Doc Gray will hold forth with Callers with three years or less experience, and Don Hanhurst with Callers with three or more years of calling experience. They have excellent programs planned so don't miss it! The programs start at 2:00 P.M. on Friday the 18th, and end at 5:00 P.M. on Saturday the 19th. On Saturday evening, the two Caller-Instructors will call a dance for the Callers and their taws. The Quality Inn is going to give us outstanding room rates for this event. It is going to be great, so be sure you don't miss it.

The Annual Business Meeting and Election of Officers will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Sunday the 20th of October at the Quality Inn. At 1:00 P.M. on Sunday, the FCA Executive Board and the Board of Directors will meet with the 1986 Convention General Chairman, Frank McAllister and the Convention Caller Vice Chairman, "Hoss" Waldorf, to program the 1986 Convention. Did you remember to send back your question-naire? If it is not received by September 15th, you **WILL NOT** be programmed to call. You had better dig it out, fill it out and mail it out.

At the May meeting in Lakeland, the FCA verbally contracted with Jack Lasry to plan and produce a video tape of sight calling methods. This copyrighted tape will be made available to FCA members on a loan basis free of charge. FCA members may make VCR copies of it for their own use, but may not sell or otherwise distribute the tape. Jack planned, programmed, and produced the tape at no cost except the actual studio production costs. The FCA agreement with Jack was that in return for his work on this project, he would receive permission from the FCA to market the tape outside the State of Florida. The tape is nearing completion, and we hope to be able to view it at the October Clinic.

Other teaching tapes may be made in the future, depending on the response to this one.

# ROUNDALAB'S 9th ANNUAL CONVENTION

A busy and very productive meeting was held at ROUNDALAB's 9th Annual Convention in Birmingham, Alabama in June, 1985. Round Dance teachers from twenty-one states and two Canadian provinces participated this year. Since ROUNDALAB's first convention, it has grown to a membership of 561 teaching couples.

Among the many topics presented was Video Taping, which opens up a whole new field of learning through visual help. You'll be hearing more later as this exciting new teaching aid develops.

Of interest to Square Dance Callers is the development of a Callers Manual for "Using Rounds in the Square Dance Program". This manual has been published in an easy-to-mail edition and is available to callers and other interested persons. This booklet covers many facts of Round Dancing, including Rounds in the Basics Square Dance Class, Figures, Positions and Definitions, Teaching Techniques, and other valuable information.

Significant progress is also being made in developing a Phase Rating System to rate round dances according to their complexity:

Phase 1 - Square Dance Level

Phase 2 - Easy

Phase 3 - Easy Intermediate

Phase 4 - Intermediate

Phase 5 - High Intermediate

Phase 6 - Advanced

As these terms become more widely known, one of the many benefits will be letting the dancers know the level of dance programs as in Square Dances (Mainstream - Plus - A1, etc.) Knowing what steps are in each phase will make a more informed, as well as a more comfortable, dancer.

# CALLERLAB

## NEWS FLASH!

Many callers and publications did not receive notification of the most recent Plus Quarterly Selection from CALLERLAB, *Coordinate The Gears* (8/1/85). The definition of this selection is as follows:

### *Coordinate the Gears*

Starting formation - Right hand (or L.H.) Columns.

All Circulate 1½ places to form 3 pairs (column of six) with a lonesome dancer at either end as in the first part of Coordinate. From here, without stopping, each lonesome dancer and the adjacent pair extend right hands to form two 3-hand stars and, as each star starts to turn, each of the 2 very center dancers also extend a right hand to join the

star they face, thus blending into two 4-hand right hand stars. Each star turns 3/4 and the new adjacent (very center) dancers from each star now trade with a left hand and then turn the one they meet 3/4 by the right as the other four slide slightly apart to become the ends of the final parallel 2-faced lines formation. From left-hand columns, action is reversed (right becomes left and vice versa). The action starts as in Coordinate but converts to stars in a "gear" set-up. Ending formation - 2 faced lines.

Timing: 20

There are currently four Plus Quarterly Selections: *Spin Chain & Exchange The Gears* (4/83); *Ping To A Diamond* (2/85); *Load The Windmill* (5/85); and *Coordinate the Gears* (8/85).

### Help Get Cosponsors For Our New Bill - "HJR 316"

This bill, introduced June 17, 1985, has 73 cosponsors. In the light of the House Post Office & Civil Service Sub-Committee on Census & Population's failure to act on permanent designation; we should work for another one or two year designation. Hopefully, by setting a continued precedent of temporary designations, a stronger case can be made in the future for a permanent designation of the Square Dance as the National Folk Dance of the U.S.A.

