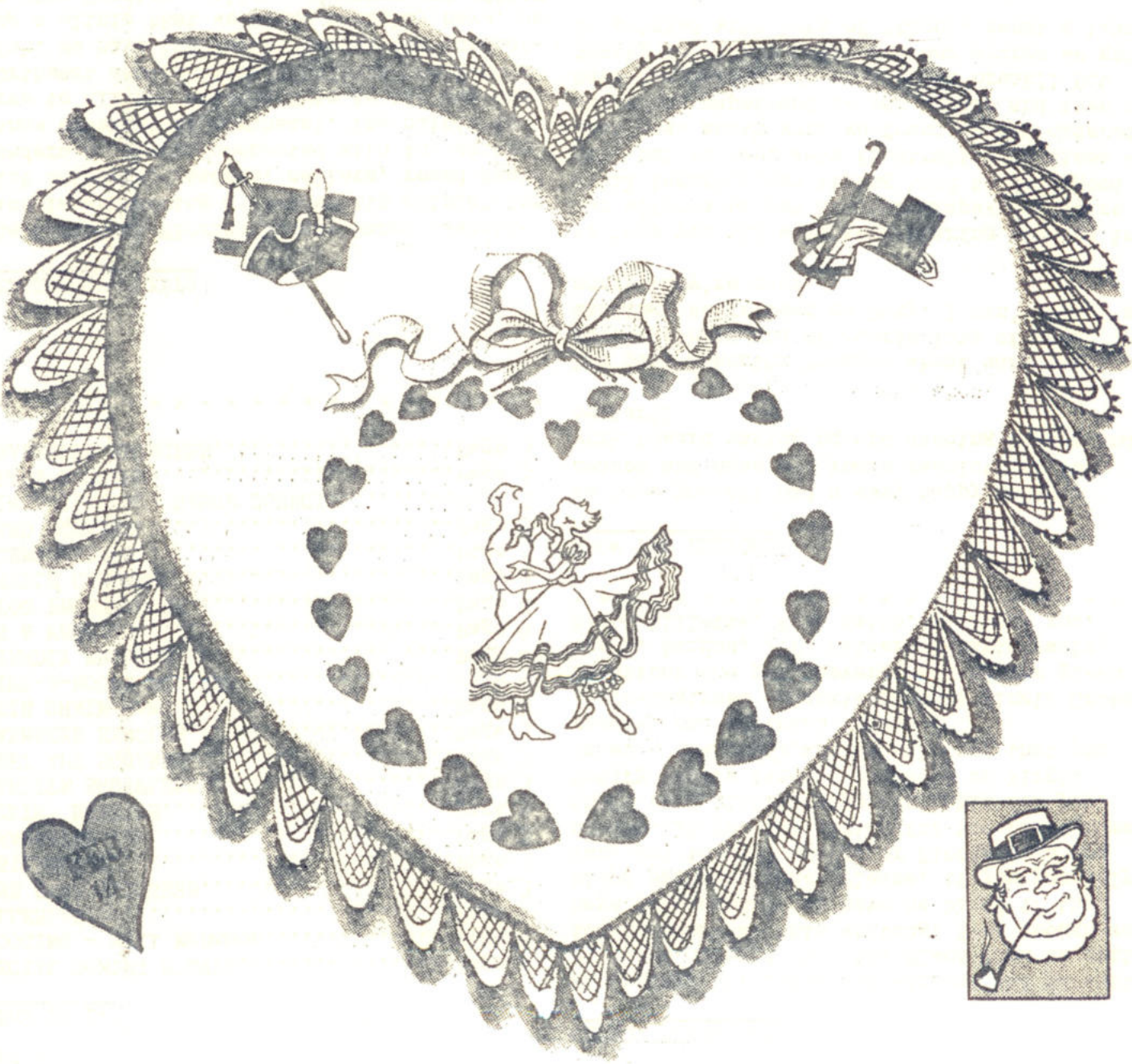

There are many great special dances and festivals coming up, sponsored by our local clubs so get out and support them all - it will be appreciated.



LET'S SEE NOW . . .

Today's Clogging, like modern round and square dance, is a "through the years" version of old-style dances. Its roots are planted in the region of our country known as Appalachia.

The term "Clogging" refers to the footwork which is used to accentuate the dance patterns of exhibition routines.

To my knowledge, no one has ever quit square dancing because he learned to clog. Many people who have first learned Clogging have gone on to discover the joys of square dancing.

The Florida Clogging Council has gone on record in our meetings that since there is a fine line between being a courteous clogger and an annoyance to square dancers and callers, the following has been forbidden: "Square dancing with taps on or Clogging (even in regular shoes) during a tip are No-No's."

Square dancing, round dancing and Clog dancing has it's own little spot under the umbrella of the square dance activity. Each spot is a little different from the others. This is as it should be.

I would suggest that each of us approach all square dance activities with an open mind and an understanding heart.

CALLERLAB  
For the quarter beginning Jan. 1, 1980, the Quarterly Selection Committee of CALLERLAB voted NO NEW MOVEMENTS. The judgement of these callers was based upon the new moves being written and under consideration by more than 70 callers who regularly workshop new material for possible use in the various level programs...Recently, it appears that those writing new calls or combination calls have gone beyond the normal scope of the Mainstream Dancer. While CALLERLAB is not criticising any new call, the committee felt that the moves could not comfortably be handled by the typical dancer who dances once a week or perhaps only twice a month, and that is the definition of the Mainstream Dancer. Lastly, the committee urges all callers and teachers to teach the moves as they are written and not take it upon themselves to re-write the call to accommodate their particular groups. If we are to standardize the moves for the more complete enjoyment of all, then we have an obligation to teach and use the calls correctly. . . To review for all concerned, the current QS List includes the following calls:

- Extend (the Rag) - Make Me A Column - Roll (as an extension) - Track & Trade - Two Steps at a Time - Dixie Derby - Ping Pong Circulate - Track II - Touch (to a wave, 1/4, 1/2, 3/4)

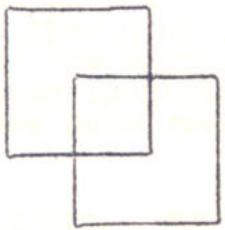
