



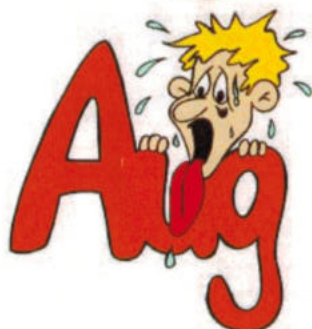

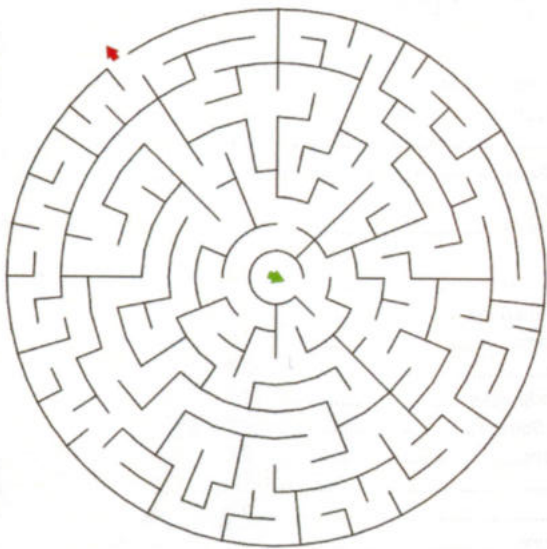

## NEFSARDA DELEGATES MEETING MINUTES - April 14, 2013

The meeting was called to order by the President Pat McMillan at 3:02 PM.

The invocation was led by Val Newsome. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Joe Hardcastle.

Mary Giera read the minutes for the Jan 13, 2013 delegates meeting. Motion to accept and file minutes as read was made by Pat Herscha; seconded by Val Newsome. Motion was approved.

Bill Morgan read the Treasurer's report. (See Attach 1) Motion to accept and file the report as printed was made by Voncelle Hunnicutt; seconded by Ann Hadsall. Motion was approved.

Tom Herscha gave an auditor's report. All was in order.

Bill Morgan gave the Grapevine report. (See Attach 3) At no additional cost the cover for the April, May and June issue was printed on a higher quality glossy paper. A list of people whose subscriptions have expired will be compiled and given to Val Newsome who volunteered to call them and encourage them to re-subscribe.

Belinda Barker reported that the 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday Dance held on March 30, 2013 was a success in terms of dancers having a grand time. The dance ran \$126 in the red but was well attended. The next 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday Dance will be June 30, 2013 at Pinewood Presbyterian Church on Knight Boxx Rd in Orange Park, FL. Further details will be announced when the information has been finalized.

Pat McMillan gave a President's report that included the following 5 points:

**First**, she explained why the meeting was being held at the Quality Inn. A discussion followed.

**Second**, 17 people from Northeast Florida attended the Working Weekend in February. Handouts covering ideas for club growth were distributed. (See Attach 5) It included a summary of Grand Squares membership's successful boosting ideas.

**Third**, 82 dancers attended NEFSARDA's social Fish Fry event on April 6 for fun, food and games. A very special thanks went to the fish catchers and fryers: Ed Van Frachen, Paul Scott and Lamar McMillan.

**Fourth**, a discussion was launched about advertizing square dancing in our area. A motion was made by Tom Herscha to allow the NEFSARDA Board to design a flyer announcing square dance classes for free or reduced rates. Priscilla Bellefeuille seconded it. A voice mail phone number, an email address and NEFSARDA's web address are possibilities to be listed on these flyers. The wording will be up to the NEFSARDA Executive Board. The motion passed. Bud Taylor made a motion that the NEFSARDA Board could spend up to \$500.00 on the proposed flyers. Priscilla Bellefeuille seconded it. The motion passed. These flyers will be distributed to each club as soon as they are ready. It is up to the delegates to share this information with their clubs.

**Fifth**, Marilyn Scott spoke about square dancers giving demonstrations at Wal-Mart. Tom Herscha suggested the same at flea markets. Val Newsome suggested dancing at the World of Nations in the spring in downtown Jacksonville in Metropolitan Park. At these functions we could have flyers available. Bill Morgan asked for assistance in finding more places to give demonstrations. Shirley White and Priscilla Bellefeuille both volunteered.

Ann Hadsall spoke about the success in recruiting new students Dixie Dancers has had using a colorful flyer.

Belinda Barker spoke about advertizing on Facebook, Twitter, etc. These websites are social liaisons that are attractive to and frequented often by the younger set.

