CONVENTION SETS NEW MARKS IN QUALITY PROGRAMMING, DRAWS OVER 2,000 DANCERS

When the curtain came down on "Sunshine 79," the 26th Annual Florida Square & Round Dance Convention, in Orlando, May 25-27, it was generally agreed that it had set new quality marks in the area of programming.

George & Judy Garland, convention chairman, summed it up rather well when they said, "the convention offered something for everyone." Indeed, the 26th convention did just that. Square dancers took advantage of the five halls set aside for dancing everything from mainstream to advanced material. Over 300 cloggers had two halls for their special activities. Round dancers had their "corner" of the big show with one hall especially for their programs. In all, 8 halls designed to provide the convention dancer a varied and exciting program of dance opportunities.

Exposition Center in Orlando was the site for this year's convention and the Northeast Florida Dancers, convention hosts, made certain the center's facilities were primed ready for the 3-day whirlwind of color, music, and dancing feet. More than 2,000 dancers filled the center's halls with feverish toe-tapping as 50 callers, 20 round dance leaders and 6 clogging instructors showcased their special talents.

Highlights were many. There was the "solo dancers" get acquainted party at the Harley Hotel, the Calendar of Fashions, (a special fashion show with dancers modeling their own creations), the square dance/pool party for teen dancers. There were sewing clinics, funny after-party skits, and as always the wee-hour frolicking of after-party dancing.

The biggest highlight of the convention, however, was the rather outstanding fact that whatever a dancer wanted in dance opportunities was available to him. Workshops of all variety were in abundance. There were "how to" sessions, exhibition sessions, and panels on teaching. You name it — it was there; real growth experiences.

And talent! Outstanding Florida callers, round dance leaders, and high-stepping cloggers adding "bounce" to every hour. Notable personalities were on hand, too. Sheila Popwell, author/instructor (clogging) and Ohio's Stan Burdick, caller/editor, (American Square Dance magazine) adding their expertise to the convention program with sessions on clogging and contras respectively.

The souvenir program was most innovative this year with its handy color-coded "program strips" for

aiding the convention dancer in finding "the action."

The Garlands were warm in their praise for the convention committee, square, round, and clogger leaders, and all the dancers who helped to make "Sunshine 79" an exciting event. Next year the 27th state convention moves to the city of Lakeland. So, shine up your shoes and get ready for another rip-snorter!

Publisher's Message

DANNY ROBINSON

How many are out there?

A few weeks ago, I found myself with a night off from square dancing (callers do have some nights off now and then), so I decided to take in an evening at a local dinner theatre. During one of the intermissions, I spotted some friends who were there with some of their neighbors. Introductions were made and casual conversation followed. As usual, (it almost always happens), someone in the group asked me about square dancing. What's it all about? Is it hard to do? How do you get started?

"How many people in the Orlando area are square dancing?" someone asked. HOW MANY? That question put me in a bit of a quandary. You see, I didn't really know. It got me to thinking, shouldn't I know? In fact, shouldn't all of us in square dancing, dancers and leaders, know how many are in our ranks? As a publicity tool, it would be useful in the "facts and figures department." It could help us "sell" square dancing a little more effectively.

In an effort to discover just how many folks are square dancing these days in the Orlando/Central Florida area, THE BULLETIN, last month, polled the area clubs for an answer. The results, I regret to say, are not too conclusive because of the 24 organizations polled only seventeen responded. Still, the poll offered an encouraging picture. It revealed that 1579 square dancers are active in 17 clubs. Obviously, there are some duplications reflected in the 1579 figure (some dancers hold membership in more than one club), but, even so, it serves as a rather impressive bench

mark for square dance activity this Summer.

As Fall approaches, our number should increase substantially with the return of the "snow bird" dancer and the start of various beginner classes and workshops. Square dancing does seem to be "on the grow" in our area. All of us can help make this Fall season the biggest and best ever. Start by joining in the celebration of National Square Dance Week (Sept. 16-22). Local celebration schedule can be found in this issue. Share your enthusiasm for square dancing with a friend. Invite him/her to join a beginner class.

Callerlab Program Up-Date

The Sixth International Square Dance Callers Convention (Callerlab) was recently held, April 9-11, in Los Angeles, California. Of major interest to square dancers, I suspect, are changes affecting the Callerlab Basics Program.

Dropped from the Mainstream Program: couples lead left, couples backtrack, swat the flea, shoot the star $\frac{3}{4}$, and cast family ($\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, in, right, left). Basics added to Mainstream: pass the ocean and ferris wheel. A suggested all-position list to be placed in use on trial basis for one year.

Basics dropped from Quarterly Selections: stroll and cycle and grand weave. Basics added to Plus 1: chase right, co-ordinate, and trade the wave. A resolution that the word "mainstream" be dropped from the Plus 1 and Plus 2 lists. An up-dated list of Callerlab Basics Program can be found in this issue of THE BULLETIN. Hope you find it useful.

If you are planning a "dance-visit" to a square dance club in the area, it would be most helpful to you if you check the "dance level" of that club before you visit. Note that all levels include the calls from each of the previous (earlier) plateaus. For instance, if a club is labeled QS, then it will be dancing any call from the Mainstream Program (MS) and the current Quarterly Selections. If, on the other hand, a club is labeled +1 level, then it will be dancing all calls in the Plus One list, the QS list and MS list. The Dance Legend, herein listed, is designed to help you "match" your dance experience with the area clubs in order that each dance-visit will be more enjoyable.
