AN OPEN LETTER TO SQUARE DANCERS & ASPIRING CALLERS ---- Several times recently I have had occasion to overhear square dancers make the comment that they were going to apply for membership to the Florida Caller's Association, in order to acquire a green Caller's badge, so they could attend all the dances and gain free admission. . . . I, therefore feel compelled to write this open letter to square dancers and aspiring callers alike.

First let me say that anyone who has the sincere desire to join the Fla. Caller's Assoc. may do so as an associate member (green badge). He or she must be sponsored by three full members (white badge). In sponsoring a potential associate member, sponsoring member shall accept the responsibility of verifying that the potential member is, in their opinion a qualified candidate for membership. In addition, some of the criteria an associate must meet are: (1) attend at least one Fall Callers Clinic and (2) attend a recognized Caller's School or Caller's College. These are not all the standards, just some of the requirements I feel are necessary to point out at this time.

Secondly, no badge, regardless of color, gains free admission to any dance. This is a courtesy extended to an individual by the host club or organization and is not mandatory in any way. In this regard, I feel clubs should, at their business meeting, discuss this and decide as a club, what individual will be honored with this courtesy and under what conditions. Along those same lines, it should be decided by the club, in the event of a visiting caller, should he be asked to call a tip, and if so, under what circumstances? Will this visiting caller contribute to the enjoyment of the dancers this particular night, or is he going to be a hinderance to the Caller who is engaged to call that particular dance. Are you as host; placing the visiting caller in an embarrassing position? These are just a few things that should be considered prior to deciding on any course of action.

Third, we as Square Dance Leaders and Callers are constantly faced with the problem of square dance drop-outs. After graduation from a class of five or six squares, in 3 months there are one or two squares still dancing. What happened? One thing, the club we belong to has a good caller who is professional and pleasant, but does not have a free night to teach a class. As leaders, we begin to look for someone to teach a class, we hear that John Doe has started calling, we approach him, with the idea of teaching a class, and in his enthusiasm he accepts. The Lonely Hearts Square Dance Club has a class with 6 squares and an instructor! Right? WRONG! What the club really has is 6 squares of people who are trying to learn how to dance, and a foreign language at the same time, and they have an instructor who is trying to learn the same thing. In addition, he is trying to learn timing, mike techniques, chorography, music, showmanship, and the list goes on and on. Leaders and aspring Callers don't let yourself be led down this path,

There is only one solution -- if your caller can't, for some reason, teach a class for you, contact some of the other professionals, and be prepared to make some form of satisfactory financial arrangement with him. After all, you are seeking to engage a professional and keep in mind, you're not only asking for two or three hours of his time, you are really asking him for another night out and in addition he is obligating himself to a minimum of eight hours preparation for each class night. When you engage him, let him do the teaching at his own speed, using his method.

In summation, let me say to all square dancers and leaders; please don't degrade all of the callers with unfounded remarks, or because you might have had one unhappy experience with one individual. To the callers, white or green badge, let me say to you, when you were accepted into the Caller's Association, you subscribed to a code of ethics, and our association is respected and used as an exemple throughout the nation. Our membership intends to maintain this status, therefore if you conform, you will gain the respect and courtesies of a professional.
