As members of a North Florida square dance club, you are a member of NEFSARDA. NEFSARDA is the Northeast Florida Square and Round Dance Association. The purpose of NEFSARDA is to help support your club. They do this in many ways.

You are currently reading The Grapevine. The Grapevine's purpose is to keep dancers informed about what other clubs are doing, dancers who are not well, as well as state and national square dance activities. Kathy and Charles Trimble are the current editors of the Grapevine.

NEFSARDA has meetings quarterly on the second Sunday of January, April, July and October. The meetings last about an hour and you can usually find someone to have dinner with afterwards. This is a face-to-face or Zoom meeting that allows participants to get to know each other, exchange ideas to promote your club as well as make new friends. Each club should have a representative at these meetings. Your representative should then come back to your club and share what is going on in the area. Unfortunately, many clubs are not being represented. If you volunteer to be a club representative, you are only volunteering to communicate information about your club to the other clubs and take information back to your club. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Other ways that NEFSARDA helps your club are:

- Your club will receive \$100 (only once per year) at your new dancer graduation.

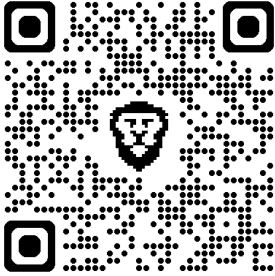
