We're now in the throes of planning our Annual New Years Eve Dance, John Saunders will call for us; further information & details will be announced later.

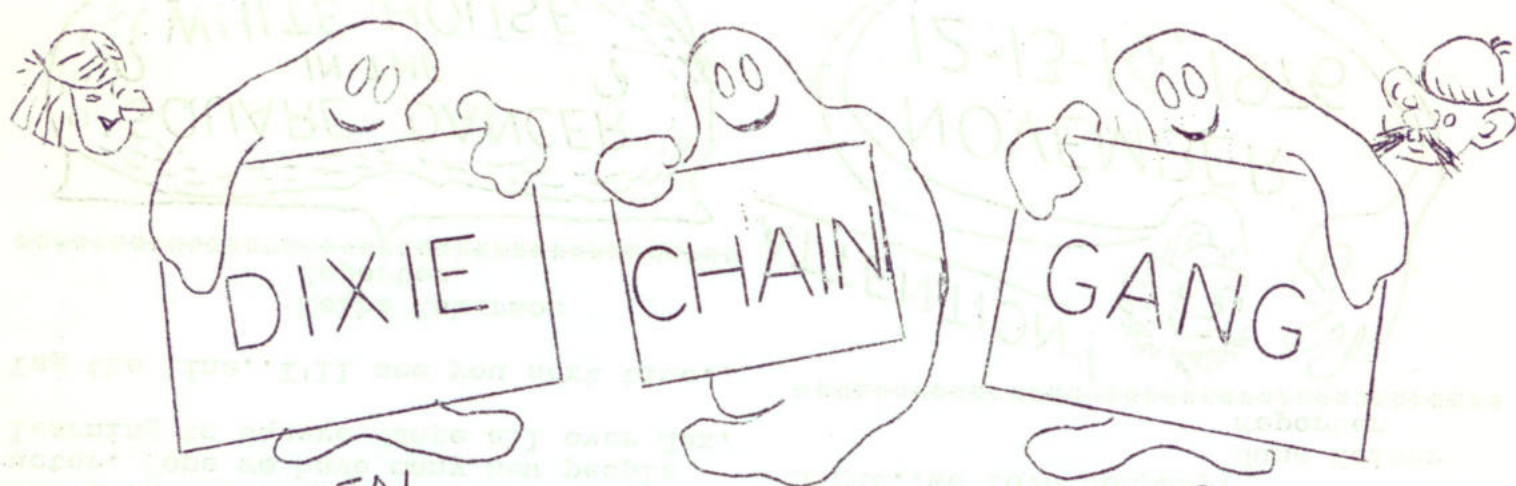

"My name is Jimmy Carter, this is my wife Rosalyn & we want to learn to Square dance".

The month was April, the year was 1963 at the American Legion Hall in Dawson, Ga., as the Merileg Square Dance Club held open house for prospective new class members.

I would like to think that square dancing had something to do with developing that famous smile, but nobody had to coach that famous smiling personality of Jimmy.

Both Jimmy & Rosalyn were quick to learn, they had a feel for the music & their approach was to enjoy square dancing & have fun while learning it! It was very apparent that they enjoyed it, however, the political future for Jimmy would curtail the time they could set aside for square dancing. I saw Carter & Rosalyn several times while he was Governor Of Ga. & every one of those times was at a square dance. He & Rosalyn hosted several big ones in the Governor's Mansion at Atlanta while he was in office & they participated in GRAND MARCHES at Ga. State Convention's, The Jekyll Island Jamboree & other festivals.

I remember as his term of Governor was coming to an end & at a square dance at the Mansion, he said he was looking forward to going back to Plains, getting his hands in the soil again & he & Rosalyn joining the nearby Crazy 8 Square Dance Club at Buena Vista... BUT..how destiny changes things! Now he is headed for the White House in Washington! & those hands will be guiding the destiny of the whole world & I'll bet you one thing..there will be square dancing in the White House... you can depend on it!

Not to be outdone by her parents, -Any Carter was interested in square dancing.

but while at the Governor's Mansion she saw the Little Generals put on clogging exhibitions throughout the State..Little Amy was good enough to be a traveling member of this young elite group..so clogging is in the family as well as square dancing..

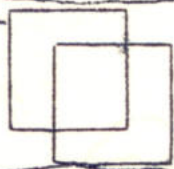

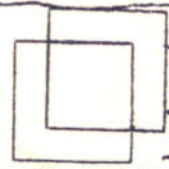
