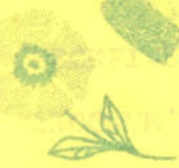

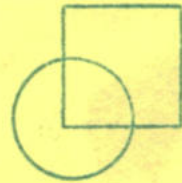

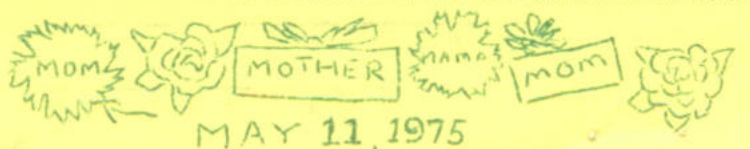
The picnic, sponsored by the Westernaires & Calico Swingers was well into the planning stage & the results will be reported next month.

In James Maxeys absence, Gil reported on letter & brochure received from James outlining caller-lab & its activities, where they have been.

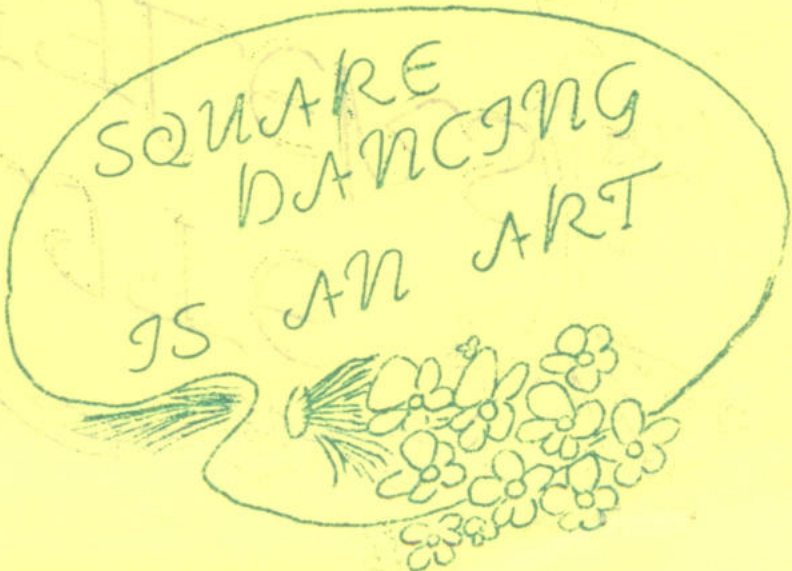
There was much discussion of club identification (dance level) & the pros & cons of this adaption..also Gil recommends that caller-lab material be taught in classes..this motion carried.

WHAT IS CALLERLAB?

What is callerlab? What does it mean to me as a Square Dance Caller? & what does it mean to Mr & Mrs Square Dancer USA? Being the only caller from the State of Georgia to attend the 1st Annual Convention of the International Association of Square Dance Callers, I was being asked these questions. This year was to be different..as we boarded the plane in Atlanta for the windy city of Chicago, we had a total of 6 Georgia callers headed for the 2ND ANNUAL CALLERLAB CONVENTION. Besides Betty & myself were George & Jan Watson, John & Gail Swindle, Jim & Jenny Mayo, Bob Bennett & Rod Blaylock; also from Jacksonville were James & Helen Maxey. After boarding the plane, we met 2 couples from Texas..they too, were headed for Callerlab..Since we were all Square Dancers & we totaled 7 couples & 2 men, we needed 1 more girl to have 2 squares & a caller. Now, if we could get one of the Airline "Cuties" to dance with Bob Bennett & Rod Blaylock to call, we could dance all the way to Chicago. We were leaving the same day atlanta was hit by a tornado & due to the turbulent weather & lightning striking our plane, we stayed in our seats & sang "Nearer My God To Thee".. Well after checking in & getting to the 1st. session, it was like meeting in St. Louis, only this time much bigger. We were seeing & brushing elbows with all the "Biggies"..I mean you name 'em, they were there..Marshall Flippo, Dave Taylor, Frank Lane, Cal Golden, Jack Lasry, C. C. Guest & on & on..The Editors of the 2 leading S/D Publication, Bob Csgood of Sets In Order & Stan Burdick of American Square Dance were there.Stan was the executive secretary for Callerlab & we were to see the convention elect Bob Csgood executive secretary for the coming year. There were Will Orlich, Bill Peters, Ed Ecote, Lee Kopman & many others who write note publications for callers. For the 2nd time there were callers whom I had just heard of, or just seen their pictures, or just heard on records..here they were in the flesh & not a turntable or record in sight. There was not one minute of calling during the entire 3 days..385 callers with 5,000 years of calling experience & we were not to hear an Allemande..All of these people, leaders in Square Dancing & nationally known callers, had given up good paying calling dates, to come here at their own expense & discuss the future of Square Dancing with Guys like me..Not one time did these Pros point their finger & say you callers should go back & do this or that..rather they pointed out what had worked for them & what had not..& then they asked us what we thought..every caller was given the opportunity to get on his feet & say what he felt..they listened & asked questions, gave council & sought council & in the end, everyone of us had an opportunity to cast our vote on each issue. The idea of Callerlab started back in the 60's, when a few of the Pros met at a informal meeting, they talked to others during the next year & in 1971 Callerlab was born..this group thoroughly discussed the direction this group would take & talked to othercallers to establish a list of points around which the group would work..then in 1974, the first convention was convened at St. Louis..Out of this meeting of 124 callers, at least 15 active Committees were appointed to come back in 1975 & report their findings & make some recommendations..it was very apparent as we listened to these reports, that they had worked long & hard during the ensuing year.. The committee on "Basics", "the tools of the trade", headed by Johnny LeClair of Mesa, Arizona, was, perhaps as controversial as any. Every caller knows that 2 callers over a cup of coffee, will not agree on teaching methods, a teaching list or even the order in which basics should be taught, nor will an area callers group or a state callers group or a national callers group, so you can see & imagine the discussion that went on with 385 callers at the Convention..However the committee listened to everyone & on the final day of the convention, brought in a list that was unanimously adopted..they worked all during the days & thru the nights at this convention & although not all would be completely satisfied with any list, they gave the convention a suggested list & a suggested order of teaching..no caller was directed to use it..any caller is free to use it as he sees fit, but it gives every caller something he can work on in his Square Dance program..If in some areas the list cannot be completed in the allotted number of lessons, another Committee, headed by Jack Lasry was working on an identification system, whereby "plateaus" & "levels" might be established so a grouping of basics might indicate the level of experience for dancers..The committee on standards, headed by Angus McMorran of Ottawa, Ont., Canada covered methods of Execution & Styling..this committee too had worked long & hard during the year & gave a very comprehensive report on the different methods of execution in our nation..there were even papers available on the pros & cons of the controversial "Palms Up" in waves as opposed to the hands down method..there was controversy on the many ways that dancers do a "Do sa do" as compared to the only way it is taught..here again the committee did not try to impose their findings on anyone, but made strong suggestions & recommendations to all present, on how some methods of standardization could be reached. Already proven a great asset & really working, was the committee headed by Jack Lasry on the basics selected quarterly for suggested use by all callers..this committee had been very active since St. Louis & a very affirmative vote of confidence was given the committee to continue its work..All reports indicated that these basics selected each quarter were being used by callers all across the

