Happy New Year. It is hard to believe a new year has begun. We were very blessed in 2014. Our association welcomed 3 new clubs and 89 new dancers. We held several well attended 5th Saturday Dances, a fun filled "free" Appreciation Dance, many club themed dances, and a great Fall Festival. Thank you to the many dancers who worked diligently to assure a wonderful time for all.

The 60th Florida State Convention was a huge success. The net profit was \$11,055.45. 20% of this profit has been given to the 61st Florida State Convention. The remainder has been split between the Florida Federation, The Florida Callers Association, the Round Dance Council of Florida and each of the five regional associations. Our share was \$442.22.

The last Florida Federation Meeting was held October 26 in Niceville, Florida. It was reported Florida has 50 clubs and 1670 square dancers. Our Association, Northeast, currently have 361 dancers. Bud and Anita Taylor will be Presidents of the Florida Federation for 2015. Congratulations to them.

Clay Alamanders, Grand Squares, and Mandarin Marauders have changed or will change their dance locations. Be sure to check. We also have several clubs beginning new classes in January and February. Also, one club, Moose Promenaders, will graduate their new student class in January. We will continue to hold 12-14 week new dancer lessons for 2015. We currently have approximately 65 student dancers attending dance classes.

We will also continue to offer an additional \$100.00 for a second graduation.

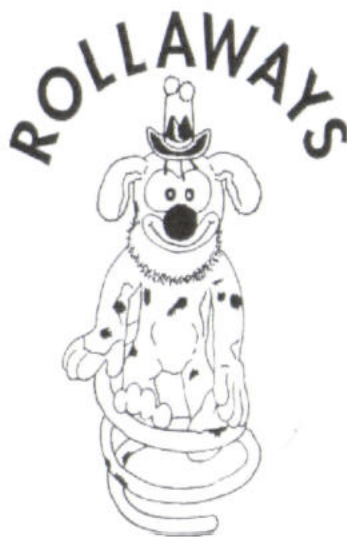

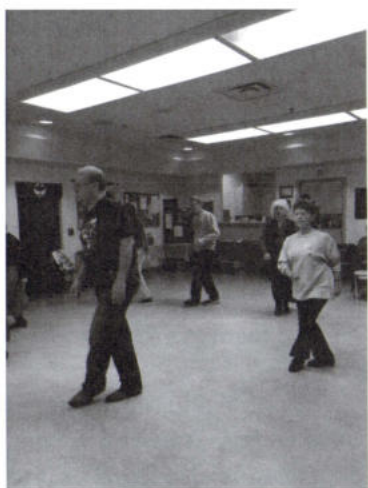
We are looking forward to starting a class for beginners on January 20!!! And we have plans for great fun through the winter and spring months of 2015.
