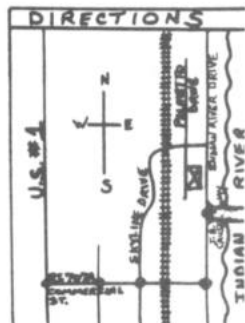

The State Convention is just around the corner. I hope that all the Callers are publicizing the Convention to all the dancers, especially the new graduates. The Convention will probably be their first venture out into the world of Square Dancing.

There will be a full program of Mainstream dancing and workshops and should be a fantastic fun experience for them. Of course we will have Plus, Advanced and Challenge halls as well as a full Round Dance program, and a full program of Clogging in the Mirror Lake facility.

Callers, remember that our By-laws require a penalty if you have a calling assignment and do not show up. If you cannot make it, notify Frank Bedell as soon as you can. If you have an emergency too late to notify Frank, correspond with the Executive Committee as quickly as possible. Genuine emergencies can be excused.

We will have a Caller-Coordinating Room fully staffed again this year. It will be in one of the dressing rooms in the Main Arena.

Full and Associate members, see me for your Caller's Ribbon. I will be in the Main Arena Lobby before the dance Friday night. The ribbons will be available in the Coordinating Room after the dancing begins, and Saturday and Sunday.

Bob Bland reports that he has the Callers Seminar set for Saturday morning with Art Springer, Jack Lasry, Frank Bedell and Johnny Walter on the panel. Look for time and location on the Convention program or a placard in the Coordinating Room.

Harry Taylor reports we have received 77 mail ballots as of April 1st, and they run 75-2 in favor of the amendments. On April 1st, our membership consists of 36 Associate Members and 154 Full members. In order to pass, each revision will require 93 affirmative votes ($154 \div 3/5$). Harry will have a full report and all of the ballots at the May meeting.

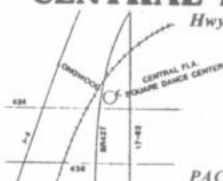

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This is the big month for Square and Round Dancers in the State of Florida! On May 24th, 25th and 26th, 1985 the 32nd Annual Square and Round Dance Convention will



be in full swing at the Lakeland Civic Center in Lakeland, Florida.

It promises to be a real humdinger, with great programs for the Square and Round Dancer, and also a full Clogging program. Many people have been working a long time to bring this to the dancers. We thought we might give you a brief idea of what happens.

Each year one of the five Associations which comprise the Florida Federation of Square Dancers is the host. That means they are responsible for planning and producing this event. Three years before the Convention, a General Chairman is chosen in his area. In the next year, he begins to formulate his committee, investigates facilities, and seeks advice from past chairmen. Two years before the convention, he reserves the chosen facility. He has consulted with the Florida Callers Association and the Florida Round Dance Council, and chosen a Vice Chairman from each to handle the Programming for their dancers.

At this time, the full committee begins meeting. They must choose a slogan, costume, ribbons, and stationery. For the next year they meet often to do all preliminary planning, to plan and practice for the Kick-Off which will take place on Sunday night of the preceding Convention.

Once they have presented the Kick-Off, they begin the big job of inviting all dancers to participate. They make visitations, the Publicity Chairman contacts various media, and they continue to solve each problem as it occurs. It is a long, long road.

The committee puts in many hours to make sure everyone will be able to come and have FUN!!!

This year the host Association is the Southeast. Let's all be there to extend our thanks in person.

GETTING ACQUAINTED WITH POINT TO POINT DIAMONDS



The point to point Diamond Formation will require a little reminder to the dancers about just what makes up a Diamond Formation. The standard parallel diamond formation is often broken down to the "Points" of the diamonds and the wave dancers as the centers of the diamond. The point to point setup will reverse this thinking so it will help to refer to the centers of the diamond as the two dancers touching hands and the others as the points. In the point to point setup you can also relate to having end to end two faced lines vs parallel two faced lines or a tidal wave vs parallel waves. . .

SETTING UP POINT TO POINT DIAMONDS

Zero Box: Right & Left Thru . . . Veer Left . . . Couples Hinge . . . Girls Hinge

(Point to point diamonds with girls as centers, boys as points) (If you flip the diamond you will have end-to-end waves as in a tidal wave) (One diamond circulate will place the boys as centers and the girls as points)

Diamond Circulate . . . Flip the Diamond . . . Recycle . . . Sweep 1/4 . . . Left Allemande . . . (zero box)

Zero Box: Right & Left Thru . . . Veer Left . . . Couples Circulate . . . Couples Hinge . . . Girls Hinge . . . (check point to point diamonds)

Diamond Circulate . . . Flip the Diamond . . . Explode the Wave . . . Trade By . . . Star Thru . . . Pass Thru . . . U Turn Back . . . Left Alle . . .