country a large majority of the dancers were familiar with the quarterly selections.. Then there were questions on the heritage & legacy of Square Dancing.. The 1st & 2nd year dancer..the possibility of a certification & accreditation system for callers..the organization of local caller groups..a benefits program for callers..a record's tune clearing house..international exchange..& the National Convention.. At last years convention we saw Dorothy Shaw, Raymond Smith & more, receive milestone awards for their great contributions to the Square Dance movement..During this years convention banquet, we saw men like Les Gotcher, Al Brundage, Stan Burdick & Myrtis Litnan (for her late husband, Lloyd) receive milestone awards for the many, many contributions they gave to Square Dancing.

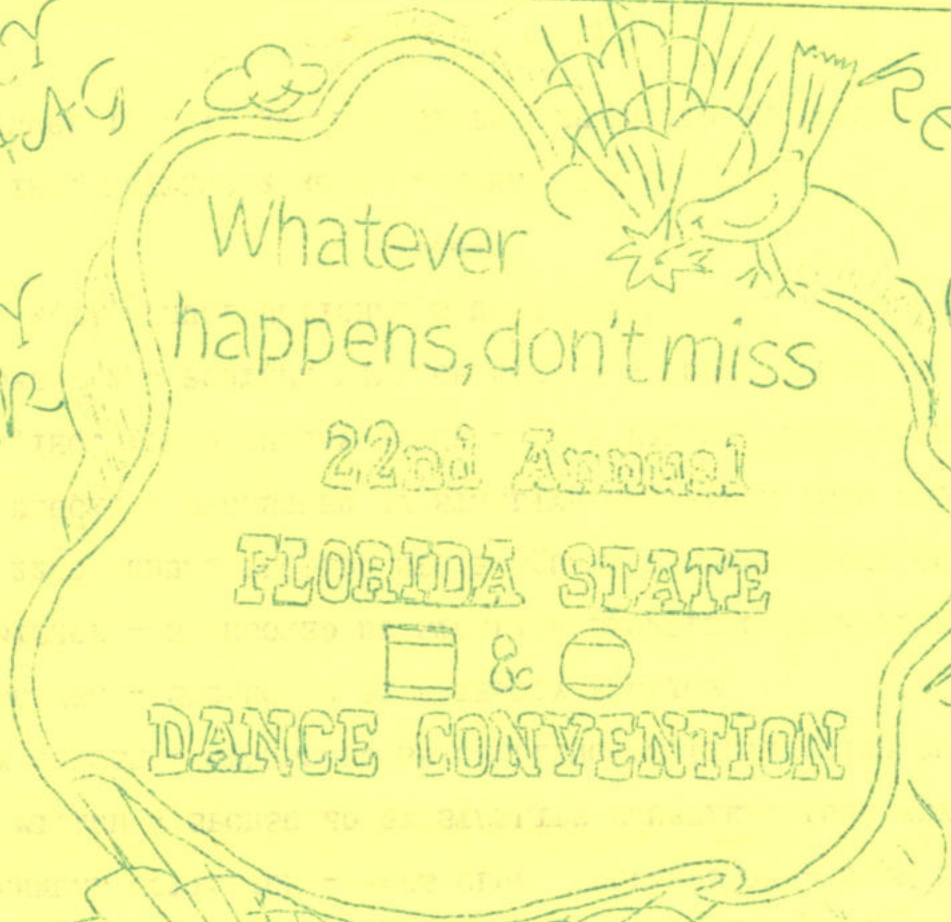