If your Representative is not a cosponsor for HJR316, letters and phone calls from constituents requesting that he sign as a cosponsor will usually prompt him to do so. Have him contact Congressman Leon E. Panetta, sponsor of HJR316. In Florida, Senator Paula Hawkins is not yet a cosponsor. Also, the following Representatives are not yet cosponsors: Buddy MacKay; Sam Gibbons; Connie Mack III; Claude Pepper. *Let's get the required cosponsors before 11/85!*

Congressmen want to know how their

constituents feel about public policy issues. The more often you write concerned letters to your Congressmen, the more influence you will have with them.

- Keep each letter reasonably brief and limit your subject matter to a single issue. State the topic clearly in the first paragraph so the letter can be assigned to the appropriate legislative assistant.
- When writing about legislation, refer to Bill Title and Number, if possible.
- Explain why you are personally advocating a specific position. Give a reason why the legislator should support the position you espouse.
- Make your communication your own and not a "form letter".
- Be positive in your approach.
- Stress your dancing activities, club name and number of dancers. Relate the involvement in community activities.
- Never threaten or beg a Member of Congress. Always appeal to the lawmaker on the merits of an issue.

# CIRCLE OF SERVICE

An award for dancers only was introduced at the LEGACY panel on Awards and Recognition during the National at Birmingham. This award called the "Circle of Service" is designed to be worn with pride by dancers who, for three or more years, are determined to have made a significant contribution to the square and round dance movement.



The stellar hub of the circle, formed by a pattern of arcs, symbolizes the importance of each individual to the total picture. The same circular shapes flow outward to help define interlocking squares and stylized musical symbols. This linear interplay suggests the strong bond and interdependence between the two "sister" dance activities, square and round dancing.

The method of presentation is for those receiving the award to purchase a pair or two and present them to dancers they feel, have over several years contributed more than normally expected in the way of organizing, promoting and/or educating. In this manner the "Circle"

would gradually spread throughout the activity, thus honoring and recognizing those whose accomplishments have for so long gone unrewarded.

Those receiving the award at the panel were Brock and Mary Brockwell, Vice Chairman of Panels at Birmingham, and Bob and Dottie Elgin, Chairman of LEGACY from Pennsylvania. The

next day at the LEGACY Board meeting, Dan and Mary Martin of Georgia, Ernie and Barbara Stone of Indiana, Bill and Colleen Wilton of Wisconsin, Gordon Goss and partner Valarie of Mississippi, Vivian McCannon of Texas and Vera

Chestnut of Wisconsin were all presented the "Circle of Service".

The award developed from an idea by Mori Sogolow of Plant City, Florida, who had been asked to moderate the panel on Awards and Recognition. The circle was designed by "Hoss" and Kit Waldorf of Pensacola, Florida, and the presentations made by Chet Vetter also from Plant City, and Co-Chairman of LEGACY Leadership and Education Committee.

# Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



## EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

### *Scoot & Relocate . . . Don Beck*

Don's idea starts from a 1/4 Tag Formation with a Scoot Back action, those who return to the center wave will then Fan the Top as the outfacers will face right and single file Promenade 1/4 of the way around the set and then face into the center. The action shifts the 1/4 Tag Formation from an east/west formation to a north/south 1/4 Tag Formation.

Most dancers are not familiar with the use of a *Scoot Back* from the 1/4 Tag Formation. It is easily learned and danced, and while *Scoot & Relocate* is a smooth action, we may, in the long run, be better off making *Scoot Back* from the 1/4 Tag Formation a more common action and then we can add the directional actions to the new wave in the center and to the outfacing outsiders. For example:

*1/4 Tag Formation: Scoot Back . . . Centers Fan the Top as the outsiders  
Cloverleaf . . . etc. . .*

For dancers not well versed in DBD, if you try *Scoot & Relocate*, the center wave in the starting 1/4 Tag Formation should start the action with the wave in a Swing Thru position, the Scoot Back action will bring them back to a normal wave for the Fan the Top action. For those who dance DBD well, the call is easily used from the all position concept.

