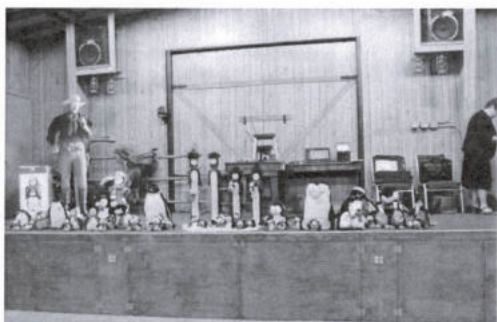

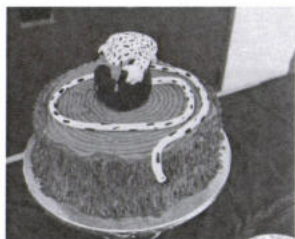

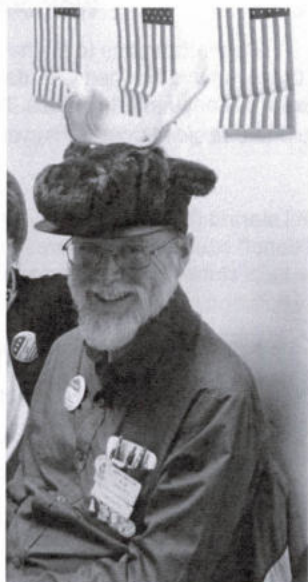

## Welcome New Dancers

Congratulations to all the new dancers in the Northeast Florida area. Now that you have finished your dance program we hope you feel adventuresome and want to dance at other clubs. To help you feel comfortable I wish to give you some of the basic etiquette that you should expect to see.

When I started dancing 10 years ago you could expect everyone to be dressed in "traditional" square dance attire at the weekly club dance. In the last 10 years all of the local clubs have gone "casual". I still prefer to dress to go out for the evening whether it is casual or traditional.

Here are just a few recommendations.

- Think of this as an evening out and dress accordingly.
- Cologne and perfume - Please keep this to a minimum. There are dancers with allergies or asthma that can be bothered by these products.
- For men - A long sleeve shirt, I am told that women do not like to touch sweaty hairy arms.
- Footwear - Please do not wear flip flops. It is more difficult to move side to side or backwards. If they come off someone may trip over them. There are a lot of older dancers and it would ruin the night if someone got hurt.
- If you are visiting another club or attending an event check the dress code. At themed dances such as Valentines or St Patrick's Day you may wish to wear an appropriate color.
- If you have a square of dancers visiting a club, you should call the club's banner chairperson or president and let them know they will have visitors.

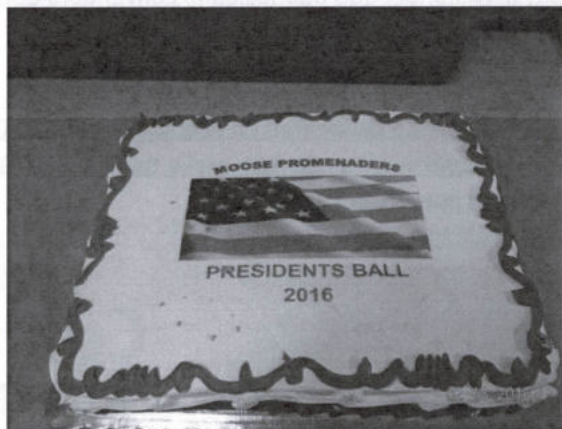


## Welcome New Dancers...continued

Once you have arrived at a dance here are a few accepted guidelines.

- Get up when the music starts. The sooner the squares fill the sooner everyone is dancing.
- Get in the 1st available square. This gets everyone up faster. People don't feel snubbed and you meet new friends.
- You will occasionally get in a square that breaks down a lot. Suffer through it. Most tips only last 10 minutes. It is considered very rude to walk out of a square in the middle of a tip. Next tip mix it up and get in a square with some other dancers.
- If you find you must leave the floor, let the other dancers know why. "My knee hurts, I did not realize this was a plus tip, etc."
- If the caller calls something with which you are unfamiliar do not be afraid ask the caller to walk you through it after the tip.
- When you are not dancing please get off the floor. This allows the next square or round dance to get started. Also keep the talking to a whisper. This is especially true during round dancing. It is very difficult to keep the music and voice at a reasonable level when there are more talkers than dancers.
- Alcohol is not acceptable before or during square dancing.
- Be sure to thank the caller or cuer at the end of the night, especially when visiting another club.

We are excited to have you as square dancers and look forward to meeting you in a square.

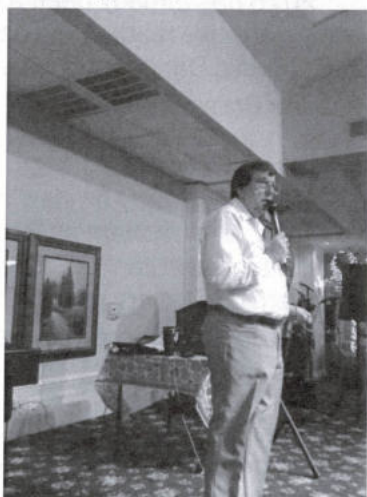
We hope that you will visit us at various dances throughout this coming year.
