Our next deadline is JULY 15...

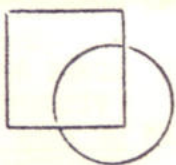

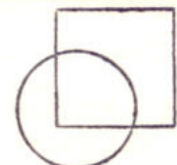

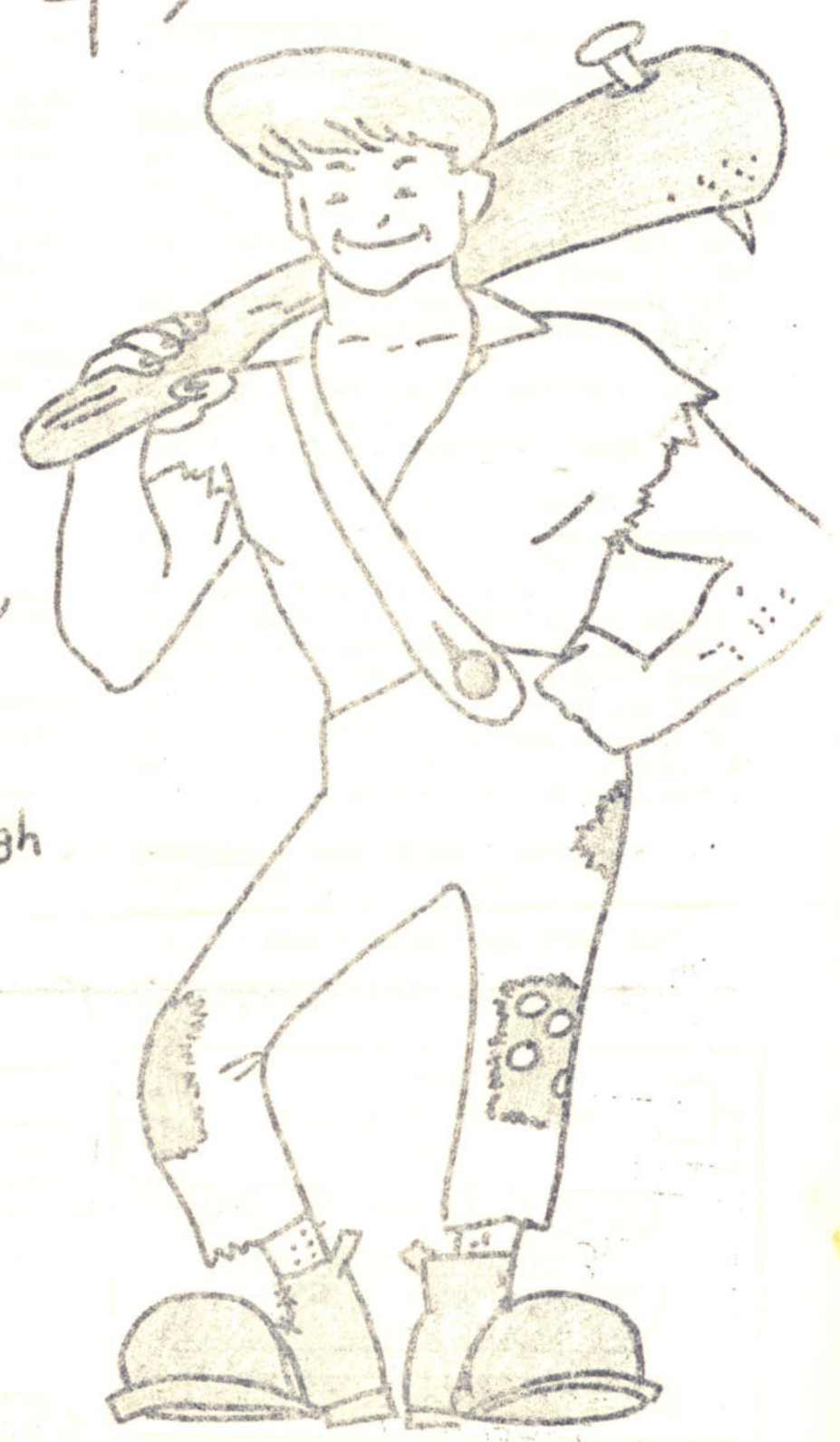

The Gateway Callers Association is an organization of local callers who are dedicated to square dancing in the Northeast Florida area. The GCA members have been responsible for teaching many thousands of you to enjoy modern western style square dancing over the past 15-20 years. Many of our local callers have 10-15 years calling experience (and still retain most of their sanity). At a recent GCA meeting it was decided to write a bi-monthly article for the Grapevine to use as a communication tool between callers and dancers. The format of this article may vary from time to time; sometimes serious, sometimes humorous, but the intent is to bring you interesting facts about callers and square dancing.

Ann and I have visited several clubs over the past few months and were very impressed with the quality of calling and dancing being done in the area. The Dixie Chain Gang should be recognized as an outstanding club with a great deal of enthusiasm. Frank Clements called a tremendous dance - of course Frank is one of the old timers in the area now with over 12 years of calling experience; a real professional. Another true professional caller that we had the opportunity to dance with at his Tuesday night workshop was John Robbins. John really knows how to conduct a workshop the way it should be done. (I stole several ideas from John that night). James Maxey has a great group over at the Merry Mavericks that really know how to have a good time, both at the dance and at Gino's afterwards. James recently took a group of square dancers to Nashville on a tour (what's this I hear about Las Vegas?)

I've had the opportunity to call for several groups lately that I would like to mention. The Lone Star Swingers have a great club with about ten squares of active dancers. It was fantastic calling for a group like that who really enjoys square dancing. Art Wilson did a fine job teaching their last class. The Orange Blossom Specials is another group with a lot of enthusiasm. We had a great time calling for them recently. March 30 Art Wilson (complete with his orange suit) was up in Fontana, N.C., calling and I had the pleasure of filling in for him at the Gator Promenaders. It was fun seeing some old friends once again - incidentally, I used to call regularly for that group when they danced in Orange Park and were known as the Orange Park Promenaders.

CALLERLAB recently completed its sixth International Convention in Los Angeles and there were several significant actions taken by this prestigious group. A revision of the Mainstream Program, a revision of the Quarterly Selections List and a minor revision of the Plus I list.

The membership of CALLERLAB voted by a large majority to keep "RECYCLE" as a NO-HANDS move.

The following resolution was passed which should help clarify what is recommended for all clubs and callers on the subject of Dance level identification.

"Be it resolved that CALLERLAB adopt a policy suggesting that members call movements within the advertised/designated plateau and use calls from any plateau other than that which was designated, and/or any unlisted experimental, only after walking or workshopping that call, and be it resolved that conducting a designated level workshop shall mean, workshopping the calls listed for that plateau."

CALLERLAB hopes that all callers, clubs and festivals will follow the spirit of this resolution and make it easier for dancers to know if they follow the spirit of this resolution and make it easier for dancers to know if they are attending the correct dance for their particular comfort, confidence and skill level. It does not brand anyone (club or caller) as a particular type of person, but rather indicates what the calls for that program will include. When everyone follows this guidance, the callers will be able to program and thus improve the enjoyment of all dancers.
