# RECRUITING — HOW GOOD ARE WE?

Promotion and recruitment - how good are we at promoting beginner programs in Central Florida? On the heels of Central's Square Dance Month promotion last September, square and round dance leaders were asked several questions concerning their beginner programs. The major question - how many new dancers did you recruit? The response may not paint an accurate picture, for it is doubtful that all programs responded to our inquiry (or knew of it).

Here is what we do know. Only 13 square dance programs and 6 round dance programs are conducting beginner classes (this came as a surprise, we thought there would be more). The 13 square dance programs drew a total of 456 dancers (57 squares) and the 6 round dance programs attracted 187 dancers (93½ couples). Our recruitment total, at this time, is 643 dancers. Not too bad, but on the other hand, not too impressive for the whole of Central Florida.

On the average, beginner classes are small in number. The smallest square dance class numbers 2 squares and the largest has 7½ squares (two clubs reported 7½ squares - Golden Triangle Squares and Whirl & Twirl). A typical

class numbers a little better than 4 squares or 18 couples.

Round dance programs fared little better with the smallest class numbering 7 couples and the largest (Golden Triangle Squares) registering 25½ couples. Clerbrook was second with 22 couples. The average round dance class appears to be 16 couples.

A note of interest here - Golden Triangle Squares was the only club responding to our inquiry that sponsors two beginner programs - one for square dance and one for round dance - and seemingly having good success with it.

How good are we at promoting beginner programs? The definitive answer, unfortunately, is -- not very good! In view of the geographical span of Central Florida - a 9 county area - it does seem our efforts should have reaped a better crop. Granted, there may be some beginner programs out there somewhere that have not been counted - if so, please address your response to the attention of the Steering Committee in care of The Bulletin. But based on our current tabulation, there is room for much improvement in dancer recruitment.

It is a known fact that new dancer

programs are the life-line for round and square dancing. Without new dancers, our club programs will eventually founder and die. Central Florida has an abundant population, and thus far, the square dance community hasn't even begun to tap that resource.

The strongest recruitment tool of all is "word of mouth." All other publicity and promotional tools, i.e., newspapers, radio, television, video productions, flyers, etc., are suspect without an effective "word of mouth" campaign. Word of mouth - it may be the key to next Fall's recruitment program. The recruiting theme of "let George do it" is losing steam because George can't or won't do it any longer. Every dancer and every leader must help "George" shoulder the responsibility of dancer recruitment.

The puzzlement remains - with the great swell of folks living and moving daily into Central Florida - why aren't we doing a better job of recruiting new dancers from this vast reservoir? Current population for three countries - Orange, Seminole and Osceola -- is estimated at 815,000. Our recruiting program drew 643 people from that same area plus six additional counties. You



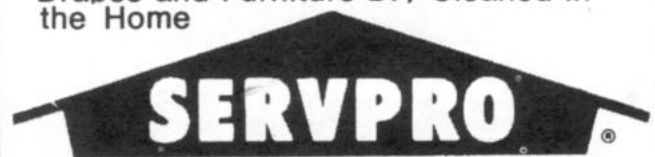

# Overview

## NEW SQUARE DANCE CENTER TO SERVE AREA'S NEEDS

**New Facility** - Longwood has a dance center. Located on the site formerly occupied by the Longwood Village Hall, the new facility will be known as the Central Florida Square Dance Center. **Mary Raney**, owner of the center tells us it is designed to serve local and regional square dance functions. The 5800 sq. ft. building will have a terrazzo floor, hold 35 squares and will feature kitchen and banquet facilities. A number of special events are already programmed for the center; it will be the site for Central's 2nd Annual Spring Fling in March!

**Dancer Survey Underway** - Distribution of LEGACY's 4th biennial dancer survey began last October. Both LEGACY and CALLERLAB members are being asked to administer the forms. Additionally, many square dance publications (Florida's Bow & Swing) are publishing copies for their readers to use.

A total of 5,481 survey forms were returned during the last ('82-'83) survey and about 7,000 are expected back this time. Last date for mailing the survey forms back is March 1, 1985 and complete results will be available after the LEGACY meeting in May.

**Quarterly Selections** - The Mainstream quarterly selection committee has announced that there will be no new movements for the quarter beginning January 1, 1985. The committee suggests a review of calls Peel Off and Fan The Top.

The Advanced quarterly selection committee has selected Harmonize as the new advanced quarterly beginning December 1, 1984. As a result of the Keep/Drop Ballot, all calls currently on the selection list will remain as quarterly selections for the next 6 months.

**One More Time** - Look for the folks who put on the hard drive to make square dancing the National Folk Dance - to try it again this year. The plan is to reintroduce the bill in the next month or two with new ammunition and perhaps a few new tactics.

