

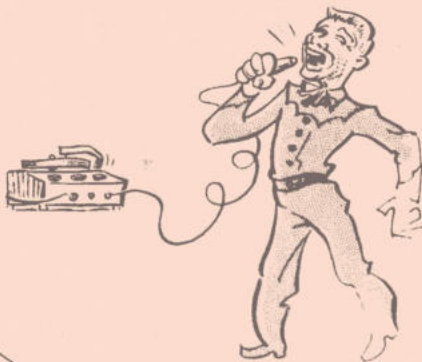

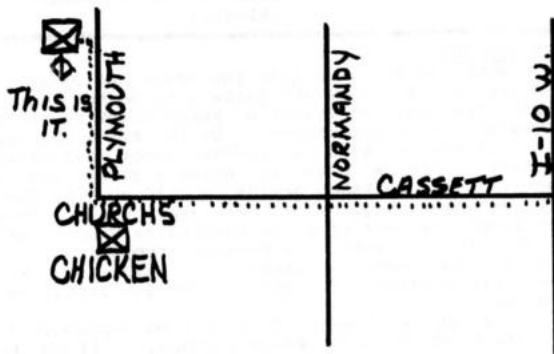

## POP AROUNDS

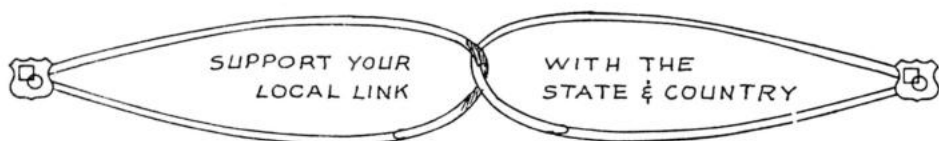

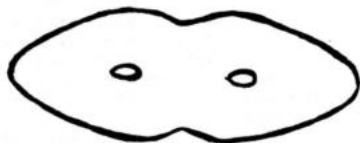

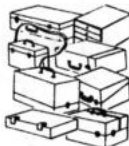

The International Association of Round Dance Teachers Inc.

Roundalab recently held its 9th Annual Convention in Birmingham, Al Round dance teachers from 21 states in the United States and two Canadian Provinces including Wayne & Barbara Blackford, from Jacksonville FL. participated in the meeting They report significant progress in the standardization of Round Dance terminology and in developing a Phase Rating System to rate round dances according to their complexity While at the meeting all teachers attended several teacher training seminars The results of the recently concluded Roundalab worldwide survey of round dancers was also discussed.

Round dancing has been called the couple dancing part of square dancing Round dancing is done in a circle formation using choreographed routines to a definite arrangement of music All couples dance the same steps at the same time together Round dancing uses many rhythms and tempos from folk and other dances

Wayne and Barbara have been members of Roundalab since 1977 and serve as chairman for Phase V Standardization committee They were recently elected to the Board of Directors and will serve for 3 years They are also members of the Video Taping Committee which is in the progress of putting our Phase System of basics on vide tape Wayne and Barbara also received their ten year teaching certificate
