HEADING INTO THE '90s

It is time to enroll in the Square Dancer's Insurance program for 1990. The insurance year is the calendar year-January 1 through December 31. The premium fee remains at a very low \$1.90 per member per year. The minimum fee for a club is \$30.00. If your club is interested and wants to be covered for the full year, the application must be in the hands of the NEFSARDA insurance representative by December 16.

All clubs dancing in Duval County Schools must be insured and have the School Board named as Additional insured. This is an agreement made by NEFSARDA with the School Board.

The insurance program is a service provided by NEFSARDA through the United Square Dancers of America.

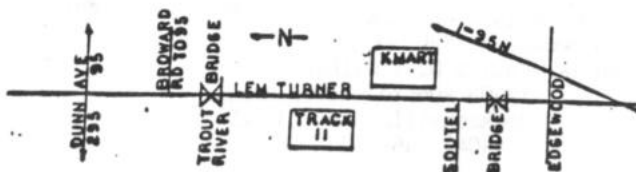

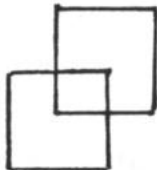

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

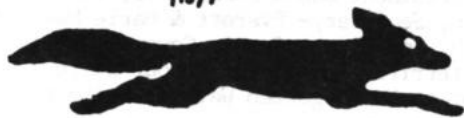
