STRAIGHT TALK

WE'RE NOT ALONE

A common topic of discussion among S/R dancers everywhere is the challenge of attracting new dancers, preferably younger ones, to our activity. We all know that it is fun and will tell anyone who will listen of its many other benefits. Well, we're not alone in this dilemma.

In Ottawa's *Sunday Citizen* newspaper in October was a short article by Bob Greene that made a great impact on us. Two American women on a recent weekend visit to Toronto discovered on their arrival that the annual International Shriners convention was in full swing. Their vivid memories of Shriners from their childhood years were of the many good deeds done for children and of conventions notable for wild, carousing guys.

This Toronto convention made a far different impact on these women. All of the Shriners seen, perhaps except two, looked like their father, aged 73. Suddenly, those wild and crazy guys of memory had become old men. Memories of those hospitals and burn units that helped so many children and were supported by the Shriners raised their thoughts to the future.

At Shriner Headquarters, it was acknowledged that the average age of a Shriner is 62. Awareness and concern prompted many recruitment campaigns to attract younger men. But they have found that younger men are not joiners. No one today pays attention to the fact that it is fun to be a Shriner and to have the sense of achievement of good work.

Sounds very familiar to all leaders in our square and round dancing organizations, doesn't it? We're not alone. What has to be recognized is that the younger persons in our population have changed their social values and standards of satisfying their needs. Is there a connection between declining interest in such healthy activities as Shriners and square dancing and the phenomenal increase in the use

of drugs among younger people? So many of today's youth crave instant escape from boredom, from fear of the future, from low self-esteem, from insecurity engendered by today's competitive rat-race. A measure of their desperation is the fact that they not only knowingly indulge, but commit crimes to pay for the addiction and self-destruction.

Another serious facet of this situation is the fact that younger people do not accept or respond to authority easily. They will not be told what to do. They have to be free to follow their own instincts and impulses. This explains why they turn away from square dance calling and the Shriners—organizational rules, regulations, disciplines, dress codes.

We are suggesting that square dancers and Shriners as clean living and honorable citizens need not only to recruit but also to extend a friendly and supporting hand of welcome to our troubled younger generation. *They* are not alone, has to be our message. We sincerely desire to share our fun and enjoyment with them.

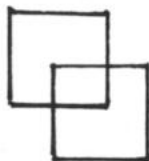
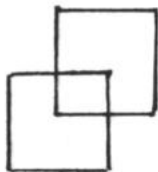

The meeting was called to order by Don Bell (President). Roll call was taken with 13 club delegates present. A quorum was present. Minutes of the November meeting were distributed and approved. Treasurers report was given and approved.

There are three clubs (Crazy 8's, Sunshine Sweethearts, and Red Fez) that use schools and have yet to be insured. Harvey suggested that club Presidents be responsible for the insurance program.

BLOOD BANK: Stephen Bigelow announced the Blood Bank Dance for Mar. 10 at St. Catherine Episcopal Church with callers Ken Miller, Lawton Smith, Jerry Reed, Art Wilson, Jim Cosman and Jim Winters on Rounds.

STATE CONVENTION 1994: Northeast Florida will be responsible for hosting the 1994 State Convention and a search for a Chairman is now underway.

OLD BUSINESS

FLAT TOP DANCE: George Wolfert reported that the carrier Saratoga is under repairs and that a dance on the flat top will be announced later. Proceeds from this dance will go to the Navy Relief Fund.

NEW BUSINESS

GENERAL DISCUSSION: Open discussion was conducted to discuss why dancing has declined in our area.

CLUB ANNOUNCEMENTS: Were made and the meeting was adjourned at 3:29PM

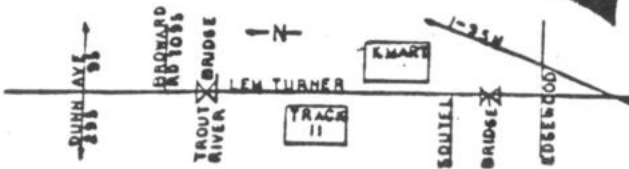

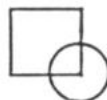

February 2, we will be having a Half-Way dance for our current class. Sure would like to see some of you come out. Wonder what the ground-hogs will come up with?

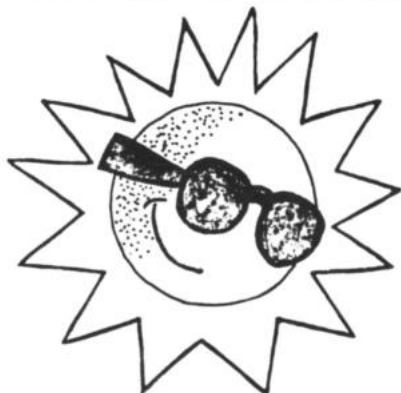

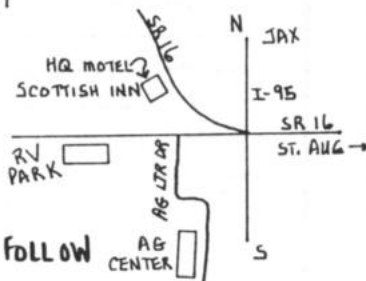

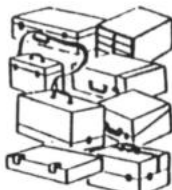