*Heads Pass the Ocean & Swing Thru . . . Scoot & Relocate . . .  
Extend . . . & Recycle . . . Square Thru 3/4 . . . Left Alle . . .*

### SCOOT BACK FROM THE 1/4 TAG FORMATION

The centers will step ahead and Turn Thru with the outsiders, then return to reform the center wave as the outsiders will end facing out of the formation. The ending formation is a 3/4 Tag Formation. Just like a beginner learning Scoot Back, it is often best to start with the center wave made up of four girls or four boys. The center wave if right handed will end right handed.

### USING CLOVERLEAF AT THE MAINSTREAM PLATEAU

The call *Cloverleaf* can be easily used two different ways, from a completed Double Pass Thru Formation where all dancers do the Cloverleaf action ending back in a Double Pass Thru Formation and by couples back to back facing out of the square. The latter is often called a "clover" for short but it is best to say Cloverleaf.

*Heads Pass Thru & Cloverleaf . . . Zoom . . . Square Thru 3/4 . . . Left Alle . . .*

*Heads Rollaway . . . Pass Thru . . . Cloverleaf . . . Zoom . . . Box the Gnat . . .  
Square Thru 3/4 . . . Left Alle . . .*

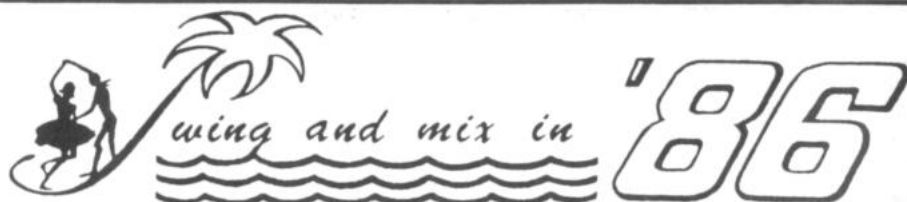

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

*Les Gotcher*

## FOOD FOR THOUGHT

There has been, and is being, a lot written about "dropouts" in the square dance world. No doubt about it, there are a lot of dropouts, and I would suppose that every caller and leader has his or her own ideas as to what is causing tremendous departure from such a family recreation, where everyone can enjoy themselves, old or young, all dancing together and all having fun, with not a care in the world.

I have read article after article about this catastrophe, and believe me, that's exactly what it is—catastrophe. Almost ninety per cent of those writing about it agrees that the dancers are being pushed too hard and too fast. Practically all of them agree that it's the fault of the caller that this is being done, so we will have to see what can be done to rectify this fault, and where else would we start to make some changes except with the 'newer callers' themselves. The older callers are the ones that caused the problem, and they simply refuse to face up to what they did. So we must turn to you younger callers and see what we can do to make the turn around.

Most writers, and many of them are the dancers themselves, agree that the 'FUN' has been taken out of square dancing. The dancers are no more than through the beginner class when they are pushed into 'plus', then no sooner are they out of that class and they are asked to get into an 'advanced' class. Then into 'challenge', etc.

Obviously, the answer would be to 'put the fun back in square dancing'. How do we do that? Actually, it's not that much of a problem. The obvious answer would be to quit pushing the dancers. Let them go through the beginner class. Make good 'Mainstream' dancers out of them and then all agree right off that they will not be asked to go into any other class for at least two, three, or four years. To do this you will have to see that they enjoy themselves dancing the 'Mainstream' basics and figures. You yourself must educate yourself to take just those basics and change them into as many different figures as you can, and you should use a lot of 'mixers' and easy calls to keep everyone happy. Try some of the older singing calls, some that are also mixers.

I have list after list of these old calls that the dancers would enjoy today just the same as they enjoyed them 50 or 60 years ago. Let me list a few of them and I am sure that the music to most of them are available. Here is a partial list:

Darling Nellie Gray; Looby Loo; Shoo Fly; Oh Susanna; Irish Washerwoman; Life On The Ocean Wave; Virginia Reel; Square Dance In The Old Town Tonight (to the tune of 'Hot Time In The Old Town Tonight'); *Slaunch to Donegal*; *Little Brown Jug*; *The Girl I Left Behind Me*; *Oh Johnny*.

## COMMENTS . . .

**Lip Service**, by *Hayes Hirschler*, July, 1985 *BOW & SWING*.

As a caller I was particularly interested in the comments on dancing Grand Square in 20-26 beats rather than the 32 which is the correct, defined way. I, and I'm sure, all other teacher/callers teach this in 32 beats and call out as our novice dancers move to the beat of the music, "One, two, three, turn, one two, three, turn, etc." It is an important tie to our broad and varied dance history and reminds us of our ancestors doing the very same thing.