## NEFSARDA DELEGATES MEETING MINUTES - April 14, 2013

Ann Hadsall announced that the Vagabond Squares has taught and danced mixer dances between square dance tips. A mixer dance is a repetitive pattern like the Virginia Reel, Duck for the Oyster, etc. These dances enable the students to dance at their club past the time lessons are over. The dance calls can be on a recording so the caller can have his break, or even dance, and the students will often stay and watch the plus tips so they will be around to dance the mixers.

Don Seay gave a Club Visitation report. (See Attach 2) 62 total visits were made during for the 1st quarter of 2013.

Pat McMillan read Linda Tester's insurance report in her absence.

Val Newsome submitted the selection process and qualifications for Dance Couple or Person of the Year. (See Attach 4) Nominations for this year's award will be available at the July delegates' meeting. Completed submissions must be given to Charlie and Val Newsome by Sept. 30, 2013. The list of winners going back to its instigation in 1994 is located on the NEFSARDA website.

Pat McMillan stated we still need someone to serve as Publicity Chairman.

Marilyn Scott read the Fall Festival 2013 report in the absence of Walt and Dianne Syphard. Fall Festival will be held November 15-16, 2013 at the Palms Presbyterian Church with Jerry Biggerstaff and Jimmy and Carol Griffith cueing and calling. Flyers are available.

Bud Taylor presented the Florida Federation Report from the meeting February 23-24, 2013. The best news is that the State Convention on May 24-26, 2013 is paid for. Also the south-east section of Florida has rejoined the Florida Federation.

It was agreed that we would continue to meet at the Quality Inn on Commonwealth Ave for the next 2 delegates' meetings with the understanding that if at least 30 people did not purchase a meal, then NEFSARDA will need to pay a \$75 hall rental fee. Cost for the buffet is \$13.95 per person plus drinks and tax, but we, as NEFSARA members, will receive a 10% discount on each meal. Food is available from noon to 5 PM.

Club Announcements: Ann Hadsall announced the **Vagabond Squares** will be holding their graduation Thursday night, April 18.; Bill Morgan announced that **Silver Fox Squares**, having earned enough money at the Circus Dance to sponsor 2 children's Dreams Come True, will be meeting with the 2nd child this week. The next Circus Dance they plan to utilize publicity for Dreams Come True and square dancing.; Paulette Kilts of **Silver Fox Squares** is hosting a Spring Fling dance on April 19. Gary Murphy is their caller. Susan Snider will cue round dancing. On May 17 they will hold a dance called Ready for the Beach which will celebrate their member Amber German's high school graduation. They are having a club anniversary dance on June 14 with a Flag Day theme, so wear your red, white and blue. On July 19 they are hosting the Dippity Doo Dah Dance. On August 23 they will have a Sha Na Na dance with a guest caller, Ernie Rollen. These dances are 7 - 9:30 PM.; Priscilla Bellefeuille of the Mandarin Marauders announced their combined graduation and 28th anniversary dance on April 25, 2013. They will be a change of officers effective May 1. Their club will be dark on May 23 due to the State Convention.

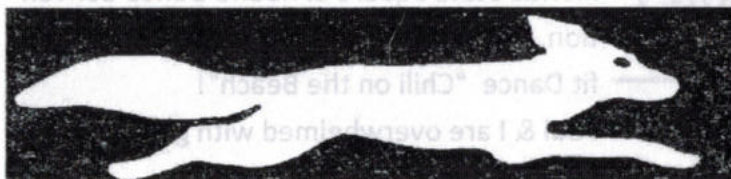

First, we'd like to congratulate Paul & Cheryl Miller on the success of their "Life's A Beach in 2013" party which just went into the History Books May 26th. The 59th Florida State Square & Round Dance Convention gave us a weekend of fun in the sun with excellent dancing all three days.

On Sunday evening during the opening ceremonies next year's convention chairman were introduced and their own special invitation was given. The 60th "Diamond Jubilee" Florida State Square & Round Dance Convention will be chaired by a Mother-Daughterteam - Penny & Jenny Green. Their Caller Chairman, Keith Stevens, started off the invitation by inviting dancers onto the floor from all corners of Florida - or from the 4 corners of the hall. They proceeded to the center and wound up in a diamond formation and as he read the invitation the dancers moved only when he "happened" to mention a square dance phrase, such as circulate, coordinate, swing, etc. Well you get the idea.

It was nicely done, with an excellent reading, and when you saw everyone moving only at certain times, dressed in lavender, purple, and white and carrying purple pompoms, the effect was quite eye catching.

Now, on to the 60th!! Some things you need to know. Let's begin with the Theme....."Diamond Jubilee". This is our 60th year, so we'll celebrate in Diamond Style. More on how this theme came about in future articles.