Zero Line: Pass the Ocean . . . Recycle . . . Veer Left . . . Couples Hinge . . . Triple Trade . . . Girls Cross Run . . . Boys Hinge . . .

Point to Point Diamonds Circulate . . . Flip the Diamonds . . . Spin the Top . . . Recycle . . . Left Alle . . .

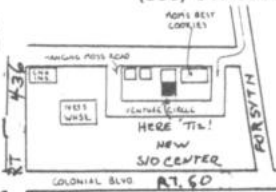

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher

QUICKIE ZEROS

I am going to show you several different things that you can use to zero figures out and this will give you a variety of ways that are effective. Here are several:

Heads Right and Circle to a Line

Touch a Quarter -

Boys Run Right

Partner Trade -

Square Thru 3/4's

Look for Corner,

Left Allemande . . .

From this beginning we can move into other set-ups and keep in mind that your results will always be the same:

Heads Square Thru - 4 Hands

Touch a Quarter -

Boys Run Right

Partner Trade and -

Slide Thru -

Dive Thru - Touch a Quarter -

Boys Run Right - Partner Trade

Cross-Trail Thru,

Left Allemande . . .

Of course you can add to, or subtract from the above. Let's add to that last one above:

Heads Square Thru - Four Hands

Touch a Quarter - Walk & Dodge

Partner Trade - Flutter Wheel

Now Slide Thru and - Dive Thru

Right & Left Thru - Turn your Sue

Touch a Quarter - Boys Run Right

Partner Trade -
Pass the Ocean
Recycle now and -
Swing Thru -
Girls Trade -
Boys Trade -
Turn Thru
and Find Corner,
Left Allemande . .



Of course you can change the basics around and get practically the same thing. Like so:

Heads Square Thru - 4 Hands

Touch a Quarter -

Walk & Dodge

Partner Trade - Flutter Wheel

Now Slide Thru and -

Dive Thru

Touch a Quarter -

Boys Run Right

Partner Trade -

Cross-Trail Thru

And find Corner,

Left Allemande . . .

We have used a couple of equivalents that are very nice and the important thing is that they are interchangeable. We used *Touch A Quarter - Boys Run Right - Partner Trade*. In another place we used *Touch a Quarter - Walk & Dodge - Partner Trade and Flutter Wheel*. It will always work. In static position or in lines of four. Always the same. Try both of them and get used to using them because they will work well for you, and they work out real nice. Give 'em a good work-out and I'll see you in June.

Round Dance Corner

Charlie Lovelace - Tampa

WHISK

One of the most difficult things to realize on a Whisk is that it is basically a closed position figure with no turn for the man and the lady only turns her head to achieve a semi-closed position.

The weight distribution should always be forward at the finish of the figure with the heels off the floor.

The footwork for the man should be forward, side and slightly forward, with the third step using a strong crossing action of the upper leg above the knee. At the finish of the Whisk, feet should not be together in a "hooked" position, but apart, with the body in an up position and weight on the balls of the feet. Body tilt should be slightly forward and never back.

As you see, we could never write all of this description in a dance cue-sheet as it would make a book out of even an easy dance. So we write *Whisk to SCP*; and hope for the best.

WING

Quite often the Whisk is followed by a Wing; the man steps forward on his right foot, draws left to the right and touches. The woman walks around the man, using all forward steps. As she takes the last step, she turns her upper body towards the man. The man must attempt to shape his body to match the woman's. Optional styling for the man is to keep his head to the left or in front of the woman as she walks around him.

Again, we write on a cue-sheet *Wing to Side-car* when, if correctly done, the Wing finishes with upper body shaped into a closed position. If this does not happen, the woman gets "clotheslined" on the man's left arm.

Starting Formation: Facing lines of four
Timing: 10 - 12 beats

Definition: The end dancers do the ends action of Load The Boat; i.e., they circulate two places around the outside of the set and, when they meet the third dancer, they Touch One Quarter to become ends (leader/trailer or #1 & #4) of the final column formation. Simultaneously, the center four do a Swing Thru and, without stopping, Cast Three Quarters by the right to end as Column Centers.

Teaching Hints: The ends have little or no trouble performing their actions as they readily understand that action. The centers

must be cautioned to establish their wave and then start the Swing Thru action while maintaining both hands at the ready position so the action goes smoothly.