**Mountain News** - Fontana Village in North Carolina was the site for some fancy stepping recently when 92 clogging teams representing Florida, Georgia, Virginia, Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi, North Carolina and Utah kicked up their heels at the Fontana

Universal Clogging Competition. Competitive categories: traditional mountain style dances, line dances and show routines.

The Buckin' Mule, a mountain dance team, under the direction of **Scotty Bilz** of Altamonte Springs took one third, two second and three first place trophies. The team was also named Grand Overall Champion. Bilz came in first in his age division in individual competition and **Joyce Hensley** of Orlando, another team member, placed second in her age division.

If, on the other hand, a club is labeled "P," then it will be dancing all calls in the Plus list, QS and MS lists. 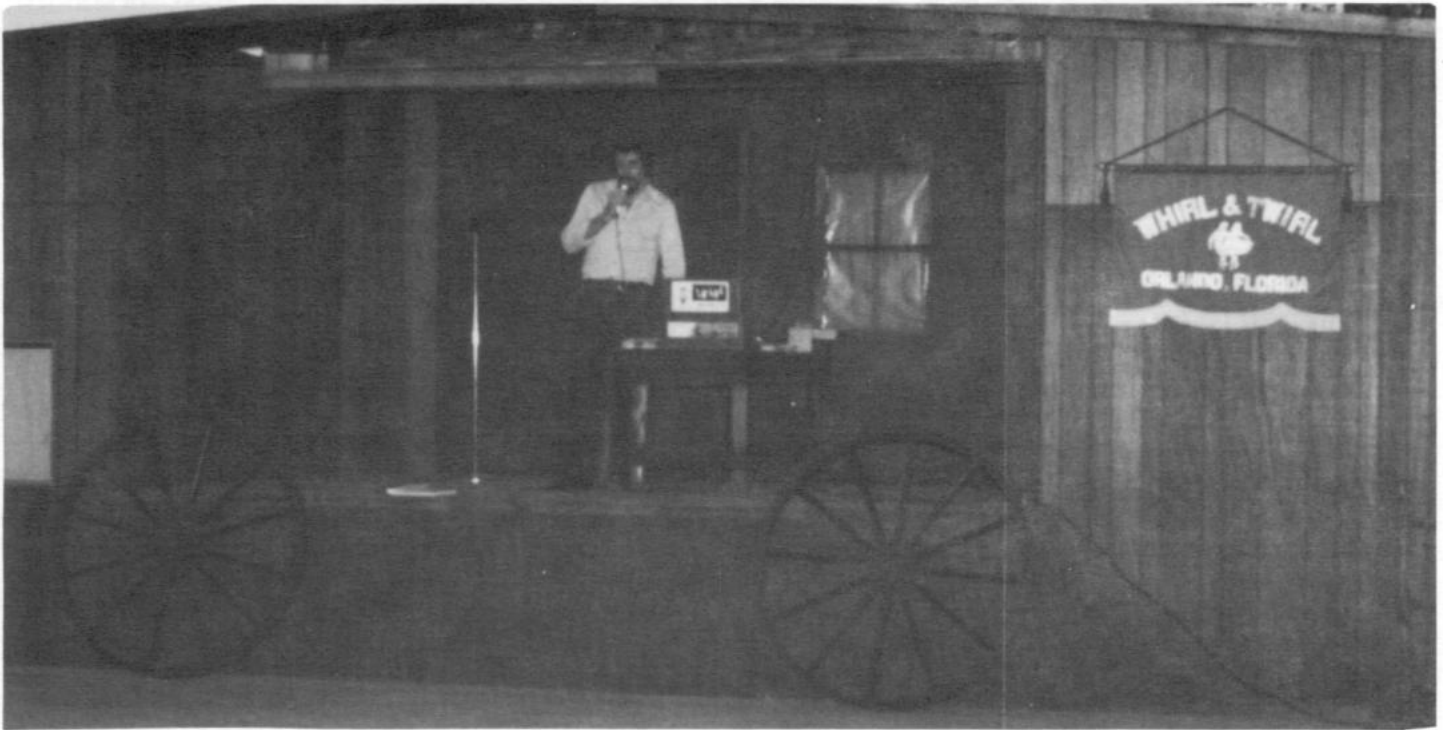

## BUILDING ON A TRADITION — A NEW ERA BEGINS

After many months of searching, near misses and frustrations, the Whirl & Twirl Square Dance Club finally found a new home. Jolted by the loss of their lease at Slovak Gardens, the home of the Whirl & Twirl for the past fifteen years, a search was begun about a year and a half ago. Now all of the labors, sweat and anxieties have paid off.