As a *dancer*, however, I understand what is happening on the floor and can sympathize. The dancer has been taught to *dance* and loves doing just that. Sometimes in certain calls we have said, "Let's not walk in a stilted way like military people but remember we are always dancing" - and then we teach the dancer Grand Square and expect them to do it like a drill team.

In the first place, when it is done properly in the original size of the square, one has to take smaller steps to dance 3 steps to the center or 3 steps to back away from partner if one is a Side. Making square corners is drilling, not dancing, where everything is more curvy. The dancers curve all the corners and that makes fewer steps. I do it, too, since it feels better and feels more like dancing. Also, if one is doing an exhibition to present a pretty picture to on-lookers, the dancer will do better, especially if admonished beforehand by the caller, but when we go to conventions, festivals, or just club dances, we are dancing for the sheer fun and cutting corners is a lot more fun. It really feels better. You try it and see if you don't agree.

My dancers and I danced Grand Square over and over last night to try out all the possibilities and see what they all felt like and choose our favorite. I was on the floor dancing, too, and this is what we discovered. A Swing in the middle with partner when one meets face to face is fun and a Swing for the sides on completion is almost necessary if the next call is Allemande Left. It's terribly awkward to have one's back to one's corner

when the Allemande Left is called but with half a Swing there we are, facing corner, and it flows smoothly. We all decided when we are doing a demo or exhibition to keep it very square with no Swings, but when we dance for fun, we'll continue Swinging whenever it feels right.

As a caller again, I shall continue to teach my new dancers correctly and call out the drill words but when they begin dancing in "the real world", I'll have no control over them. Let them have fun!

Now if you really want to worry about something, let's worry about whether the dancer meeting you in the ocean wave is going to give you a hand up or a hand down and whether you are going to have to fight off an eager corner who wants to Swing rather than do a back-to-back Dosado.

## "BACK HOME AGAIN IN INDIANA"

You've heard of everything going black? In Indiana, as the state's square dancers prepare for the 35th National Square Dance Convention, everything has gone black — and white.

The checkered flag, symbol of the Indianapolis 500 Mile Race, is a rallying sign for Hoosier square dancers, and their official dress also is black and white. This led some observers to dub the Indiana convention organizers the penguins.

So the penguin has become the mascot for the three-day convention which begins Thursday, June 26, 1986.

Life for Indiana penguins has not been too difficult. Only one square dance penguin was pulled in off the street to help a fancy restaurant which was short on waiters. And he didn't last long — one teacup chain at a table which had ordered a hot beverage and he was back on the street.

Not all penguins live amid ice and snow, something Hoosier penguins refuse to believe in January. Temperatures can reach 90° where penguins nest and breed, and it can get that hot in Indianapolis in the summer; this means there are some interesting possible nesting and breeding sights possible at the Indiana convention.

While make presentations before the National Executive Committee, presenting skits, and joking with fellow dancers, Indiana's penguins were glad to know that penguins lay, at the most, two eggs. The Hoosiers tried to lay theirs early.

On the other hand, they were crestfallen (a not unusual penguin position) to be informed that, besides the king, emperor, little blue and crested penguins, there also exists the dreaded Cape, or Jackass penguin. Nature (and a convention) is not always kind.

Penguins may be from 16 to 48 inches tall, making them difficult to spot in large square-dance halls and subject to being lost in load-the-boat shuffles. They weigh, tops, about 75 pounds. Although few Hoosier penguins can boast of being that light, they nevertheless are cautious of being swung vigorously; they fear flying, landing, that is, in a neighboring square. Some penguins have

embarked on every known Hoosier diet trying to reach 75 pounds.

Like nature's penguins, Hoosier penguins are gregarious and have the habit of standing in lines. Some of these are merely round dancers waiting for the music to start. Others are just trying to get near the coffee pot between tips. A few penguins don't know where to draw the line at all.

Penguins have an alternating system; the male will hunt while the female tends to the nest, then they will switch roles. This is known as "save me a seat while I try to get in the refreshment line."

So if you want to see penguins at work, come to Indianapolis for the 35th National Square Dance Convention. Penguins will be everywhere, trying to make your stay as cozy as possible.

You can determine their sex by their bills. The female's bill is slightly smaller than the male's among nature's penguins. It may flap more often, but it's smaller, naturalists contend. And remember that penguins will nest anywhere; don't leave your hotel room door open.

