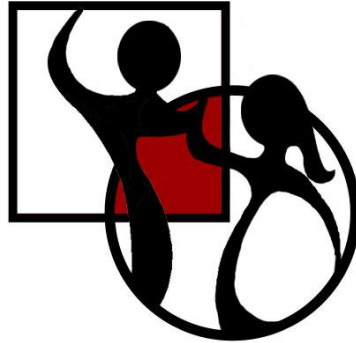

The Florida State Convention

February 23 and 24, 2018 in Daytona Beach, Florida

Three hotels are recommended. Ask for the square dance convention rate.

- The Host Hotel is Homewood Suites, 165 Bill France Blvd., Daytona (386-258-2828).
- The Hilton Hotel, 100 N. Atlantic Ave., Daytona (386-254-8200). The convention is across the street from the Hilton.
- Fairfield Inn & Suites Daytona Beach Speedway/Airport, 1820 Checkered Flag Boulevard, Daytona (386-254-4700). The \$109 discount is valid from February 22 to February 25, so you can stay an extra day or two. You must book before January 22nd.

When arriving at the convention, ask for the EXHIBITOR PASS for \$5 for parking.

The 2018 Convention has a lot of new features

- The state convention is having a BLAST CLASS for people who want to learn to square dance and for beginners wanting to hone their skills. The cost is \$35 for two days of classes. Call 321-453-3438 to register.
- A Challenge-level dance will include ten hours of C dance. Bobby Keefe, Jack Lewis, Chris Phillips, and Keith Stevens have agreed to call C-1 and C-2 dances.
- Dancing begins at 9:00 am on Friday and ends at 9:00 pm on Saturday.

The difference between an “Introduction” and a “Workshop”.

- An “Introduction” is for people who dance at the next lower level. Thus, an introduction to A-1 would be attended by people who dance at least at the Plus level, and any A-1 material introduced will be taught as though you have no A-1 experience.
- A “Workshop” is intended for dancers who dance at the advertised level and wish to improve their skills at that level. Dancers attending an A-1 workshop will be expected to know the complete A-1 program. They will get to practice with some of the trickier calls and explore calls from unusual positions or less common choreography.

NEFSARDA Delegates Meeting Minutes - January 7, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 3:05 pm by Presidents Jack & Kathy McKinney. Maxine led the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance. We had no quorum since there were not enough delegates present.

Mary Giera gave her Sunshine Report. The October 8, 2017 NEFSARDA meeting minutes were approved through e-mail. The October 8, 2017 NEFSARDA treasurer's report was approved through e-mail and filed for audit.

Visitation - Bill & Paul Dion reported on the 2017 visitations. As of January 8, 2018, there had been 148 visitations. The Rollaways are in the lead with 64 visitations; Moose Promenaders, 47; Seabreeze Singles, 11; Mandarin Marauders, 1; Clay Allemanders, 20; Clover Squares, 3; and Silver Fox 2. Visitations were discussed to get more people to visit. We discussed lowering from 4 couples to 3 couples to get a banner. Jim expressed that everyone should wear your name badges at all times.

Fall Festivals - Eric and Robin Burton reported on the 2017 Fall Festival. They thanked everyone for the help in making it a great success. Joan Amarino reported on the 2018 Fall Festival. "Murder in Maui...A Mystery to Die for" will be the theme. The caller will be Bobby Poynter and Doug & Cheryl Byrd will be the cuers. Flyers are available, and ribbons can be purchased.

Grapevine - Jim Maroldo stated that the monthly issues are being sent to all members who have e-mail addresses. Each issue is also posted on the Florida Federation Square Dance website. He said that input should be sent to squaredancejax@gmail.com by the 25th of the month. Input can be within the body of the email or as an attachment (pictures or Word text). Please do not send input in pdf format. Jim would like any feedback plus updates/corrections to the email address list.

5th Saturday Dances - Jane Johnson reported on the upcoming 5th Saturday Dances. April 28, 2018 will be our next 5th Saturday Dance, tentatively in Williston. There was a discussion about making this a Knot Head Dance. The theme will be "Happy Things." Also discussed was making the April 28, 2018 dance an afternoon dance. We will have no dance in June 2018. The next 5th Saturday dance will be September 29, 2018 and the theme will be sports.

Insurance - Linda Tester reported that eight clubs—Clover Squares, Dixie Dancers, Fun n' Frolic, Grand Squares, Mandarin Marauders, Moose Promenaders, Rollaways, Seabreeze Singles, Square Wheels-- have 242 insured dancers.

Federation Report - Linda Tester reported that the next Florida Federation meeting will be held during our Working Weekend on January 13, 2018. All information on the Federation can be found on our website.

New Business - Joan Amarino volunteered to make a basket to be raffled off at the Whirl & Twirl dance hall on January 13, 2018 to benefit the 2019 FL Convention.

Delegate Attendance at NEFSARDA Meetings

Each club in NEFSARDA should have 2 representatives and 2 alternates to provide each club with representation at NEFSARDA delegates' meetings. It is the responsibility of these important people to attend and report back to their club any business that was discussed and acted upon at the quarterly meetings.

When a quorum is not attained (meaning less than half of the representatives or alternates are not present) new business can NOT be voted upon; thus, all those who were dutifully in attendance could not fulfill their duties. Some representatives travel great distances to attend our NEFSARDA delegates' meetings. Not to have a quorum is a great disappointment to those representatives and the board members who attend with the purpose of serving the square and round dance community.

Sadly, there was not a quorum at the January 7, 2018 delegates' meeting. Though we could not alter or enact new policies, we did reinforce the importance of wearing name tags at dances and staying until the end of each dance whenever possible. Clubs are encouraged to submit articles and photos about their clubs to the Grapevine.

Club Visitations

Bill Dion has proposed an improved method for the reporting of Club Visitations and Banner Stealing. The following is a summary of his report to the NEFSARDA Board.

I believe that our visitation numbers have dwindled over the past year since it is not easy to access me to submit the paper reports. I believe that we need to offer our clubs a more convenient way of reporting visitations. Therefore, I am suggesting that visitation reports be submitted to me electronically via mail. All of us realize visitations are a fun way to meet square dancers from other clubs and to dance to different callers. Also, clubs get recognized with "Olympic Medals." This helps keep square dancing activities at a high energy mark. I also propose to recognize clubs with less than 10 visits with an "Honorable Mention Medal" similar to the Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. We can also issue a Platinum Medal for those getting 50 visits/raids or more!

I have designed visitation reports (submitted to me via email) that contain the same information as the current paper report. Clubs will be on an honor system. I have seen no bogus reporting for the last two years. My proposed letter is as follows.

In an effort to better support your club's efforts on visiting and banner-raiding, we are going electronic at last! I believe this will make it easier to record your visits and banner raids. In addition, your club will get annual recognition for all your Club's fun visits. Following a Visit or Banner Raid, you now may email me at billdionrcsail@gmail.com. Please include the following necessary information:

- Name of your club*
- Name of the club you visited*
- Date of the visit/banner raid*
- Type of activity – visit or banner raid*
- Name of the caller of the club you visited*
- Names of your club members who participated in visit/banner raid*
- Name of member making the report*

Remember that it takes 8 club members to make a Banner Raid. It takes only four to make a Visitation. You will get credit for either a visit or a banner raid. Please know this change still gives you the option of submitting your reports by paper as well... Now it is your choice!!!
