## IT'S CONVENTION TIME!

"Sunshine 79," the 26th Annual Florida State Square & Round Dance Convention is set to shine May 25-27, 1979 at the Exposition Center in Orlando. Convention officials report that major improvements have been made for more pleasurable and exciting dancing for all levels of squares, rounds, and clogging. New air-conditioning, more drinking fountains, a beautiful ballroom for round dancing, after-party square dancing, and proper Callerlab identification of all halls are part of the new convention look this year.

The convention's hospitality committee will be on hand at "key motels" to help in every way possible to make out-of-town dancers arrival a pleasant one and without hang-ups. Special desks will be located in the lobbies of Kahler Plaza Inn, Hilton Inn West, and Howard Johnson's Downtown for this purpose.

The weekend schedule is literally bursting with dancing and related activities galore. Here are just a few: Singles get-acquainted hour after dinner on Friday and a special after-party dance at midnight. Teen Time on Saturday at the Kahler pool with programmed dancing, swimming, food, and time to soak up the sun. A "Round Table" conducted by the Lovelace's for dancers who would like to teach rounds. Dancers can look

forward also to a fashion show, a sewing clinic, with great ideas for square dance attire, toe-tapping exhibition dancing by cloggers and round dancers; a Grand March on Saturday, skits, and programmed after-party dancing from Mainstream to Advanced dancing with 18 great callers.

Other features include a "Die Hard Ball" for round dancers, five square dance halls (all levels) . . . two with round dancing between tips, two clogging halls with all day and evening clogging for beginners as well as advanced; introductions to round dancing, advanced dancing, clogging, and contra dancing; panels on exhibition dancing, a leadership seminar, and clogging for those who want to teach.

Along with the wide array of ac-

tivities, the convention dancer will also find unscheduled times to browse around the exhibit and vendor areas, to share a snack with old and new friends, and to visit many of the outstanding entertainment attractions in and around Orlando.

The Northeast Florida Square Dancers Association, host for the 26th convention, has made every effort to make this event "The Big One" for the Florida dancer in '79. George & Judy Garland of Jacksonville, chairman for the convention, believe "Sunshine '79" will attract a record number of dancers. The Garlands extend an invitation to all dancers to join them the last weekend in May to share in the exuberant burst of "sunshine" that's due for Orlando.

## Publisher's Message

### STAGES AND PHASES

I spilled some "printer's ink" on a piece of paper! It began that simply almost nine years ago. An idea for a square dance publication. The first effort was called WHIRL. It was a "monthly," primarily concerned with the activities of the Whirl & Twirl Club. It soon became apparent that WHIRL was too limited in scope and a more versatile publication was needed to meet the needs of the total square dance community.

SHOWCASE, the second effort, was born in February, 1973, and for two years on a monthly basis it touted the activities of square dancing in the Orlando area. I grew weary of the idea and in December of '75, SHOWCASE closed up shop. After all, who wanted to be a publisher — I said I didn't.

The "printer's ink" wouldn't wash off. I succumbed to the basic urge and went back to "the drawing board." From its inception, THE SQUARE DANCE BULLETIN looked like a winner. The February '76 issue was just a two-pager but dancers said, "we like it — give us more." THE BULLETIN became a "quarterly" in the Spring of that same year and consisted of four "big" pages. Whether anyone fully realized it or not — THE BULLETIN, with a simple premise: to inform, educate, and entertain its readers, had arrived.

This issue of THE BULLETIN is our healthiest to date. It is a 16-

pager — our biggest ever; and reflects, I think, not only the obvious growth of THE BULLETIN over the past three years but the real growth in square dancing that is taking place now in the Orlando/Central Fla. area. Furthermore, I believe the best is yet to come.

My personal thanks to our readers, advertisers, and all the square dance community for your support of THE BULLETIN. It is our hope that we may continue to warrant your interest and future support.

### Time to Swing in Orlando

The folks in Jacksonville tell us that the 26th State Convention set for May 25, 26, and 27, at Orlando's Exposition Center will be the best ever. The Jacksonville folks should know. If you are planning a "dance-visit" to a square dance club in the area, it would be most helpful to you if you check the "dance level" of that club before you visit. Note that all levels include the calls from each of the previous (earlier) plateaus. For instance, if a club is labeled QS, then it will be dancing any call from the Mainstream Program (MS) and the current Quarterly Selections. If, on the other hand, a club is labeled +1 level, then it will be dancing all calls in the Plus One list, the QS list and MS list. The Dance Legend, herein listed, is designed to help you "match" your dance experience with the area clubs in order that each dance-visit will be more enjoyable.


