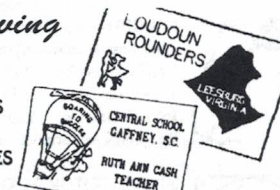

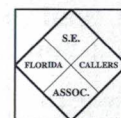

EDITOR'S DESK

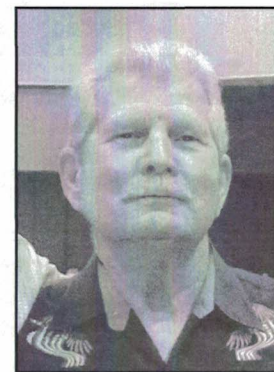

As the clubs begin to close for the summer we ask that you support the local clubs through the summer that will continue to dance and those that are raising monies for next year's convention.

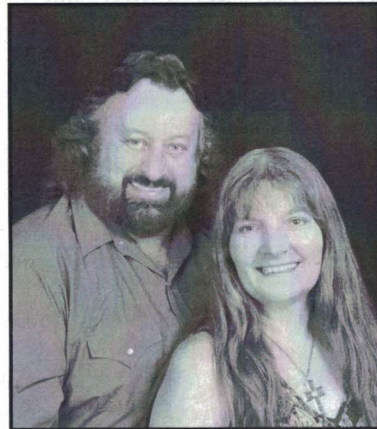

FLORIDA FEDERATION OF SQUARE DANCERS PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

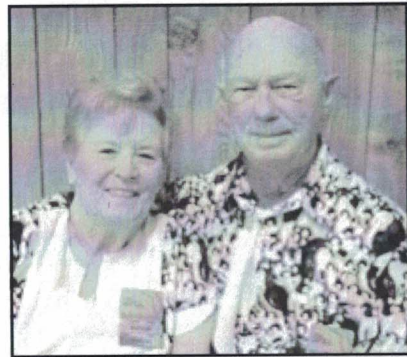

Please give as much information as possible, the more the better. Talk to friends, callers, cuers, fellow board members, dancers that have left the activity, etc. for information. You'll be surprised how many people will work with you to prepare the nomination resume.

By using the above method you may have several, WHO, WHAT, WHEN & WHERE to cover all that the nominee has done in their dancing career. They may have been involved with several aspects of the activity.

Before his death, he estimated almost a thousand dancers had suffered through his “green badge” calling and instruction as members of the “Garage Gang”. She once wished they had kept a written record but they were having fun with people not doing the numbers. Zeona “Zonie” Taylor passed away this past weekend. Jack and Zonie Taylor were highly respected members of the Florida square dance community for over twenty years.

Zonie met Jack at a square dance in Biloxi Mississippi. The dancing became romancing and they married. Jack retired from the Air Force and took employment with a contractor in Iran. They were one of the few couples that escaped through Turkey after the Iranian government was overthrown in 1978. Eventually they moved to the Space Coast.

In the 90's, a very active decade, they were Florida Federation President, Central Florida Association President and served on several committees advancing square dancing. Zonie was the Historian for a number of years. Both were CFA Area Representatives for many years.

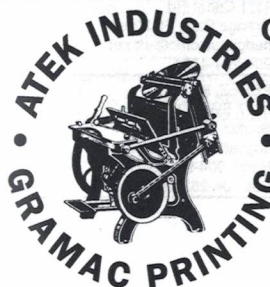
That is when and how we met them.

And we were subjected to the garage abuse. A1/A2 lessons with Skip Cleland many years ago – two squares went down to one and it is still remembered warmly today (the good times that is – not so certain about the calls). Skip would listen to Jack's input on how we were doing and then work us accordingly. Then we'd all hit Ashleys for the late nite ribs special after 9:00. In the garage - Jack would work us on the floor while Zonie would work him to get us where she thought we should be. It really was a wonderful time – we danced; we learned; we laughed at Jack and ourselves; then we did it again; we had goodies; then we did it over again; and finally we knew the blinkety-blank move! There's a lot to be said for the CAMARADERIE born in their garage. They extended it further – to the classes they were in – to their life.

She was in good health until the last moment when her heart failed. She has joined Jack in the Master's Square. Their time on Earth was well spent; enjoyed and loved by many friends and two beautiful daughters.

And so it ends, we say, “goodbye, adios, adieu, aufwidersen, until we meet again!” to a dear friend and comrade.

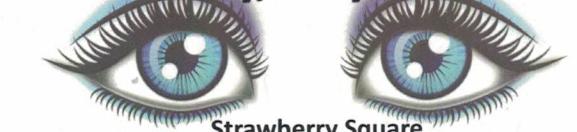
