establishment and operations of local shows such as "Images" and "The Art Fiesta" but does not participate in their exhibitions. He is a member of the Artists' Workshop and a past member of their board of directors. He considers the opinions of the judges secondary to that of the viewing public and believes that what he enjoys painting may be viewed favorably by many of those who visit these exhibits. Warren has a realistic approach to the subjects of his paintings and often includes people and birds to give life to the compositions. Most of his watercolors are planned and several preliminary ink sketches may be made before a painting is started.

Some of his pen and ink sketches have been used for covers for the Florida State square dance magazine, "Bow and Swing." Recently he was commissioned to paint the official emblems and scenes on a canvas banner 52" x 74" for the Florida State Federation of Square Dancers. It will be used for national exhibitions. Many of Warren's paintings are included in institutional and private collections.

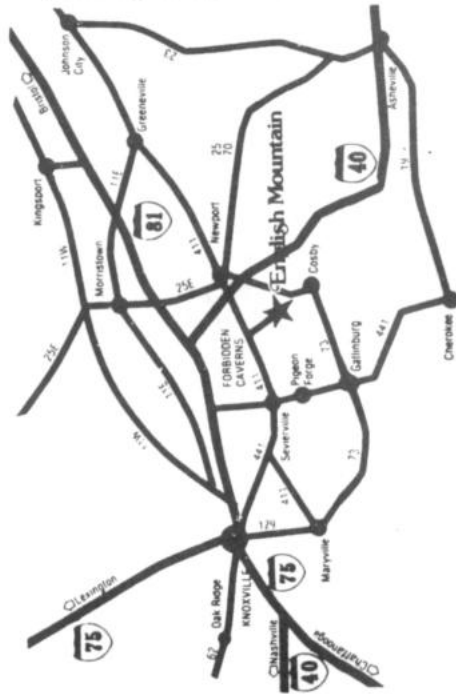

DANCER SURVEY RESULTS

The 4th dancer survey turned out to be the largest of all with 7,584 forms received. In the past 6 years, close to 20,000 in all have been read, compiled, reviewed and analyzed in an effort to measure dancers' needs, learn what makes things tick and feel the pulse of the activity.

Any doctor feeling the pulse of square dancing right now would have great concern over the patient's welfare. The data indicated declining class sizes, declining dance attendance and decreasing dancer satisfaction in several important areas.

The average profile of all respondents was a person who had been dancing about 6 years and danced about 6 times per month. 6% were callers, 3% were cuers, 25% were club officers and 7% were association officers. Looking back, the average years of dancing experience and average dances attended per month has been gradually increasing. While the exact reasons for these two trends cannot be defined by the data, most likely the average experience is increasing because of reduced numbers of new dancers. Probably the frequency is increasing because of the gradual movement of dancers into programs that require more frequent dancing to maintain proficiency.

Class size and dance attendance suffered more in metropolitan and suburban areas. All dancers together reported the trend was downward about twice as often as they reported increases.

A very strong correlation was noticed between the average number of lessons and dancer retention. The national average was 25 lessons with 80% reporting the percentage dancing after 2 years was between zero and 50%.

When the dancers were asked what they enjoyed the most, the far-and-away most popular answer was open club dances (49%). Next was vacations and weekends (13%). Rounds, workshops and festivals/conventions came out even at 10% for each.

Lessons were more popular in rural environments and open club dances appealed most to dancers in small towns. Dancers in metropolitan areas chose closed club dances and festivals/conventions more than those in other areas. Rounds and vacation/weekends appealed most to city dancers and workshops got the highest vote in suburban areas.

Dancers responded to the question, "What would help square dancing most?" as follows: More workshop tips (37%); Stabilized list for all programs (26%); More mainstream clubs (23%); and More lessons (21%) as the top four. Looking at all of these choices together (there were others) indicated the dancers collectively lacked confidence in their ability to dance what was being called.

Exercise, cost, learning new things, doing things with friends, the challenge, mixers and getting out scoring trends conformed closely with the mean average score, indicating dancers see little or no change in their relative appeal. Two aspects, clothes and club activities, dropped in average scores with this survey.

Three aspects, club leadership, the pleasure of dancing and round dancing, have not conformed to the overall trend and should be considered problem areas.

Since the pleasure of dancing is the highest scoring aspect, it could be considered the primary appeal for most dancers and its downward trend should be of great concern. While the appeal of round dancing is not as universal, the steep decline could indicate something is really amiss. Club leadership's trend could be influenced by the decline in new dancers who, so often, are given the burden of running the clubs.

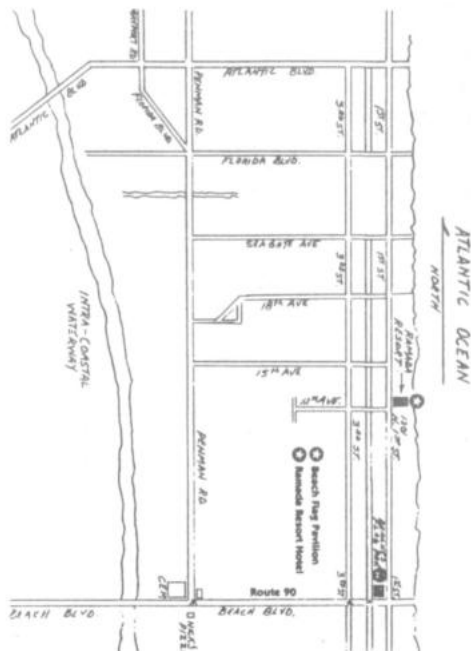

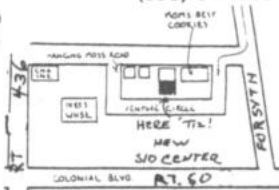

Fund-raising efforts continue, such as a recent Spaghetti Supper in June and a planned Road Block, to pay for our scheduled trip to Washington, D.C. in September. The trip during Square Dance Month has taken on additional significance since we have been advised by Congressman Earl Hutto that the National Square Dnce Committee's proposal that square dancing be designated as the "National Folk Dance" for 1985 and 1986 has again been submitted as a Bill by Congressman Panetta of California. This was confirmed at the United Square Dancers of America annual meeting in Birmingham.

