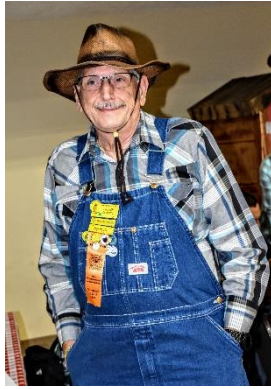

## 2020 Fall Festival

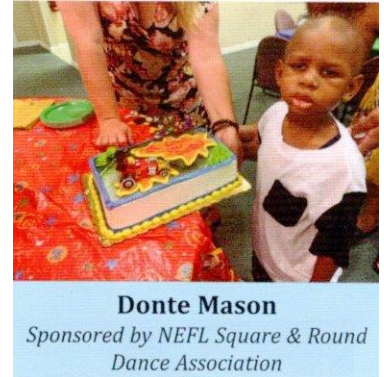

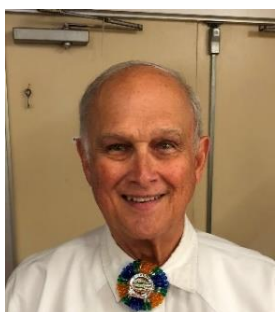
