Meeting of the NEFSDA was called to order by President, Frank Hamwey, at 2:30 P.M. The invocation was given by Virgil Green.

Mrs. Noel Parsons of the Phillips International Travel Agency presented information on transportation to the 1981 National Square & Round Dance Convention to be held in Seattle Wash. in June.

Roll Call was taken by the Recording Secretary, Bill Stanton. 19 member clubs were present, thus constituting a quorum. New delegates were asked to introduce themselves. A question was raised as to whether the By-Laws allowed the wife of a Permanent Delegate to be a club delegate. Since there was a quorum present without these delegates in question, it was decided to take up this matter at a later date.

Minutes of the September meeting had been mailed to the delegates prior to the meeting so were not read. George Ephrem had several corrections. They were: In the second paragraph under the Florida Federation report the last sentence be changed to read "A majority approved to check into this prior to taking any action". George also asked what had happened to the discussion about free distribution of the Grapevine that was brought up at a previous meeting. He also stated that the price of \$5.00 for the Tony Oxendine dance on Jan. 3, sponsored by the Sunshine Sweethearts, had been omitted. The report was approved as amended.
