FLA. STATE CONVENTION TO CELEBRATE 25th YEAR IN ORLANDO MAY 26-28

With a projection of 4,000 dancers in attendance, Florida's annual extravaganza for square and round dancers takes place May 26-28 in Orlando with the 25th anniversary of the state square and round dance convention. The convention will be held at Exposition Park and registrations are expected to skyrocket by convention time. Inquiries about registrations should be directed to Ray and Thelma Thomas, 107 Oakwood Dr., Maitland, 32751. Dancers registering before April 30 can take advantage of a \$1.00 savings. Cost of early registration is \$6.00 per person; later registrations will be \$7.00 per person.

The event, sponsored and planned by the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, the Florida Callers Association, and the Round Dance Council of Florida, will be a highlight of the state's dancing year.

Exposition Hall in Orlando's Exposition Park will be convention headquarters with morning, afternoon, and evening sessions planned for the facility. It will also be the scene for the Trail's End dance on Friday evening, May 26. Two additional Trail's End dances will be offered, one for singles and another for round dancers.

The Howard Johnson's Downtown Hotel will serve as hotel headquarters and the Kahler Plaza Hotel, located near-by, will serve as a back-up facility for accommodations as well as after-party dancing each night during the wee hours of the convention.

Planning something for everyone, the convention will test the talent and tax the endurance of both callers and dancers. Close to 50 Florida callers and 40 round dance leaders will be on hand to direct the various dance sessions and after-party programs. Highlighting the evening dances will be eight of Florida's finest callers. Elmer Sheffield, Johnny Walter, Art Springer, Ron Schneider, Singin' Sam Mitchell, Jack Lasry, Danny Robinson, and Roger Chapman will be putting "the bounce in the dancers' steps" Saturday and Sunday nights.

State Convention In Orlando

John and Ester Layne, convention chairman and co-chairman Harry and Betty Cassar along with various committees have "rolled up" a lot of working hours in preparation for what they believe will be the biggest and best convention ever. The convention, Layne said, is packed with a lot of "goodies" that is sure to please most all dancers. Square dancers can expect workshop and dance sessions in Mainstream, Mainstream Plus 1 & 2, and Advanced dance levels. There will be similar sessions planned for round dancers in the round dance program. Square dance clogging which has become very popular recently will be

featured with a number of workshops and dances available to novice and experienced cloggers. Layne added that other highlights include a fashion show, a sewing clinic, singles parties, and teen dancing.

Jimmy Clossin of Orlando, a member of The Square Dance Hall of Fame and an active leader during the early years of the state convention, recalls that Florida's first convention or "festival," as it was called, was held in Tampa in April, 1953. The big Saturday dance was held at the Plant High School football stadium and although rain somewhat dampened the activities, over 100 squares were on the floor at one time. The second convention was also held in Tampa the following year with over 1,000 dancers in attendance, as well as 20 callers. Last year, the 24th convention attracted 3,300 dancers at Lakeland's civic center.

Convention co-chairman Harry Cassar commenting on some of the changes over the last 25 years, "... dancing apparel, music, dance figures, even the halls we dance in have experienced changes, but much of the original philosophy remains with us today. The reason published for holding a convention back in 1953 read: "We get to know one another better, not only as a dancer, but as people." Dancers who have never been to a convention will probably find this experience — of making new friends — the most rewarding of all.
