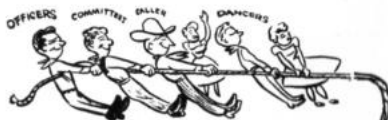

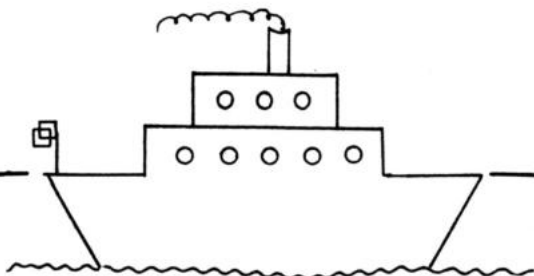

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE NEFSDA BY-LAWS:

All Club Delegates should present them to their clubs securing a yes or no vote to be brought before the July NEFSDA meeting for approval or rejection:

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE:

To provide for a Fifth Saturday Dance Committee which shall have the responsibility for making arrangements for each Fifth Saturday dance including, but not limited to hiring callers and round dance leaders, providing adequate facilities, promotion and hostess clubs.

The committee shall be composed of three couples, one of which shall be named Chairperson by the the President of the Association. At its inception the committee shall be appointed by the President of the Association for the following terms:

1. One couple for three years.
2. One couple for two years
3. One couple for one year.

Thereafter, the President of the Association shall name a couple for a period of three years

The committee shall render regular reports of its activities to the delegates at regular meetings of the Association.

\*\*\*\*\*

Some reasons for this proposed change include the following:

To provide for continuity and experience on this committee and to prevent one couple from having to gain their experience on their own. It also will provide for regular procedures which shall provide for better programming over the coming years.

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE

To provide for a Fall Roundup Arrangements and Steering Committee which will have the following responsibilities:

1. Establish and prepare written procedures covering all aspects of the Fall Roundup.
2. Engage the professional staff for the Roundup including the Callers, Round Dance Leaders and such other staff as required to provide all elements of the program for the Fall Roundup. They will engage the callers and round dance staff at least three years in advance of the scheduled Roundup and longer if it is thought prudent by the committee.

1. Two couples to serve for three years.
2. Two couples to serve for two years.
3. Two couples to serve for one year.

Thereafter, two couples will be named to the committee by the President of the Association for a three year term.

At least one couple on the committee will be from the Round Dance community and the committee shall solicit advice from any other group they deem necessary in carrying out their duties.

The Chairperson of the Committee shall be the Vice-President of the Association or such other person designated by the President of the Association if the Vice-President is unable to serve.

The committee shall keep all records including financial and render regular reports to the delegates at regular meetings of the Association.

\*\*\*\*\*

Some of the reasons for this change are to provide a level of experience and continuity in the conduct of the Fall Roundup which has become a major business venture involving several thousand dollars each year. It will enable us to have permanent guidelines and avoid the necessity of a brand new committee being required to find out as best they can what is required for a successful Roundup.

★ From the desk of the President

We wonder if all the clubs in the NORTHEAST know WHAT IS WHAT. The most recent meeting of the Northeast was unable to transact ANY business because we did not have a quorum of delegates present from the member clubs. We cannot help but wonder why.

Each club is entitled to one couple to act as delegate. The couple can be married or not. Each delegation is entitled to one vote on all business to come before the Board. If we do not have a quorum we cannot transact any business, and this makes it difficult to keep things flowing smoothly, particularly important things like Fall Round-Up.

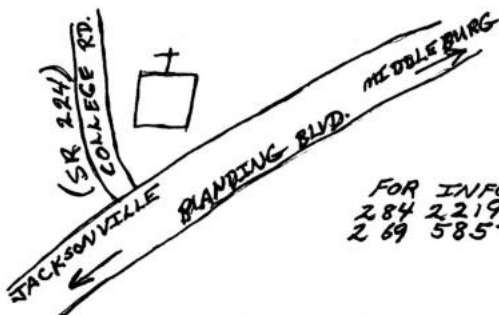
We urge each club president to make SURE they have their delegates appointed, and if something comes up that the appointed delegates cannot make a particular meeting, appoint a temporary alternate. Caller run clubs may either appoint a delegate or the caller can act as his own delegate. This is the best way we know to keep information flowing from the Board to the individual clubs. Your delegate should report back to the club president, or to the membership in general about what is going on at the Northeast. Too often we hear people say, "I didn't know that". If their club delegate doesn't make the meetings, they will never know, and that is sad for the individual dancers and for the entire Northeast square dance community.

If your club does not have a delegate, or it is necessary to make a change, it is easy enough to get them on the roster so they receive notice of each meeting. Simply call ANY of the officers listed on the inside cover of The Grapevine, or particularly call Hank or Linda Snow at 264-4235.

Normally, meetings are scheduled for the second Sunday of odd months at 2:30 p.m. at the Times-Union Building on Riverside Avenue. BE THERE!

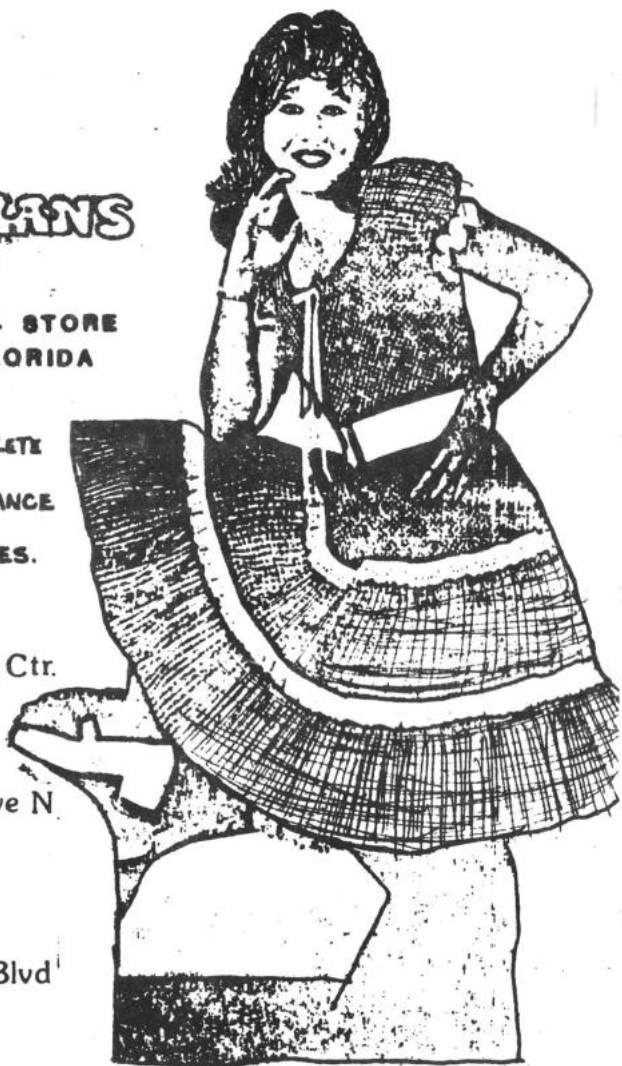
