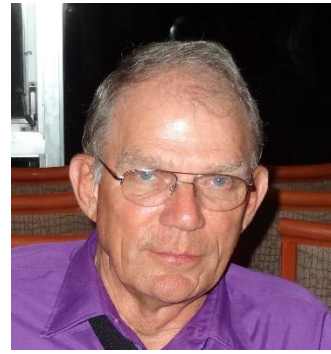

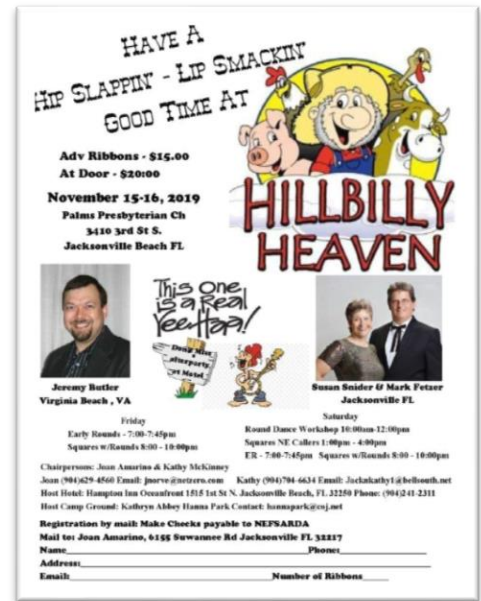

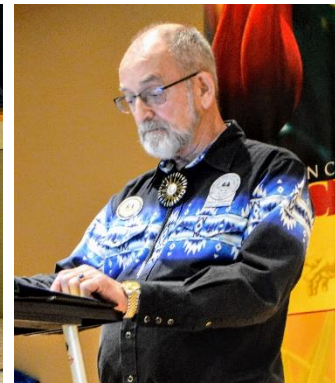

### Aluminum Pull-Tabs - Tower of Tabs – Tabs for Tom Dance

The National Square Dance Campers Association (NSDCA) has a drive each year to collect aluminum pull-tabs from soda pop and beer cans. Each club adds their collected tabs to a "Tower of Tabs" that is displayed on the stage at their annual International Camporee. This year's camporee will be held at the Pride RV Resort in Maggie Valley, North Carolina from June 18th through 20th.



The collected aluminum pull-tabs are converted to cash that is donated to the Shriners Hospitals for Children. These hospitals treat children with orthopaedic conditions, burns, spinal cord injuries, and cleft lip and palate. The children receive all services in a family-centered environment, regardless of the patients' ability to pay. What a great cause!



The camping square dance chapters/clubs from each state compete to see which club can collect the most aluminum pull-tabs. Our local Square Wheels club came in second place last year behind another Florida chapter, the Roadrunners.



Tom Herscha of the Square Wheels (and the Moose Promenaders) has made it his mission to collect enough tabs so that the Square Wheels will be the winning club this year. He has had the help of many other dancers and friends in this quest. With their help, Tom has filled four 5-gallon buckets and he is starting a fifth. These buckets currently weigh approximately 60 pounds. That's a lot of Diet Cokes!

Tom extends special thanks to Moose Lodge 2020 of Jacksonville, Maxine Thomas and two Advance Auto Parts stores for the tabs that they have already donated. "Way-to-Go" to Tom for your hard work and dedication.

Please save your aluminum pull-tabs from beverage cans for this cause. The tabs must be aluminum. You can use a magnet to assure they are not steel - you probably have a magnet hanging on the front of your refrigerator. The tabs can be any color, as long as they are aluminum. The picture to the right is Jim Maroldo's current collection of pull-tabs. Jim expects to at least double his saved amount by May 23rd. We hope that many of you have a similar collection.



There are three methods to get your tabs to Tom.

- 1 - You can give them directly to Tom.
- 2 - You can give them to a member of the Square Wheels or Moose Promenaders clubs. Someone from these clubs is at virtually every square dance event. Ask the dancer to give your tabs to Tom.
- 3 - The third way is to bring your aluminum pull-tabs to the Moose Promenaders special dance (Tab for Tom) on Thursday, May 23rd. This evening will feature Susan Snider cueing round dancing and Bill Chesnut calling squares. Early rounds will start at 6:30 pm with regular dancing beginning at 7:00 pm. We hope to have a big crowd that night to reward Tom with a "small mountain" of donated pull-tabs. If you can't be at this dance, you can send your pull-tabs with someone who will be at the dance.