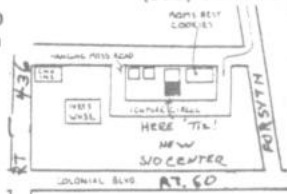

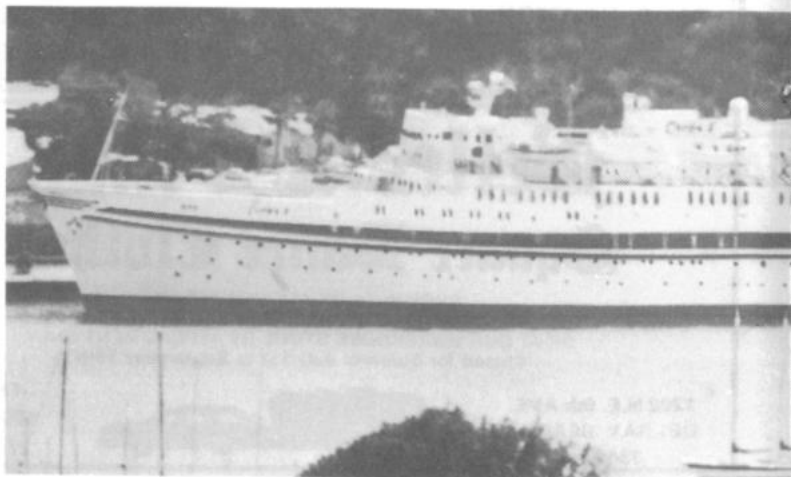

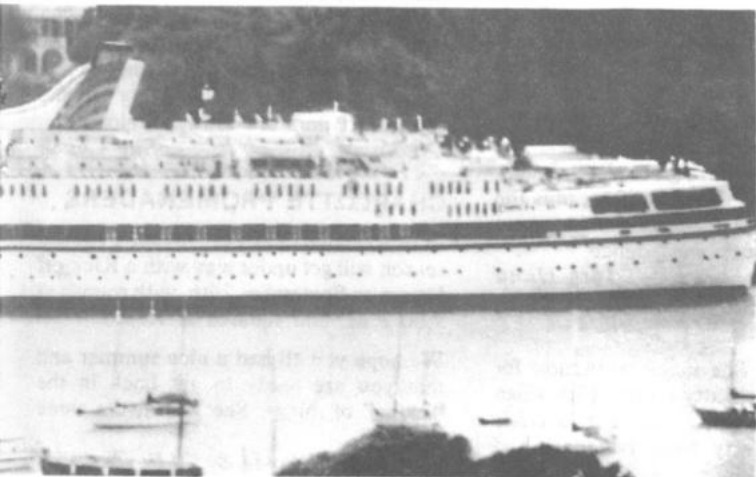

There are about a 'baker's dozen' of the oldies. All were enjoyed by thousands of our dancers in the 20's and in the 30's and 40's and there is no reason they would not be enjoyed today if the dancers are taught to enjoy them. One thing I would like to point out is the fact that we seldom ever lost any of our club dancers. They stayed with us simply because they enjoyed the dancing. They enjoyed the friends that they had made learning to square dance, and they were not pushed. They danced the figures they knew and enjoyed them. It was fun and laughter that filled the hall, not solemn looks of sheer frustration and derogatory remarks from someone because they made a mistake. It was all for fun and enjoyment — and if square dancing is going to live and prosper as we would like to see it do, we are going to

have to make it enjoyable to everyone.

I will be on this same subject again, hoping that I can help in some small way to bring square dancing back — back where the dancer does not have to memorize a combination of basics that someone threw together just to see how far the dancers could go.

Use those combinations of basics, but call them directionally. That's the answer to it.

I am willing to help in any way that I can to cut out a full evening of challenge. It is really easy if you apply yourself to it and come up with challenging combinations that are all called directionally.

Think about it. It's really a lot of fun for you.

## Our Tarnished Image

The 1985 LEGACY survey report should be required reading for all of us — perhaps in front of a mirror.

The 1985 survey brought 7,584 responses, making a total of 19,422 questionnaires returned in the 4 surveys since 1980. Those numbers provide a significant data base. We are looking at much more than random comments and complaints from a few unhappy dancers. We have an opportunity to put our finger squarely on the pulse of square dancing in this country. Right now that pulse indicates a body which is not as healthy as we would like it to be. If we are smart, we will heed the warning signs and take corrective measures to help improve the health of our favorite activity.

