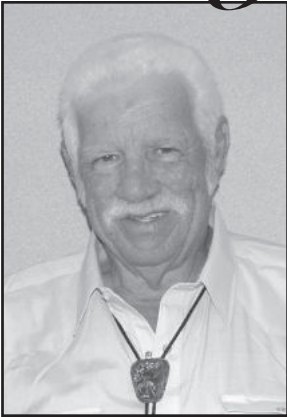

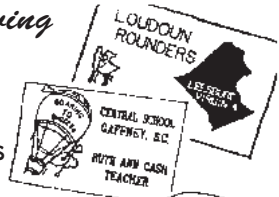

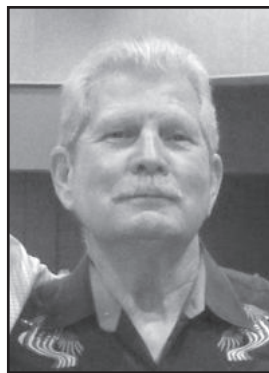
EDITORIAL COMMENT

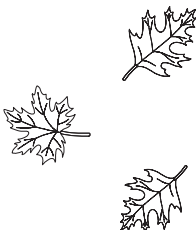

tips with Plus so that the students would have the opportunity to dance.

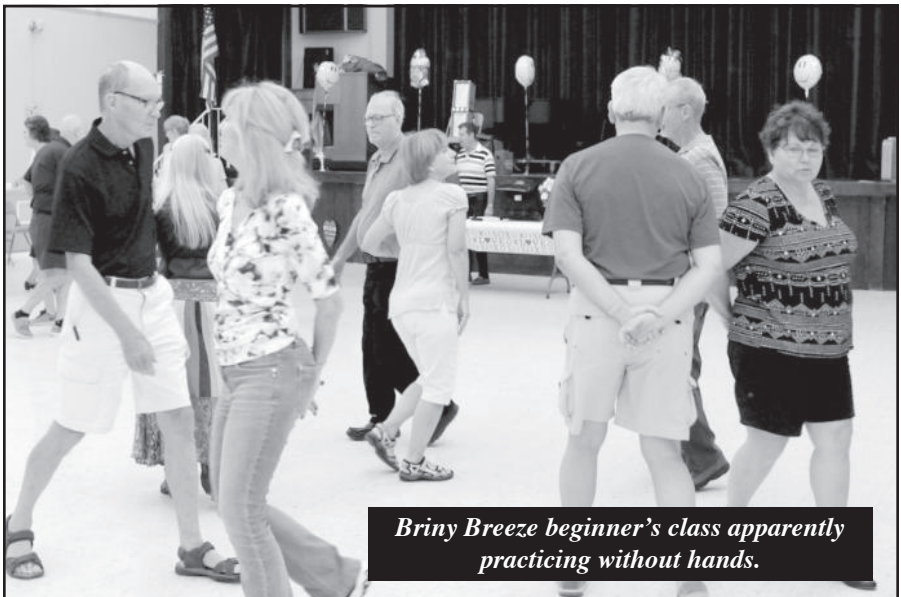
And what will next year bring? It’s going to be our 70th season, so I’m sure that there will be something extra special!

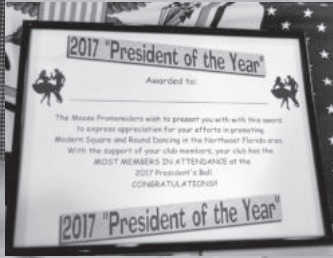

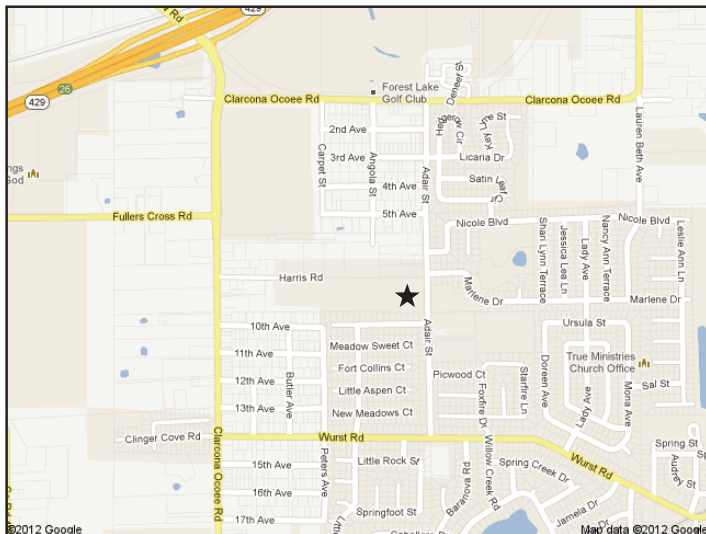
