



EDITORIAL COMMENT




Word has it that all the dancers that flocked to Daytona this year had a wonderful time of dancing, visiting with old friends and making new friends.





I guess we should all start thinking of the National square dance convention in


June and hope you have your plans made. Have a great month of fun and dance.

That is all the news from here for this month. Keep smiling and keep dancing.