Two items of great interest to us have shown a decline during the 4 years of the survey: Club Leadership and the Pleasure of Dancing. The ratings of Club Leadership showed a drastic drop in the last survey. Pleasure of Dancing always has rated highly and still does, but its ratings have declined also. These ratings are significant because they do not follow the trend of the overall average scores, which show a decline and then a gradual rise. Both of the critical areas above fall within our responsibilities as callers, albeit shared ones with cuers and club officers.

If the square dance population is losing its confidence in leadership, some of us have not been doing our job. Have we become so involved in the intricacies of the dance movements that we have forgotten that square dancing is a "people" activity? Have we too often skipped instruction on Leadership and Club Responsibilities in our classes in order to get to more choreography?

Have we really emphasized the importance of leadership in our callers' schools? Is it because the inflated egos and greed (more on this later) of a few, highly visible callers have tarred all of us with the same brush in the eyes of the dancers? These are tough questions and honest answers may not

come easily, particularly if we are looking in that mirror.

The decline in Pleasure of Dancing is damning evidence we have been missing the boat in giving the dancers what they want most—fun in Square Dancing! That *IS* our job as callers—to give people pleasure in dancing. This is where we really need to look in that mirror and ask, "Have I been working to give the dancers pleasure, or have I been using the dancers to satisfy my own desires and ego?" We have argued frequently with the statement that dancers become bored and maintain that, more often than not, it is the caller who is boring as he becomes bored with the material and pushes the dancers to newer movements and programs they do not need and often cannot handle.

It is interesting to review the data on classes and drop-out rates. The average length of classes was 25 weeks. The number of weeks ranged from a low of 18 in Nebraska to a high of 28 in California. On the average, 50% or less of the dancers were dancing after two years in 80% of the clubs reporting. For whatever reasons, we are losing far too many of our new dancers within the first couple of years. What are those reasons? What can we do about it?

Respondents to the survey wrote voluminous comments, and many of these have been collected into a single document and are available for study. They make very interesting reading. We can take little comfort in the fact that, of those comments compiled, numerically the most frequent was to the effect that *Callers are the cause of the problems*. Greed was an unpleasant word frequently mentioned, and there were many comments that callers are doing things "because CALLERLAB said so" without adequate explanation or instruction. It is not surprising that several respondents said that all the problems are CALLERLAB's fault. The second most frequent comment was that there are too many calls, and the third most frequent that graduates are not ready for clubs.

# Charlie's

## Round Dance Corner

Charlie Lovelace - Tampa



Round Dancers:

In previous articles we have looked at Whisk, Wing, and Telemark. This month we will go through two figures that are quite often used together. They are: Chair, Recover, and Slip. A Chair can be executed any time the dancer is in SCP with the inside foot free. Some

people explain a Chair as a forward lunge, and that is all right, but it is not enough if we want to really understand the figure.

There are three different styles of Chairs — the Forward Poise Chair, the Backward Poise Chair and the one we will use for this time, which is the Standard Chair.

Both man and woman should toe in slightly toward partner as they step forward on the inside foot, as weight is taken a slight relaxing of the knee is a must. The body should remain *erect*.

The styling options consist of either looking at partner or looking to Line of Dance. Usually the Chair is followed by a Recover, and Slip to C.P. with the upper body commencing to turn L.F. On the Recover, take weight onto the trailing foot, man's left and woman's right. On the Slip, man's right foot slips back with heel turning out, the woman's left foot follows the man's right, turning to C.P.

Both man and woman should try to finish the Slip step with a feeling of being up on the ball of the foot, not down, which is the common error. If properly executed, the upper body is ready to turn left into the next movement.

To summarize, in Chair, relax the knee and keep body erect over the weighted foot. In Slip, try to finish high.

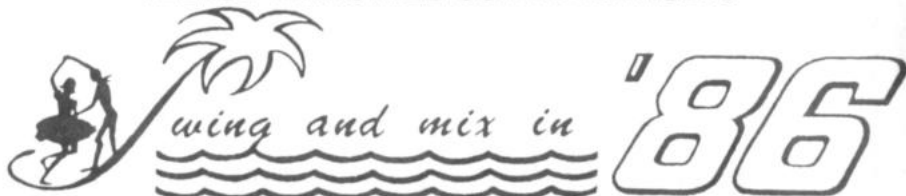

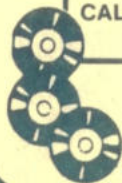