On the 15th of November, a long term lease was signed for a new dance facility on Hanging Moss Road in the Ivey Commerce Center off Semoran Boulevard in East Orlando. Since that date, response and enthusiasm from club members have been overwhelming. On Saturday, November 17, a throng of some fifty members met for an early breakfast and then descended on Slovak Gardens to begin moving Club assets that had accumulated over the many years of residence at that location. The organization and moving operation was not unlike a military maneuver and what was estimated to be a possible two-day job was accomplished in just a little over four hours.

With a team in place at Slovak Gardens busily packing and loading and a team in place at the new Hanging Moss Center unloading and rearranging and

This doesn't mean however, that we haven't had, and still have some problems. We're working on them and you can be sure that if any group can rise to the occasion and overcome, this hardy band of Whirl & Twirlers can.

As a new era and a new year begins for Whirl & Twirl, we would like to extend a cordial invitation to all our round and square dance friends in the area - to drop by our "new home" and

share some good times with us. The welcome mat is out and the coffee pot is on the stove. As our caller, Danny Robinson, would say, "Square dancing is our game; friendliness is our name."

*(Editor's note: Bob Wildermuth, along with his wife, Dot, is president of the Whirl & Twirl Club. Bob and Dot display outstanding leadership qualities and mainly through their tireless efforts, along with a spirited executive board, the move to a new hall was accomplished.)*

*The Whirl & Twirl Club is one of the oldest, active clubs in Orlando - having formed in June, 1962. In the early years, the club danced weekly at the Robert E. Lee Jr. High School. By the late sixties, the club danced twice weekly (quite unusual for a square dance club at that time) and was quite nomadic - dancing in many and varied halls. In 1969, the club acquired the use of Slovak Gardens near Winter Park. It was their "home" for the past 15 years.*

## INSIGHT — THE PASSING PARADE

*(Editor's Note: Once again, the Bulletin welcomes the commentary of Les Gotcher. "The King of Hash" always has something interesting to say about square dancing. Les, a member of Square Dancing's Hall of Fame, has been an outstanding nationally-recognized leader for many years. I think you will enjoy reading Les' comments - for he is always forthright in word and stimulating in thought. Read on.)*

Wouldn't it be wonderful if we were able to have some "insight" into the minds of the quarterly selection committees of Callerlab when they decide, after many weeks of mental agony, to come out with something that is nearly 30 years old? A figure that most of us older callers have never ceased using since it was introduced into the square dance world - I am talking about Grand Parade.

I am aware of the fact that Harold Bausch is chairman of the mainstream quarterly selection committee. I have known Harold for around 35 years; I know that he is a veteran caller and I am sure that he is aware that Grand Parade is an old timer. This makes me wonder what the committee had in mind when they came up with this bit of asininity.

Grand Parade, we were told last Fall,

could be added to callers' dance programs as of October 1, 1984. On October 1, - I probably did - some thirty years ago.

On the day previous to receiving this astounding bit of information, I taught it to my beginner class in their 15th lesson (which I usually do in all my beginner classes). Over the years I have found that "pattern" dancing is excellent for teaching beginners to dance smoothly; to quit school hopping and to glide gracefully to the count and the beat of the music.

Almost all callers use "Grand Square" in their beginner classes along about the eighth lesson. The dancers like it. It helps their timing when the caller counts the 16 beats with them; then reverse it and that takes another 16 beats. Thirty-two beats in all. Grand Parade takes 16 beats for each sequence and there are four sequences; heads twice, sides twice - so it takes 64 beats to complete the entire figure. Rhythm and smoothness are the names of the game. From Grand Square they progress smoothly into Grand Parade and thousands and thousands of dancers have been gliding smoothly down this route for nigh on to four decades.

As one of the callers in the Hall of

Fame, I suggested five or six years ago that Callerlab use Grand Parade as a selection for beginners. They ruled it out at that time in favor of an "older" figure - Chain Down The Line.

Regardless of any such blatant foolishness, the dancers keep their favorites alive by asking for them over and over. The beloved movements thus become "classics." Let me give you an example of a classic - not long ago, some b-sharp, high level dancers offered me a very high price to come and teach them "Venus & Mars." This figure is a kaleidoscope of twirling figures, all moving gracefully while forming two different sets of stars, changing with each other like the meshing of gears -- a classic figure that will never die. As a demonstration dance or to promote square dancing at some event, it has no equal.

For callers wishing to try Venus & Mars with their clubs, do not tell them that it is an "old" figure. Tell them it is an experimental that you're showing them, and that you want their reaction. You will be surprised at their reaction, too.

"Water seeks its own level," so, in spite of gaps in leadership, the beauty (and sanity) of the square dance will survive.

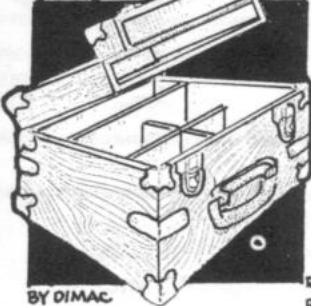
