We will have Elmer Sheffield on Nov.1 He has always been a favorite here & we look forward to a good dance.

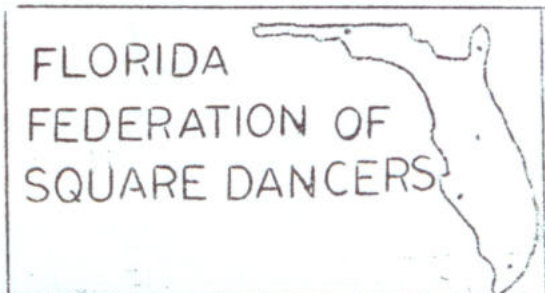
The Fall Roundup will be the 7-8. This will be an outstanding weekend of dancing Don't miss it!!