The Education Panel, "Teaching the Handicapable" at the National, with panelists Gil Josephson, Pete Mazik, and Frank Cherry, and moderated by the undersigned, was very successful in that five attendees are

interested in starting Handicapable Square Dance Clubs. There was ample opportunity for the exchange of information, including addresses for future communications.

Speaking of communications, the July, 1985 issue of *SQUARE DANCING* contains an article about "Working with the Handicapable Dancer" and lists leaders of these dancers. The article also recognizes the Committee for Handicapable Dancers, USDA, as the central contact for coordination of information about individuals and groups working with the disabled. They state that *SQUARE DANCING* magazine intends to direct all future information as well as questions relating to handicapable dancers to their attention and suggests that all others working in this special field contact them.

Another milestone in the Handicapable Dancer movement was established at the annual meeting of United Square Dancers of America when a Resolution was passed encouraging square dancers and Callers to promote the establishment of square dance clubs for the Handicapable. Along with the article in *SQUARE DANCING*, this Resolution should do a lot in promoting the cause for *Handicapable Dancers*.

Styling Committee

From a survey taken regarding "hands up/hands down", 28 states are dancing with "hands up", 9 states are dancing "hands down", 16 states appear to be divided. Five countries were unanimously "hands up". Straw polls taken at the April CALLERLAB Convention favored "hands up" position and the following resolution re-

sulted:

Whereas, one of the major goals of CALLERLAB is to enhance enjoyment of Square Dancing by its participants;

Whereas, it is presumed that standardization contributes to the reduction of confusion and increases dancer enjoyment;

Whereas, standardization of square dance styling has not yet been sufficiently achieved and conformity and acceptance of CALLERLAB established standards of styling and timing will increase dancer enjoyment;

Whereas, it is necessary to address a formal petition submitted to CALLERLAB concerning hand position in *Ocean Waves*;

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED that the definition of hand position in *Ocean Wave* type movements such as *Swing Thru* and *Spin The Top* remains hands up as previously adopted by CALLERLAB and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to document the near unanimous desire of those attending the three Styling Committee meetings during the 1985 convention, that it is the obligation of each CALLERLAB member, subscriber and affiliate organization to subscribe wholeheartedly to the established standards of definitions, styling and time for all CALLERLAB square dance programs.

"BACK HOME AGAIN IN INDIANA"

When the National Square Dance Convention promenades to Indianapolis June 26-28, 1986, after a 20-year absence, the reconvening "Back home again in Indiana" will be a pleasant contrast for dancers.

In 1966, when the convention came to the Hoosier State, Indianapolis was just stirring from its Naptown image. But today, just as there is a renewal of interest and national recognition for square dancing, there is a renewal for Indianapolis; she is exploding into a metropolis with all the vigor and enthusiasm of a noisy hoedown.

There has been a rejuvenation of the downtown, site of the Hoosier Dome, in which conventioners will dance. Nearly \$100 million in developments will be completed by convention time. Two new hotels have opened near the \$77 million Hoosier Dome and a third is planned. In the last two years 18 restaurants have opened within walking distance of the convention site. Shuttle trolleys operate right past the Hoosier Dome. Carriages cart sightseers around the downtown area. Fast interstate routes make suburban hotels and motels less than 10 minutes from dancing.

The Hoosier Dome and adjacent halls provide 300,000 square feet of dancing space and the football field is a spectacular squaring-up arena under a billowing ceiling of white, 95 feet overhead.

In this unusual setting, these practical aspects beckon an expected 40,000 to Indianapolis for the greatest spectacle in dancing.

Travel: There are 138 daily flights into Indianapolis, providing seats for 30,000 passengers a day. Among the 15 airlines which land in Indianapolis is Delta, designated the official airline of the 35th National Convention, which guarantees flying dancers the best rate available.

Indianapolis is an easy drive from most major cities.

Housing: Downtown Indianapolis, called the Mile Square because of its shape and size, offers more than 2,000 rooms, with more to be ready by 1986. You will be interested to know that Indianapolis will be able to house a 40,000 person convention

with no more than a 20-minute travel time to the farthest hotel/motel.

Camping: Special campsites for the convention total 2,200, and arrangements include transportation to the convention center, only 45 blocks away. 1800 campsites will have electric hookups.

At the present time, there are 19,000 garage parking spaces available and many more new spaces are planned by convention time.

Climate: Indianapolis averages 71.7 degrees and June can be comfortably balmy. June averages 4.09 inches of rain; a dry convention is a good bet. Relative humidity averages only 62 percent in June at 1 p.m.

In 1986, Indy is no longer in the sticks. Good news for those who plan to dance under the Dome in the heart of Hoosier hospitality.
