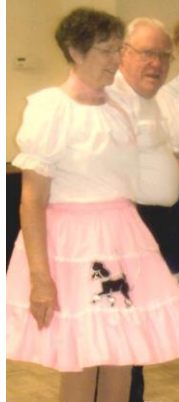

Margaret was born January 17, 1939, in Trenton, New Jersey, and adopted as an infant by William Hyatt Bache and Marie Louise (Marilou) Clark Bache. The family settled in Florida, where Margaret grew up. She graduated from Gainesville High School in Gainesville, Florida. In 1960 she earned her B.S. in Education from Florida State University and went on to earn her Master’s in Early Childhood Education from the University of North Florida in 1984. She taught in the public schools of North Florida for 22 years. Margaret married Dave Kidd on April 17, 1960, at Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Gainesville, Florida. Margaret was very active in the Episcopal Order of the Daughters of the King (DOK), joining the DOK in 1972 at St. Mark’s, Palatka, Florida. She served as Treasurer and then President for the Diocese of Florida Assembly and was Registrar for Province 4 of the DOK from 2002-2014. At the time of her death, she was President of The Blessed Mary, Mother of God DOK Chapter at St. Joseph’s, Newberry, Florida. Margaret attended the first Cursillo (#1) in the Diocese of Florida, worked many teams and served as Rector for Cursillo #25. She also worked on teams in the Atlanta Cursillo Community. She attended Happening #9 in the Diocese of Florida when her daughter, Karen, was Rector. Margaret and Father Dave were a presenting clergy couple for Episcopal Marriage Encounter for 30 years, serving on Regional and National Boards. She is survived by her husband, two daughters, Robin Kidd (Bob Vuckovic) and Karen Adams (Steve) three grandsons, two brothers, and five nieces and nephews. Services will be held at **St. Joseph’s Episcopal Church, Newberry, Florida on Saturday, April 2, 2022 at 10:30am.** Flowers are welcome, as are gifts to St. Joseph’s or Haven Hospice.
